**THE TWINS:** After completing their six-game homestand with a record of 2-4 (1-2 vs. Cincinnati and 1-2 vs. Toronto), the Twins began their 10-game, 11-day roadtrip with a loss to the White Sox last night...they will play the second of four tonight on the Southside...after this weekend, they will travel to St. Louis for two games on Monday and Tuesday, followed by an off-day in Anaheim Wednesday and four vs. the Angels next Thursday-Sunday...the Twins have gone 2-12 since April 20.

**ANOTHER WALK-OFF LOSS:** The Twins lost to the White Sox last night by a score of 6-5, suffering their fifth walk-off loss this season...Jake Odorizzi was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing five runs (3 earned) on six hits in 5.1 innings pitched...Addison Reed suffered the loss, allowing a walk-off homer to Trayce Thompson in the ninth inning...the offense recorded seven hits, three from Logan Morrison who homered and doubled, while driving in two of the Twins five runs.

**TWINS AND SOX:** The Twins and White Sox are playing the third of 19 meetings this season...the Twins have won four of their last five over the Sox, 10 of their last 15 and 15 of their last 23...lastly, the Twins have out-scored the Sox 55-34 in their last 10 meetings.

☞ Brian Dozier is hitting .325 (40-for-123) with 11 doubles, 11 home runs, 23 RBI and a .403 on-base percentage in his last 31 games vs. the White Sox.

☞ The Twins have gone 8-5 in their last 13 at Guaranteed Rate Field.

☞ Joe Mauer is hitting .302 (104-for-344) with 23 doubles, nine home runs, 46 RBI, 65 runs scored, 62 walks and a .408 on-base percentage in 94 career games in Chicago...his OBP is 10th best in this park's history and second among actives, trailing only Victor Martinez (.418).

**ESCY FOGO POWER:** Since April 18, Eduardo Escobar has hit .321 (18-for-56) with eight doubles, three home runs, seven RBI, six walks, 11 runs and a .387 on-base percentage in 14 games...in his first 10 games prior, Escobar was hitting .263 (10-for-38) with a .286 on-base percentage...Escobar is tied with Kevin Pillar for most doubles in baseball with 13.

**LO-MO NOTES:** Logan Morrison is hitting .360 (9-for-25) with two doubles, two home runs, six RBI, five runs scored, three walks, a .448 on-base percentage and a 1.128 OPS in his last seven games...Morrison started the season hitting .134 (9-for-67) with three extra-base hits in his first 19 games...the 30-year-old was signed by the Twins to a one-year contract on February 25.

**HOME SICK:** The Twins have gone 3-10 on the road this season, entering tonight with an eight-game road losing streak, their last away win coming April 4 at Pittsburgh...it marks their longest road losing streak since dropping 11 straight from August 18-September 12, 2016.

**TIME FOR A TURNAROUND:** The Twins began the season with a record of 8-5...since they left Puerto Rico on April 19, the Twins have gone just 2-12...since then, they are hitting .207 (24-for-116) with runners in scoring position and pitchers have posted an 7.20 ERA (121.1 IP, 97 ER) with 28 home runs allowed in 14 games.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 1984, at the Metrodome, Oakland's Dave Kingman was awarded a ground rule double when the ball he hit disappeared, going through a drainage hole in the stadium roof and never returned to the playing field.

**BIRTHDAY SHOUTS - TWINS CIRCA 2009:** Former Twins Kevin Slowey and Matt Tolbert are celebrating birthdays today, Slowey turns 34 and Tolbert 36...they were teammates for four seasons from 2008-11...Slowey last pitched for Miami in 2014 and Tolbert was in the Phillies minor league system in 2014.

**PERKINS FAMILY PERFORMANCE CENTER:** Today Gopher Baseball will honor alum Glen Perkins and his family for their significant financial investment in both Siebert Field and the indoor training center connected to the park with the naming of the Glen Perkins Family Performance Center...The Glen Perkins Family Performance Center is an indoor training space built onto the existing structure of Siebert Field...with three large doors facing the field's concourse, the facility can be open during the warmer months, but closed to maintain a comfortable temperature throughout the winter...inside, student-athletes have access to three batting tunnels, a video review system and a team meeting space...the Perkins family will be on hand to throw out the ceremonial first pitch at Siebert Field tonight before Minnesota takes on Indiana in the opening game of the teams' Big Ten Conference series...prior to first pitch, there will also be a brief dedication ceremony to celebrate the renaming of the performance center.

**LAST START:** Berríos suffered his second straight loss in his shortest outing of the season against the Reds April 29...allowed a season-high three walks...gave up runs in each of the first two innings then loaded the bases in the fourth before recording an out...allowed two runs to score on a pair of fielders choices and was pulled after recording the third out.

