NEW YORK YANKEES NOTES

- The Yankees are 1-1 on their six-game homestand and have lost three of their last four games...a loss tomorrow would secure consecutive series losses for just the second time this season (also 1-3 vs. Baltimore and 1-2 at Boston in April).
 - Are still 19-8 (.704) at Yankee Stadium in 2018 and 14-3 in their last 17 home games.
 - Are 4-1 vs. the Angels this season and 13-6 in their last 19 meetings since 7/1/15.
 - Fell to 21-7 (.750) outside the AL East.
 - Are 16G over .500, two games shy of their season high (18G over at the close of play on 5/21).
- Yankees batters** hit 3HR tonight and have homered 25 times over their last seven games.
- CF Brett Gardner** (1-for-4) hit his 12th career leadoff HR and first of the season (first since 9/28/17 vs. Tampa Bay)...the homer was his first since the Yankees' season opener on 3/29 at Toronto, snapping a 159AB homerless stretch...his 12 career leadoff homers rank seventh on the Yankees' all-time list (Frank Crosetti-14).
 - Is hitting .305 (18-for-59) with 11R, 5 doubles, 1 triple, 1HR, 8RBI, 11BB and 3SB in his last 16G (since 5/4) after hitting .100 (5-for-50) with 7R, 0XBH, 3RBI, 8BB and 1SB in his previous 14 games (4/17-5/3).
- RF Aaron Judge** (2-for-2, 2BB, 1SB) reached safely in each of his 4PA...hit his 70th career homer in the first...came in his 231st career game, becoming the fastest player in Baseball history to reach the mark in terms of games played (previous: Ryan Howard – 233G).
 - Is batting .347 (33-for-95) with 25R, 6 doubles, 11HR and 32RBI in 27 games at Yankee Stadium this season.
- Tonight marked the second time since 2013 the Yankees had back-to-back leadoff home runs to start the game (also **Gardner** and **Judge** on 9/28/17 vs. Tampa Bay)...according to research by the Associated Press, the Yankees have led off a game with consecutive homers eight times in franchise history, going 4-4 in those games.
- C Austin Romine** (2-for-4) hit a two-run HR in the second, his third HR in his last four games...hit 3HR over his previous 123 games (7/8/16-5/11/18)...has matched his brother, Andrew, with 10 career home runs.
 - Is batting .458 (11-for-24) with 7R, 3 doubles, 3HR and 9RBI during his career-high eight-game hitting streak (since 4/30).
- 1B Greg Bird** (0-for-4) made his season debut after being returned from rehab and reinstated from the 10-day disabled list prior to the game.
- RHP Sonny Gray** (3.2IP, 7H, 5ER, 2BB, 7K, 1HP, 1HR) started and recorded his second loss in his last three starts...allowed 11 of his 21 batters faced to reach base...failed to complete 4.0 innings for the third time this season (also 3.0IP on 4/12 at Boston and 3.1IP on 4/20 vs. Toronto).
 - Is 5-4 with a 3.59 ERA (87.2IP, 35ER) in 15 games/14 starts vs. the Angels in his career...tonight was his first start against the Angels as a Yankee.
- RHP Jonathan Holder** (1.1IP, 1BB, 3K) has not allowed an earned run in 12G since being recalled on 4/21, retiring 40-of-45 batters (13.2IP, 4H, 1R/0ER, 2BB/11BB, 15K).
- RHP Tommy Kahnle** (0.2IP, 2H, 4R/2ER, 2BB) made his first appearance since returning from the 10-day disabled list on Friday.

LOS ANGELES ANGELS NOTES

- The Angels improved to 3-2 on their 10-game road trip... have won three of their last four games after losing six of their previous seven...their 17-6 (.739) road record is the best in the Majors...have not lost consecutive road games this season.
- CF Mike Trout** (5-for-5, 3R, 3 doubles, 1HR, 4RBI) hit a go-ahead, two-run home run in the fourth inning...has homered in three straight games...marks the fifth time in his career and second time this season he has homered in at least three consecutive games (also 4G from 5/12-15/17, 3G from 4/20-22/18; 3G from 6/25-27/16 and 3G from 9/16-18//13).
 - His career-high 4XBH tied a franchise record for most extra-base hits in a game (11x, last: Mark Trumbo on 9/10/13 at Toronto).
 - Set a new career high with 5H.
 - Recorded his 600th career RBI with a double in the first inning.
 - His 11 total bases also marked a career high (previous: 10, 4x)
 - His 4RBI marked a season high.
 - Has scored a run in a season-high eight straight games, tied for the second-longest such streak of his career (15G from 7/5-23/12 and 8G from 8/28-9/6/16).
 - In 19 career games at Yankee Stadium, is hitting .389/.476/.819 (28-for-72) with 16R, 10 doubles, 7HR, 16RBI, 11BB and 8SB.

- **2B Zack Cozart** (2-for-5, 3R) is hitting .329 (28-for-85) on the road this season and .149 (14-for-94) at home.
- **SS Andrelton Simmons** (1-for-4) is hitting .355/.415/.523 (38-for-107) with 16R, 8 doubles, 2 triples, 2HR, 21RBI and 10BB in his last 30 games (since 4/21).
- **C Jose Briceño** (2-for-3, 2R, 1HR, 1BB, 2RBI) made his Major League debut and became the seventh player in franchise history to homer in his first career game, joining Carlos Perez (5/5/15 vs. Seattle), Kendrys Morales (5/23/06 at Texas), Mike Napoli (5/4/06 at Detroit), Eduardo Perez (7/27/93 vs. Oakland), Dave Macheimer (6/21/78 at Minnesota) and Billy Parker (9/9/71 vs. Milwaukee)...picked up his first career hit with a fourth-inning single but was thrown out at second trying to stretch.
- **RHP Jaime Barria** (5.0IP, 6H, 4ER, 1BB, 4K, 3HR) started and earned his fourth win of the season...his 6H, 4ER and 3HR allowed were a season highs...prior to tonight, had allowed only 1HR over his first five starts (25.1IP).
- **LF Justin Upton** (0-for-1, 1BB) was hit by a pitch in the fourth and removed from tonight's game for a pinch-hitter in the sixth with a left forearm contusion...X-rays were negative.
