WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox have lost three of their last four games as they continue their first homestand of the season this afternoon vs. Detroit ... RHP Lucas Giolito, who went 3-0 with a 0.99 ERA (3 ER/27.1 IP) in four daytime starts in 2017, takes the mound for the White Sox.
- The Sox opened the homestand on Thursday with a 9-7 loss to Detroit in 10 innings.
- Following this three-game series, the White Sox will conclude the homestand with three games vs. Tampa Bay (4/9-11) before taking a seven-game trip to Minnesota (4/12-15) and Oakland (4/16-18).
- The Sox went 3-2 on their first trip of the season to Kansas City (2-0) and Toronto (1-2), rallying to win both games of an abbreviated two-game series against the Royals before losing two of three games to the Blue Jays.

TODAY'S STORYLINES

- Magglio Ordóñez, who played for the White Sox from 1998-2004, will throw out a ceremonial first pitch.
- The White Sox lead the major leagues with 14 home runs, a .533 slugging percentage and .890 OPS.
- Chicago has led at some point in all six games this season.
- Lucas Giolito is 3-1 with a 1.71 ERA (5 ER/26.1 IP) in his last four starts at Guaranteed Rate Field.
- José Abreu is a .378/.445/.556 (51-135) hitter in 36 career home games vs. Detroit.

THURSDAY'S RECAP

- The White Sox were unable to hold a late four-run lead as they lost their home opener, 9-7, in 10 innings to Detroit.
- Detroit scored three runs off Joakim Soria in the ninth inning and two off Gregory Infante in the 10th.
- Matt Davidson reached base safely four times, going 2-3 with a double, RBI and career-high tying four runs scored ... Yolmer Sánchez was 3-5 with two triples and three RBI, while Avisail García and Leury García collected two hits apiece
- James Shields posted a no decision, allowing three runs on eight hits over 5.0 IP.

MARK YOUR CALENDARS

- The White Sox game on Monday vs. Tampa Bay, originally scheduled for 7:10 p.m. CT, has been moved to 1:10 p.m. CT due to anticipated cold weather.
- Fans holding used or unused tickets and parking coupons for the game may redeem them for a comparable ticket to any future White Sox game (excluding the Cubs series) and based on availability ... tickets may be redeemed at the Guaranteed Rate Field box office beginning at 10 a.m. on 4/10.
- WGN-TV, WGN Radio AM-720 and WRTO-AM 1200/Univision Radio will broadcast the game.

WELCOME BACK MAGGLIO

- Former White Sox and Tigers great Magglio Ordóñez will throw out a ceremonial first pitch.
- Ordóñez batted .307 (1,167-4,214) with 187 home runs and 703 RBI in 1,001 games over eight seasons with the Sox (1997-2004) ... he ranks fifth in franchise history in home runs and 10th in RBI.
- Ordóñez won three Silver Sluggers, was a three-time American League All-Star and won the AL batting title with the Tigers in 2007 (.363).

QUALITY IS JOB ONE

- The White Sox have made a major-league leading 1,317 quality starts since the start of the 2003 season, four more than the Mets and 46 more than Oakland, the next-closest American League team.

WHO'S HOT?

- Avisail García is hitting .381/.433/.548 (75-197) over his last 52 games dating back to 8/10/17.
- José Abreu is batting .356/.395/.673 (37-104) with seven home runs and 21 RBI over his last 28 games (since 9/9/17).
- Tim Anderson owns a .336 average (43-128) with six homers, 15 RBI and 27 runs scored over his last 31 games (since 9/3/17).

HAWK'S FAREWELL

- Ken "Hawk" Harrelson, who is in his 33rd and final season in the White Sox television booth in 2018, will call tomorrow's game alongside Steve Stone.
- Harrelson will work primarily Sunday home games this season as well as select other contests ... he will serve the organization as a team ambassador throughout the 2019 season, which will mark the beginning of his eighth decade in baseball.

WHITE SOX VS. DETROIT

- The Tigers lead the season series, 1-0.
- The White Sox went 10-9 in 2017 for their first season series victory over the Tigers since 2008 ... they won six of the nine games at home, outscoring Detroit by a 48-26 margin.
- The Sox batted .292/.351/.466 with a 5.01 ERA (93 ER/167.0 IP) and outscored the Tigers, 103-98.
- Chicago is 61-89 against Detroit since 2010 (36-39 at home).
- The White Sox trail in the all-time series, 1,049-1,088 ... they are 562-510 in Chicago (125-95 at Guaranteed Rate Field) and 487-578 in Detroit (78-87 at Comerica Park).

