RED HOT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals are 30-17 post All-Star Break and 31-17 under manager Mike Shildt since he took the post on July 15. The Cardinals and Athletics have the most wins in MLB since the All-Star Break (30), while St. Louis .638 winning percentage ranks 3rd in MLB over that period. St. Louis has won 20-of-its-last-28 games overall, including a season-best eight-game winning streak (August 7-15). Entering July 15, the Cardinals had T9th-most wins in the NL (47) and currently have the 3rd-most wins (78) in the NL.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals are at 15 games over .500 entering play tonight and currently reside in 3rd place in the NL Central, 5.5 games out of first place, and hold the 2nd spot in the NL Wild Card standings, trailing Milwaukee by 1.5 games. The Cardinals currently carry the 3rd-best record in the NL and have 6 games remaining against teams ahead of them in the standings, the Cubs and Brewers.

ROAD WARRIORS: The Cardinals' NL-leading 41 road wins are T3rd-most in the Majors and are the club's most since 48 road victories in 2016 (29 in 2017). On the road since July 15, the Cardinals lead the National league in wins (17), home runs (46), RBI (145), average (.274), on-base pct. (.344), slugging (.478), OPS (.822).

INTERLEAGUE ACTION: St. Louis is 180-173 all-time in Interleague play, with a .510 win percentage that leads all NL clubs (Mets, .507)...this season, St. Louis is 10-8 (5-3 on the road) needs one more win for winning Interleague record for first time since 2015 (11-9) and 13th time in 22 seasons (since 1997)...St. Louis is 88-89 all-time in American League ballparks.

DESIGNATED TO HIT: Cardinals designated hitters are the all-time leaders amongst NL teams in batting (.303, 209-690), on-base pct. (.379) & slugging pct. (.513).

HE MAKES IT A LITTLE BADER: Outfielder Harrison Bader leads Major League outfielders in 5-star catches (7) and Outs Above Average (20) (Statcast), and co-leads the Majors with Detroit outfielder JaCoby Jones with 21 defensive runs saved (Fangraphs). His 8 outfield assists rank T6th in the National League and and co-lead NL rookies with Miami's Brian Anderson.

INTERLEAGUE ENFORCER: Matt Carpenter enters tonight's Interleague matchup leading all active players with a career .614 slugging pct. and OPS (1.027) in those contests while ranking 5th in batting (.327) and 2nd in on-base pct. (.413).

CHICKS DIG THE LONG BALL: St. Louis have homered in 102 of 141 games this season, going 70-32 (.687 win pct.) in those games (8-31 when not homering)...their 70 wins lead the NL and rank 5th in MLB (Yankees, 77)...among MLB clubs going yard, only the Red Sox (76-19, .800) and Astros (74-29, .719) have better winning percentages...St. Louis' 186 home runs are 2nd-most in the NL and trail the Dodgers (197)...277 of the Cardinals 652 runs scored (42.5%) this season have come via the long ball. **ROAD BOMBS:** St. Louis is an NL-best 39-18 (.684) while homering on the road, and trails only Oakland (117) in road homers (114).

POSTCARDS: Two Cardinals minor league affiliates are currently competing in the postseason. The defending PCL Champion Memphis Redbirds (AAA) currently lead the Oklahoma City Dodgers, 2-1, in the best-of-five PCL Semifinals...last night the Redbirds overcame a two-run deficit in the bottom of the 9th inning and won on a Max Schrock walk-off RBI single. The Peoria Chiefs (A) swept the Quad City River Bandits (Astros) in the best-of-three Midwest League Quarterfinals, and begin the best-of-three Semifinals tonight at Cedar Rapids Kernals (Twins). The Cardinals minor league organization finished 492-402 overall and .550 winning pct. that ranked 3rd behind Tampa Bay (.604) and Houston (.562).

BIG MAC FLASHBACK (Sept. 8, 1998) Home Run #62: Mark McGwire's shortest home run of the year (341 ft.) was recovered under the stands by Cardinals Grounds Crew member, Tim Forneris, who gave the ball back to Big Mac. The game was delayed 11 minutes by the ensuing celebration and a brief speech where McGwire thanked his family, his son, the Cubs, Sammy Sosa, and the fans of St. Louis. After the game, which the Cardinals won 6-3, Commissioner Bud Selig conducted an on-field ceremony where McGwire was presented with the first Commissioner's Historic Achievement Award. The Cardinals also presented Mark with a red 1962 Corvette for his achievement.

