THE TWINS: The Twins completed their nine-game homestand with a record of 2-7, going 1-2 in Cleveland, 1-2 in Texas and 0-3 in Houston...tonight the Twins will begin a six-game homestand with three vs. the Royals over the weekend and three vs. the Yankees next Monday-Wednesday.

TWINS SWEEPED OUT OF HOUSTON: The Twins lost to the Astros on Wednesday afternoon by a score of 9-1...Jake Odorizzi (5-10) was the starter and loser allowing five runs on four hits in 4.1 innings pitched...the offense recorded six hits two from both Jorge Polanco and Max Kepler...the Twins scored their only run on a Willians Astudillo home run in the fifth inning, the second of his career.

TWINS AND ROYALS: The Twins and Royals are playing the 13th of 19 games this season...they have gone 6-6 against KC this season, going 1-5 at Kauffman Stadium and 5-1 at Target Field...they swept the Royals in three games in their last meeting August 3-5 at Target Field.

- ☞ Eddie Rosario is hitting .318 (28-for-88) with 15 RBI in his last 21 games vs. KC.
- ☞ Miguel Sanó has reached safely in each of his last 20 games against the Royals, hitting .358 (29-for-81) with four doubles, one triple, six home runs, 32 RBI, 18 runs scored and a .422 on-base percentage in that span...the 20-game on-base streak is the longest of his career vs. any opponent.
- ☞ Max Kepler is hitting .303 (20-for-66) with 14 walks and a .427 on-base percentage in his last 20 games vs. KC.
- ☞ Jake Cave is hitting .304 (7-for-23) in nine games vs. KC this season.

MAUER AND KC: Joe Mauer is hitting .321 (247-for-770) with 45 doubles, four triples, 14 home runs, 122 RBI and a .404 on-base percentage in 206 career games against the Royals...he ranks sixth all-time in batting average against KC (minimum 500 at-bats), trailing Rod Carew (.345), Ivan Rodriguez (.337), Wade Boggs (.332), Alex Rodriguez (.329), Derek Jeter (.322).

☞ In his last 15 games against the Royals, he is hitting .413 (26-for-63) with a .456 on-base percentage and seven multi-hit games...he has 14 hits in 36 at-bats (.389) this season vs. KC.

EXTRA-BASE MAUER: Joe Mauer has 596 extra-base hits in his career and needs one to tie Tony Oliva for fourth most in Twins history (since 1961):

MINNESOTA, NICE: The Twins have gone 39-29 at home this season, compared to 24-47 on the road...the Twins won 41 games at home last season...they have gone 20-8 at Target Field since June 24...since that date, they have the sixth best home winning percentage in baseball (.690), trailing Boston (.800), Tampa Bay (.750), Oakland (.719), Colorado (.710) and Chicago-NL (.697)...however, the Twins have lost three straight home games (August 24-26 vs. Oakland), and looking to avoid losing four straight here for the first time since June 16-18, 2017 (also 4).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1970, Brant Aleya drives in all seven Twins runs on two homers in game 1, then drives in two more in the nitecap as the Twins sweep the Brewers, 7-6, and 8-3...Stan Williams (9-0) wins his ninth straight to set a Twins record...in Game 2, Hal Haydel makes his first major league appearance a good one, pitching 5.0 innings of relief to win, and also hitting his first big league home run.

HAPPY BELATED: Happy Belated Birthday to Tyler Austin who turned 27-years-old yesterday.

MINOR MATTERS: Twins minor league affiliates in the playoffs:

- ☞ Game 1 of the Florida State League Championship will be played tonight as Single-A Ft. Myers hosts Daytona...the Miracle will play the best of five, two Ft. Myers and three at Daytona.
- ☞ Single-A Cedar Rapids is playing games two and three of their round one matchup with Beloit in a doubleheader tonight...the Kernels are down in the series 1-0.
- ☞ Rookie-Level Elizabethton won the Appalachian League title with a 2-1 win over Princeton on Wednesday...it marked their second straight Appy League title and their eighth under Manager Ray Smith (since 1989).

LAST START: Gonsalves did not factor into the decision on August 31 vs. Texas after allowing six runs (3 earned) on six hits and four walks in 3.2 innings...has allowed at least six hits in each of his first three big league starts...first professional outing without a strikeout since August 30, 2017 with Double-A Chattanooga and his first professional start without a strikeout since July 24, 2016...in his three big league starts has only been given one run of support, good for a run support average of 0.90.

AGAINST THE ROYALS: Gonsalves is making his fourth career start against Kansas City...has made one career start against an AL Central opponent, suffered the loss vs. Chicago-AL on August 20 after allowing four runs on six hits and two walks with three strikeouts in 1.1 innings...has made one career minor league start against a Kansas City affiliate as a member of Rookie Elizabethton, earned the win over Burlington on June 25, 2014 after shutting out the Royals on two hits with nine strikeouts over 6.0 innings.

2018 ON THE FARM: Gonsalves began the season in Double-A Chattanooga where he went 3-0 across four starts with a 1.77 ERA (20.1 IP, 4 ER), two home runs allowed, 10 walks and 25 strikeouts...was named Twins Minor League Pitcher of the week for the week of April 22-28...promoted to Triple-A Rochester and made his first start for the Red Wings on May 1... had three winning months in Rochester, going 4-1 in May, 2-0 in July and 2-0 in August...in July, he went 2-0 with a 0.88 ERA (30.2 IP, 3 ER) across five starts.

KEEP 'EM COMIN': Gonsalves became the 12th different starting pitcher the Twins have used this year (not including the three openers)...he is one of 33 different pitchers to make an appearance this year (including outfielder Ryan LaMarre, infielder Willians Asutdillo, catcher Mitch Garver and catcher Chris Gimenez), tied for third most in the AL with Oakland.

2017 RECAP:

- Spent first career spring training with Twins and reassigned to minor league camp March 13; reported to Double-A Chattanooga.
- Began season on 7-day disabled list with left rotator cuff strain.
- Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Month for June, going 4-1, 2.32 ERA (31.00 IP, 8 ER) in five starts for the Lookouts.
- Ranked third on Chattanooga staff in wins (8), innings pitched (87.1), and strikeouts, despite pitching just three months.
- Promoted to Triple-A Rochester August 7.
- Made five appearances (four starts) for Red Wings in August where he finished the season
- Named left-handed starting pitcher on the Twins Organizational All-Star team by MLB.com.
- Ranked fourth best prospect and best changeup in Twins system by Baseball America, entering 2018...ranked 78th best prospect in baseball by MLB.com.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - JOSE BERRIOS, RHP (SEASON: 11-10, 3.92 ERA ; CAREER: 28-25, 4.55 ERA)

Berrios is making his 29th start of the season, is 11-10, 3.92 ERA (167.2 IP, 73 ER) with 49 walks and 171 strikeouts...last start was at Texas on September 1, suffered the loss after allowing five runs on three hits and three walks with six strikeouts over 4.0 innings...making his eighth career start and third of the year vs. Kansas City, is 2-1, 4.99 ERA (39.2 IP, 22 ER)...last start vs. KC was August 4, earned the win after giving up two runs on five hits and three walks with six strikeouts over 7.0 innings.