TIGER TAMERS

- José Abreu is a career .339/.407/.582 (95-280) hitter with 19 doubles, 15 home runs and 47 RBI in 74 career games vs. Detroit, including a .382 (45-118) average with six homers and 19 RBI in his last 31.
- Avisail García has 52 RBI in 69 games against his former team, including a 5-5 effort with seven RBI on 9/14/17 at Comerica Park ... Matt Davidson owns a .382 (21-55) average with five home runs and 14 RBI in 16 career games.
- Omar Narváez is batting .375 (18-48) with a .464 on-base percentage in 16 career games ... Yolmer Sánchez is 18-47 (.383) with 10 RBI over his last 13 games ... Wellington Castillo is 9-17 (.529) with one homer and five RBI in four career games.

LOOKING FOR CENTRAL COMMAND

- The White Sox are 2-1 against the American League Central in 2018 after going 33-43 (.434) last season.
- The Sox are 293-378 vs. the AL Central since 2009, posting a losing record every season except 2012 (37-35).

AT THE HELM

- Rick Renteria is in his second season after being named the 40th manager in White Sox history on 10/3/16.
- Renteria was the only Latino manager in the major leagues in 2017 but has been joined by Boston's Alex Cora and Washington's Dave Martinez in 2018.

ROSTER QUICK FACTS

- The Sox 25-man roster includes 13 pitchers (three LHP), two catchers, six infielders and four outfielders ... the average age is 27.7, including 28.8 for pitchers and 26.4 for position players.
- LHP Aaron Bummer, OF Nicky Delmonico, OF Adam Engel, RHP Carson Fulmer, RHP Lucas Giolito, RHP Gregory Infante, RHP Reynaldo López, RHP Juan Minaya and Moncada have made their first career Opening Day roster.

ABREU IN ELITE COMPANY

- José Abreu is one of three players in major-league history to begin his career with at least four consecutive seasons of 25-plus homers and 100-plus RBI, joining Hall-of-Famer Joe DiMaggio (1936-41) and Albert Pujols.
- Abreu also has joined Al Simmons (11, 1924-34), Pujols (10, 2001-10), Ted Williams (1939-42, '46-49) and DiMaggio (1936-42) as the only players in history to record 100 or more RBI in each of his first four seasons.
- He led the American League with 343 total bases in 2017, joining Albert Belle (399 in 1998), Minnie Miñoso (304 in 1951) and Joe Jackson (293 in 1916) as the only players in Sox history to accomplish that feat.

CALL TO THE HALL

- Jim Thome, who played for the White Sox from 2006-09 and serves as a special assistant to the general manager, will be inducted into the Baseball Hall of Fame on 7/29/18.
- Thome, who ranks eighth in major-league history with 612 home runs, received 89.8 percent of the votes to become the fifth former Sox player inducted on the first ballot.
- He will join Chipper Jones, Vladimir Guerrero, Trevor Hoffman Jack Morris and Alan Trammell in the Class of 2018.

ON THE FARM

- The White Sox minor-league system is rated by *Baseball America* as the fourth-best in baseball.
- The Sox organization features five of *Baseball America's* Top 100 prospects: OF Eloy Jiménez (No. 4), RHP Michael Kopech (No. 11), RHP Alec Hansen (No. 57), OF Luis Robert (No. 58) and RHP Dane Dunning (No. 82) ... Jiménez (No. 4), Kopech (No. 10), Robert (No. 28), Hansen (No. 54), RHP Dylan Cease (No. 71), Dunning (No. 92) and OF Blake Rutherford (No. 99) are ranked in MLB.com's Top 100.