DETROIT CONNECTIONS

Cardinals Director of Communications Brian Bartow is a native of Battle Creek Mich...graduated from Ferris State College in Big Rapids, Mich.

1934 World Series: The "Gas House Gang" won the NL pennant on the final day of the season, then defeated Detroit in the Series, four games to three, for their third championship in eight years. Dizzy and Paul Dean, each won two games over the Tigers. The final game of the Series, won by the Cardinals, 11-0, was marked by Commissioner Kenesaw Landis' order to eject Ducky Medwick from the game. Medwick slid hard into Tigers third baseman Marv Owen in the sixth inn., so infuriating Detroit fans that they bombarded Medwick with empty bottles, fruit, vegetables and debris when he took his position in left field in the bottom of the inning. Landis removed Medwick to halt the disturbance...1934 was the last World Series in which both teams were led by player-managers.

Jim Adduci's father, Jim Adduci, was drafted by the Cardinals in the 7th round in 1980...appeared in 10 games for the Cardinals in 1983.

Hall of Famer Cardinals Manager Whitey Herzog played in 52 games for Detroit during the 1963 season...became a Tiger via trade with Baltimore, packaged with catcher Gus Triandos in exchange for catcher the Dick Brown (Nov. 26, 1962).

1968 World Series: 50 years ago, the Tigers overcame a 3-1 deficit and defeated the defending World Series champion Cardinals, four games to three, for their first championship since 1945... Left-hander Mickey Lolich hurled three complete-game victories (1.67 ERA) to earn MVP... Gibson won two games and set Series records by striking out 17 batters in Game One and 35 in the Series. Lou Brock batted .464 and stole seven bases. Current Cardinals Hall of Fame broadcasters Tim McCarver and Mike Shannon, each homered and played all seven games.

Tigers Special Assistant to the GM Jim Leyland spent six seasons (2000-05) as a scout for the Cardinals, scouting NL clubs from Pittsburgh and AL clubs from Cleveland.

2006 World Series: The Cardinals secured a play-off berth on the final day of the regular season by winning the NL Central Division and went on to capture the 10th World Championship in franchise history, topping the Tigers in five games... the Cardinals won the Fall Classic with the fewest regular-season wins during a full season in major league history (83)...St. Louis pitchers limited the Tigers to 32 hits in 44 IP with a 2.05 ERA. David Eckstein batted .364 (8-22) with three doubles and four RBI to be named MVP... Tony La Russa joined Sparky Anderson (Reds & Tigers) as only the second manager to win the World Series with teams in both leagues...notable Cardinals to appear include Yadier Molina and Adam Wainwright.

TONIGHT'S GAME

- Rookie makes his 24th start of the season & 30th career appearance (29th start).
- Leads all MLB rookies and the Cardinals with his 154 strikeouts (12th in the N.L.).
- Has held his opposition to one run or less in 14 of 23 starts, ranking T3rd among N.L. pitchers (deGrom 16, Nola 15). Held opposition to 4 ER or less in all 23 starts.
- Has struck out 67 batters post All-Star Break, 5th among National League pitchers.
- His 174 strikeouts in first 29 career games are the most ever by a Cardinal.
- Leads National League rookie pitchers in wins (8) and strikeouts (154). Ranks in the Top 10 in ERA (2.83, 2nd), opponent BA (.192, 2nd), innings (127.1, 2nd) and starts (23, 2nd).
- Averages 10.88 strikeouts/9 IP, ranking 4th all-time for rookie pitchers behind Kerry Wood (12.58), Dwight Gooden (11.39) and Hideo Nomo (11.10), all who went on to win Rookie of the Year awards.
- 10 of the 13 runs he's allowed over his last nine starts have come via home run.
- Has the 2nd-lowest ERA in the N.L. of pitchers who have allowed 17 or more home runs this season (Scherzer 2.28, 21 HR).
- Ranks T5th among NL pitchers with 10 hit batsmen, including four Cubs batters.
- Has received one run or less of support in 7 of his starts & 2 runs or less in 13 starts. He's 7-0 (STL 8-2) in games which he receives 3 or more runs of support.

LAST TIME OUT

- Walked a career-high five batters, but allowed just three hits over 5.0 innings including a solo home run (Trea Turner) for his only damage in the game.
- Has only allowed one run in each of his last three starts.
