THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 3-1 through four games on their 10-game, 11-day roadtrip winning each of the last three...tonight they will play the first of two in St. Louis...following tomorrow afternoon's finale, the Twins will travel to Anaheim for an off-day Wednesday followed by four against the Angels from Thursday to Sunday...they are seeking their longest winning streak this season, their last streak longer than three games coming September 21-26 (5 games).

TWINS TAKE ANOTHER IN CHICAGO: The Twins beat the White Sox yesterday afternoon by a score of 5-3...Kyle Gibson was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on four hits in 6.2 innings pitched...the offense recorded just four hits and scored all five runs in the seventh, eighth and ninth innings...Eddie Rosario led the offense with two hits, including his seventh home run of the season.

IL PLAY, FOR THE RECORD: The Twins have gone 2-3 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-1 at Pittsburgh and 1-2 vs. Cincinnati...they have won 12 of their last 15 vs. the NL, dating back to August 2...the Twins play the NL Central this season, with 15 games remaining: St. Louis (4 games home and away), Milwaukee (6 games home and away), Chicago (3 games away), and Pittsburgh (2 home games)...the Twins are 205-182 all-time in Interleague Play, eighth most wins in MLB since IL began in 1997...they are 91-103 all-time in road IL games and 114-79 at home.

☞ Eddie Rosario is hitting .333 (24-for-72) with eight doubles, seven home runs and 17 RBI in his last 18 games vs. NL opponents.

☞ Brian Dozier is hitting .346 (18-for-52) with seven home runs, 12 RBI, 14 runs scored and a .469 on-base percentage in his last 13 games vs. the NL...he has eight homers vs. the NL since the start of last season, tied for second most in baseball with José Abreu and Charlie Blackmon, and trailing Mike Trout (9).

NATIONAL TREASURE: Joe Mauer is hitting .321 (272-for-847) with 57 doubles, five triples, 21 home runs, 114 RBI, 136 runs scored, 117 walks and a .403 on-base percentage in 231 games against the National League...he has a six-game hitting streak vs. the NL, dating back to August 10...below are his ranks among actives in IL Play (min. 500 PA's):

THE GATEWAY CITY: The Twins and Cardinals are playing for the 23rd time during the regular season in their history tonight...they have gone 10-12 all-time, going 2-7 at old Busch Stadium (1997, '99 & '01), 2-3 at new Busch Stadium (2009 & '15), 4-2 at the Metrodome (1998 & '00) and 2-0 at Target Field (2015)...these two teams last met in 2015 as the Twins were swept in two games in St. Louis but swept the Cardinals in two at Target Field.

RED HOT ROSIE: Eddie Rosario has hit safely in seven straight and in nine of his last 10 games...Rosario is batting .395 (17-for-43) with five doubles, five home runs and 14 RBI in his last 10 games...Rosario has a 1.270 OPS in that span, eighth best in the majors and third best in the American League, trailing only Mookie Betts (1.683) and Mike Trout (1.510).

INTERNATIONAL MAN OF VICTORY: Triple-A Rochester left-handed pitcher Stephen Gonsalves has been named the International League Pitcher of the Week, the league office announced today...in his first Triple-A start of the season on May 1 at Pawtucket, Gonsalves allowed just one hit and one walk with five strikeouts in 7.2 innings...he faced the minimum through 7.0 innings and retired 16 in a row before a leadoff walk in the 8th...the left-hander followed that up by throwing 4.2 perfect innings to begin his start on May 6 vs. Lehigh Valley before Mitch Walding hit a solo home run in the fifth...Gonsalves finished the game by surrendering one run on three hits and a walk with nine strikeouts in 6.2 innings...Gonsalves is the first Rochester pitcher to be named International League Pitcher of the Week since Aaron Slegers on July 24, 2017...the Wings had four IL Pitchers of the Week last season: Jose Berríos (2x), Nik Turley and Slegers.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2000, Tom Kelly recorded his 1,000th managerial win in a 4-0 victory over Detroit...Kelly finished his career with 1,140 victories, the most in club history...in 2008, Carlos Gomez became the eighth Twin (10 now) to ever hit for the cycle...at Guaranteed Rate Park, Gomez led the game off with a home run (off Buehrle), then tripled in his third at-bat (Buehrle), doubled in his fourth at-bat (Buehrle) and singled in his fifth and final at-bat (Wassermann)...in 2010, the Twins suffered their first rainout at home since 1980, being forced by weather to reschedule that day's game against the Orioles as part of a day-night doubleheader on May 8th.

THIS AND THAT:

☞ Mauer has 26 walks compared to 15 strikeouts for an MLB-best 1.73 BB/K ratio.

☞ The Twins pitching staff is striking out 10.28 hitters per nine innings on the road in 2018, ranking first all of baseball.