**SOUVENIRS FROM THE ISLAND:** Berríos made the start in his native Puerto Rico on April 18 vs. Cleveland...he became the just the second different Puerto Rican pitcher to start a major league game at Hiram Bithorn Stadium, the other being Javier Vazquez (4 starts)...two other pitchers appeared in relief: Pedro Feliciano (1 game) and Roberto Hernandez (3 game)...he and teammate Eddie Rosario became the first Twins Puerto Rico natives to play in Hiram Bithorn.

**THE ROCKET AND LA MAQUINA:** By shutting out Cleveland over 7.0 innings in his start on April 24, Berríos became the first pitcher since Roger Clemens in 1991 to throw 7.0+ shutout innings three times in their teams' first 13 games of a season...Clemens went on to lead the AL in ERA (2.62) and win the Cy Young Award.

**AGAINST THE WHITE SOX:** Berríos is making his sixth career start and second of the season against Chicago-AL...last time out on April 12, shut out the White Sox over 7.0 innings, allowing only three hits and striking out 11 batters...in five career starts against Chicago-AL, 4-1, 1.67 ERA (32.1 IP, 6 ER) with eight walks and 42 strikeouts, the most innings Berríos has thrown against any team...only loss came August 24, 2017, allowed five runs (three earned) on four hits and three walks in 5.1 innings with nine strikeouts...four wins are his most vs. any team.

**FAMILIAR FOES:** This will be Berríos third start against an AL Central opponent in 2018...in starts against Cleveland and Chicago-AL, 1-0, 0.00 ERA (14.0 IP, 0 ER) with no walks and 16 strikeouts...faced Cleveland in Puerto Rico, didn't earn a decision in a game the Twins ultimately won 2-1 in 16 innings...in 20 career games (19 starts) against AL Central opponents, 8-5, 5.10 ERA (100.2 IP, 57 ER) with 38 walks and 87 strikeouts.

**LEFT AND RIGHT:** He has held right-handed hitters to a .164 (10-for-61) average with one home run, one walk, 20 strikeouts and a .190 OBP...in his three starts at Target Field, righties are batting .156 (5-for-32) with just two extra-base hits (2 2B)...lefties have hit .232 (13-for-69) with two homers, 16 strikeouts and a .284 OBP in 2018...for his career righties have hit .241 with 30 walks and 123 strikeouts and lefties have hit .264 with 59 walks and 101 strikeouts...he allowed his first walk to a right-handed batter in 2018 in his last start against Cincinnati.

**WIZARD OF WHIFF:** With his outing on April 12 vs. Chicago-AL, Berríos has now thrown the three most recent 10+ K, 0 run games in Twins history (August 30, 2017 vs. Chicago-AL, May 18, 2017 vs. Colorado)...the last to do it before Berríos was Ervin Santana on August 30, 2015 vs. Houston...with three games of 10+ strikeouts and 0 walks, he follows Johan Santana (8) and Bert Blyleven (6) for most such performances in Twins history...Berríos is tied for sixth in the AL in strikeout-to-walk ratio at 6.00.

### 2017 RECAP:

- Berríos started 25 games, a single-season career-high.
- In first full season, Berríos finished 14-8 with 139 strikeouts and 48 walks over 145.2 innings.
- Set career highs in wins (14), strikeouts (139), innings (145.2) and ERA (3.89)...he ranked second on Twins staff in wins, and strikeouts, and third in starts and innings pitched.
- Tied for ninth in the AL in wins.
- The youngest pitcher in baseball to record an 11-strikeout game last year against Colorado on May 18.
- Made first career postseason appearance against New York-AL in the Wild Card Game...allowed three runs in three innings and was credited with a loss.

**KEEPING 'EM OFF THE BASES:** Through six starts in 2018, Berríos has walked six batters, giving him a BB/9 rate of 1.56, which is sixth best in the AL and 11th in baseball... Berríos has also only allowed 26 hits and owns a 0.92 WHIP, which is seventh best in the AL and 12th in baseball.

**ROUGH PATCH:** Berríos' has suffered a loss in consecutive starts, the first time he's done so since losing to Los Angeles-NL and San Diego from July 25-August 1 2017...in his last two outings, Berríos has allowed nine earned runs, the most he's allowed in consecutive starts since 11 runs over two starts to Texas and Detroit in August of 2017...Berríos hasn't suffered more than two consecutive losses since losing four in a row from August 25-September 16, 2016.

**TOMORROW'S STARTER - LANCE LYNN, RHP [SEASON: 0-3, 8.37 ERA // CAREER: 72-50, 3.50 ERA]**

Lynn has made five starts in 2018, 0-3, 8.37 ERA (23.2 IP, 22 ER) with 23 walks and 26 strikeouts...in three career starts against Chicago-AL, 1-0, 1.40 ERA (19.1 IP, 3 ER) with three walks and 26 strikeouts...last time against the White Sox on July 22, 2015, allowed two runs over 6.0 innings on five hits and one walk with eight strikeouts and didn't factor into the decision.