GIOLITO AT A GLANCE

- The 23-year-old makes his second start of the season and first at home ... is 3-2 with a 2.18 ERA (11 ER/45.1 IP) over his last seven starts since 8/27/17 ... 2.18 ERA during that span ranks sixth in the American League.
- Made his first career Opening Day roster.
- Is 7-3 with a 2.00 ERA (21 ER/94.2 IP) over his last 17 starts, which includes five with Class AAA Charlotte in 2017, seven with the Sox in 2017, four in the Cactus League in 2018 and one this season.
- Went 3-2 with a 1.83 ERA (8 ER/39.1 IP) over his final six starts with the White Sox in 2017.
- Lost 10 pounds in the offseason, dropping from 255 to 245.
- Was acquired from Washington on 12/7/16 with RHP Dane Dunning and RHP Reynaldo López in exchange for OF Adam Eaton.

LAST START

● Posted a no decision on 3/31 at Kansas City, allowing three runs on four hits over 6.0 IP ... walked four and struck out one ... made his seventh quality start in nine outings since joining the White Sox ... gave up two runs in the first inning on one hit, two walks and a HBP and one in the third ... held the Royals scoreless on one hit over his final 3.0 IP ... left with a 3-1 deficit after throwing 89 pitches (49 strikes) ... Sox rallied to win, 4-3.

SPRING RECAP

● Went 2-0 with a 2.04 ERA (4 ER/17.1 IP) over four spring starts ... threw 42 pitches in his final outing on 3/25 in a minor-league game vs. the Dodgers ... worked 6.1 scoreless IP in his final Cactus League start on 3/20 vs. Texas, allowing two hits with no walks and four strikeouts ... surrendered one run on two hits with eight strikeouts over 4.0 IP on 3/10 at the Cubs.

2017 RECAP

- Made 24 starts with Class AAA Charlotte and seven with the White Sox in his first season in the organization.
- Went 3-2 with a 1.83 ERA (8 ER/39.1 IP), 30 strikeouts, a .177 (25-141) opponents average and 0.94 WHIP over his final six starts ... five of the outings were quality.
- Was recalled on 8/23 and made his White Sox debut that night vs. Minnesota (4 ER/6.0 IP; 3 HR) ... earned his first win with the Sox on 8/27 vs. Detroit, allowing just three hits over 7.0 scoreless IP.
- Allowed one run and struck out a career-high 10 over 7.0 IP on 9/3 vs. Tampa Bay ... became the first Sox pitcher to strike out 10-plus batters within his first three starts with the club since Chris Sale in 2012.
- Received a ND on 9/13 at Kansas City, allowing one run on four hits in 6.1 IP ... became the 15th Sox pitcher to make four-plus straight starts of 5.0-plus IP and four hits or less allowed.
- Earned the win in his final start of the season on 9/24 vs. Kansas City ... gave up one run on five hits over 7.0 IP.
- Began the season with Charlotte ... at the time of his promotion, ranked among the IL leaders in shutouts (2nd), starts (T2nd), strikeouts (3rd), SO/9.0 (4th, 9.37) and IP (7th).
- Made 10 quality starts, allowed two runs or less eight times and worked 7.0-plus IP in five outings ... recorded double-digit strikeouts on 6/5 vs. Durham (11) and 7/8 at Louisville (10).
- Went 3-1 with a 1.71 ERA (6 ER/31.2 IP), 28 strikeouts and just two home runs allowed over his final five starts ... threw his first professional no-hitter on 5/25-1 vs. Syracuse (7.0 IP), marking the first no-hitter in BB&T Ballpark history ... was named IL Pitcher of the Week for 5/22-28.
- Entered the season ranked by MLB.com as the No. 12 Prospect in baseball.

DAY AND NIGHT

● Went 3-0 with a 0.99 ERA (3 ER/27.1 IP) and .156 (15-96) opponents average over four afternoon starts in 2017, compared to 0-3 with a 4.50 ERA (9 ER/18.0 IP) and .239 (16-67) opponents average at night.

● Allowed one or no runs in all four of his starts during the day and lasted 7.0 IP three times ... his 0.99 ERA would have led the American League with the required IP.

IT'S ALL ME

- Is one of 35 members of the Taylor Hooton Foundation advisory board, which is recognized as the leader in advocacy against appearance and performance enhancing drug use by the youth of America.
- The advisory board is comprised of at least one member from each of the 30 Major League clubs ... the players will participate in the THF 2018 public service campaign, including "It's All Me" themed PSAs which will appear in MLB's 2018 All-Star Game, League Championship Series and World Series programs.