DOMINANT DEBUT: Romero shut out the Blue Jays over 5.2 innings in his major league debut on May 2, allowing four hits and three walks with five strikeouts, earning his first win...Romero retired the first three batters of the game, striking out the first batter he faced (Curtis Granderson)...he retired the first two batters he faced in the sixth inning but walked Kevin Pillar on a full count, ending his day...one of two pitchers to hold their opponent scoreless in their ML debut in 2018 (Nick Kingham, PIT)...he became the first Twins pitcher to win in his debut since Felix Jorge on July 1, 2017 at Kansas City.

JOIN THE CAROUSEL: By making his first career start on May 2, Romero became the sixth different starting pitcher and the 19th different pitcher the Twins have used in 2018 (including outfielder Ryan LaMarre)...Twins starters are 8-9 while the staff owns a 4.96 ERA, 12th in the AL.

ELITE ENTRANCES: Romero was the 63rd player and 40th pitcher to make his big league debut in 2018...he is also the seventh player on MLB.com's top-100 prospect's list to make his debut in 2018...Romero is one of five players in the Twins organization listed on the top-100 prospect list (Royce Lewis, 20; Stephen Gonsalves, 77; Nick Gordon, 79; Wander Javier, 100).

SEVENS UP: Romero is the second player in club history to ever appear in uniform number 77, joining third baseman Tony Batista, who wore it for 50 games in 2006...33 players in baseball history have ever worn 77, including current players: Toronto's John Axford, San Diego's Buddy Bauman, Miami's Merandy Gonzalez and Detroit's Joe Jimenez.

TWINS DEBUTS: Romero is the second Twins pitcher to make his major league debut and the 12th Twins pitcher to make his debut since the beginning of 2017 (Tyler Kinley debuted April 7 vs. SEA)...he is now one of 16 different Twins to make his major league debut since 2017, joining pitchers John Curtiss, Dietrich Enns, Trevor Hildenberger, Justin Haley, Gabriel Moya, Alan Busenitz, Nik Turley, Aaron Slegers, Felix Jorge, Randy Rosario and Jason Wheeler, catcher Mitch Garver, infielder Niko Goodrum, and outfielder Zack Granite.

2017 RECAP:

- Optioned from Twins spring training to Double-A Chattanooga March 13 where he spent the entire season.
- Named Southern League Midseason All-Star.
- Named Twins minor league Player of the Week July 29, going 2-0, 0.90 ERA (10.0 IP, 1 ER) with four walks and 15 strikeouts in two starts for the Lookouts.
- Placed on 7-day disabled list with right shoulder impingement August 24, ending his season.
- Held right-handed hitters to a .239 average and left-handed hitters to a .276 average.
- Tied for seventh in all of Double-A in wins (11).
- Named sixth best prospect in Twins system by *Baseball America*, entering 2018.

TOP PROSPECT: Since being signed in 2011, Romero has been touted as one of the top prospects in the Twins system...*Baseball America* named him the Twins 12th ranked prospect in 2013 and has been rated as a top-30 prospect in the Twins organization since...entered 2018 as the number 66 prospect in all of baseball and the second best prospect in the Twins system according to MLB.com, while *Baseball America* rated him as the sixth best prospect in the Twins organization.

IN THE MINORS: Romero was signed as an undrafted free agent November 4, 2011...started 2018 in Triple-A Rochester, 0-1, 2.57 ERA (21.0 IP, 6 ER) in four games (3 starts)...after missing half of 2014 and all of 2015 recovering from elbow surgery, split 2016 between Low-A Cedar Rapids and High-A Ft. Myers...in six minor league seasons, 23-17, 2.83 ERA (324.1 IP, 102 ER) with 102 walks and 314 strikeouts.

AGAINST THE CARDINALS: Romero will be making his first career start vs. the Cardinals today...has made two starts against Cardinals affiliates, both against High-A Palm Beach in the Florida State League in 2016...won both starts, allowing two runs over 14.0 innings on six hits with 14 strikeouts.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - JAKE ODORIZZI, RHP [SEASON: 2-2 4.10 ERA // CAREER: 42-40, 3.84 ERA]

In seven starts in 2018, Odorizzi is 2-2, 4.10 ERA (37.1 IP, 19 ER) with 18 walks and 35 strikeouts...last start against Chicago-AL on May 3, did not factor into the decision after allowing five runs (3 earned) on six hits and two walks over 5.1 innings with eight strikeouts, a season high...has three career starts against St. Louis, 1-1, 3.24 ERA (16.2 IP, 6 ER) with eight walks and 17 strikeouts...last start against the Cardinals was August 25, 2017, allowed three runs on three hits and four walks over 3.2 innings and didn't factor into the decision.

TEAM BULLPEN NOTES

- In their first 20 games, the Twins bullpen had a 6.50 ERA (80.1 IP, 58 ER) with an opponent average of .302...since 4/28 (9 games) the 'pen has a 3.27 ERA (33.0 IP, 12 ER) and .225 opp. avg.
- In fact, their last five games (Twins record: 4-1), the bullpen has a 1.80 ERA (15.0 IP, 3 ER)...all three runs came via solo home runs, the other 7 hits allowed were singles.
