RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals are 40-27 post All-Star Break and 41-27 under manager **Mike Shildt** since he took the post on July 15. The Cardinals are 1st in wins (40) in the National League since the All-Star Break, while St. Louis' .597 winning percentage ranks 7th in MLB over that period. Entering July 15, the Cardinals had T9th-most wins in the NL (47) and currently have the 6th-most wins (88) in the NL.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals snapped their 4-game losing streak with a 2-1 win behind **Miles Mikolas** yesterday and guaranteed themselves a winning record (10-8) in their season series against the Cubs...St. Louis enters play today in 3rd place in the N.L. Wild Card race, 6.0 games back of Milwaukee and 2.0 games back of the Dodgers...the Cardinals are currently in 3rd place in the NL Central, 6.0 games out of first place.

WINNING SEASONS: The Cardinals have posted their 11th consecutive winning season, something they'd done just once previously in franchise history, when they compiled 15 consecutive winning seasons from 1939-1953.

PERFECT ROAD: **Miles Mikolas** improved to a perfect 10-0 on the road with yesterday's win, becoming only the 3rd pitcher in MLB dating to 1908 to post a 1.000 winning pct. on the road while winning 10 or more games...the only others to do so were **Greg Maddux**, ATL (13-0 in 1995) and **Jimmy Key**, NYY (10-0 in 1994).

CATCH THIS: **Yadier Molina** hit his 20th homer on Tuesday, two shy of his career high 22 in 2012...Yadier joined **Ted Simmons** (1977 & 1979) as the lone Cardinals catchers with multiple 20+ homer seasons.

CARPENTER CHASING N.L. HR TITLE: **Matt Carpenter** hit his NL-leading 36th home run last Sunday and is trying to become just the 8th Cardinal (12th instance) to lead the league in round-trippers: **Albert Pujols** (2009-10); **Mark McGwire** (1998-99); **Johnny Mize** (1939-40); **Joe Medwick** (1937); **Rip Collins** (1934); **Jim Bottomley** (1928) and **Rogers Hornsby** (1922 & 1925).

A TASTE FOR CHICAGO: **Matt Carpenter** has hit eight home runs in 18 games against the Cubs this season, the most by any opposing player in 2018, and tied with **Jim Edmonds** (2004), **Albert Pujols** (2004), **Stan Musial** (1950) and **Rogers Hornsby** (1925) for most in a season among Cardinals. The most ever hit in a single season by a Cubs opposing player was **Ralph Kiner** (13, PIT, 1949). Carpenter's eight are the most since **Greg Vaughn** hit nine in 13 games vs. CHI with Cincinnati in 1999...**WRIGLEY WALLOPS:** **Carpenter** has hit six homers at Wrigley Field this season (all during July 19-22 five-game series), tying **Les Bell** (1925) for the most in a single-season by a Cardinal.

POWER PLAY: St. Louis has homered in 115 of 161 games this season, going 77-38 (.670 win pct.) in those games (11-35 when not homering)...their 77 wins lead the NL & rank 6th in MLB (Yankees, 1st-90)...St. Louis' 205 HR's are 3rd in NL behind the Dodgers (230) & Brewers (216)...**HOMERS AWAY FROM HOME:** St. Louis is an NL-best 41-20 (.672) when homering on the road, and trails only Oakland (134) in road homers (122) among all Major League teams.

TRIPLES TRIVIA: The Cardinals have hit a Major League low nine triples this season and finished with a record single-season low of four at Busch Stadium III...the Cardinals have never finished a season in single-digits in three-baggers.

GAMES THAT MATTER: Yesterday, the Cardinals played their 1,292nd regular season game out of 1,294, dating back to Opening Day of 2011, during which they still maintain playoff aspirations and had not yet to be eliminated. "**MO**"- **MENTUM:** In their 11 seasons under President of Baseball Operations **John "Mo" Mozeliak**, the Cardinals have won 984 regular season games, trailing only the Yankees (1,009) & Dodgers (989), while they & the Yankees are the only teams to have posted 11 consecutive winning (+.500) seasons in that time period.

FARM SYSTEM: The Cardinals 492-402 (.550) overall organizational record placed them 2nd behind Tampa Bay (539-345; .604) in total wins among all minor league systems this year...Memphis (AAA) won its 2nd-consecutive Pacific Coast League title and the Triple-A National Championship Game and Peoria (A) reached the Midwest League Championship Series.

TODAY'S GAME

- Rookie makes his 28th start of the season & 34th career app. (33rd start). His 28 starts are the most by a Cardinals rookie since Shelby Miller (31) in 2013.
- Leads all MLB rookies and the Cardinals with his 179 strikeouts (T11th in the NL). Next closest rookie in strikeouts is Walker Buehler (LAD) with 148.
- Ranks 3rd all-time in Cards single-season history for rookies, trailing only Dizzy Dean (191 in 1932) and Rick Ankiel (194 in 2000) are ahead.
- Has struck out 92 batters post All-Star Break, 6th-most among NL pitchers.
- His 199 strikeouts in first 33 career games are the most ever by a Cardinal.
- Averages 10.86 strikeouts/9 IP this season, ranking 4th all-time for rookie pitchers behind Kerry Wood (12.58 in 1998), Dwight Gooden (11.39 in 1984) and Hideo Nomo (11.10 in 1995), all who went on to win Rookie of the Year awards.
- His .196 average against ranks as the T6th-lowest mark in MLB history among rookies with at least 25 starts. Jose Fernandez (2013) and Hideo Nomo (1995) are first at .182.
- Limited the opposition to one run or fewer in 15 of 27 starts, ranking T4th among N.L. pitchers (J. deGrom - 18). Held opposition to 4 ER or fewer 26 of 27 starts.
- Leads NL rookies in win pct. (.500), opponent BA (.196) and strikeouts (179). Ranks in the Top 10 in wins (8, T1st), ERA (3.16, 3rd), innings (148.1, 2nd) and starts (27, 2nd).
- 14 of the 25 runs he's allowed over his last 13 starts have come via home run.
- Has the 2nd-lowest ERA in the NL of pitchers who have allowed 18 or more home runs this season, behind Max Scherzer (2.53, 23 HR).
- Looking to earn his first career win in September in nine career starts (10 app.).
- Ranks T4th among NL pitchers with 11 hit batsmen, including four Cubs batters.
- St. Louis has lost his last five starts (9/3-present).
- Has received one run or fewer of support in 11 of his starts & 2 runs or less in 17 starts. He's 7-0 (STL 8-2) in games which he receives 3 or more runs of support.

- Allowed three runs over 5.1 innings in a come-from-behind 6-4 loss to the Brewers in last Monday's (9/24) series opener at Bush Stadium.

- Threw 5.0 innings allowing one run on two hits and struck out nine batters (110 pitches) in an 18-5 rout of the Cubs while pitching opposite Jon Lester. His 15 runs of support were the most by a Cardinal since Lance Lynn (15 at CIN, 8/4/13) and most against the Cubs since Garrett Stephenson (13 on 4/6/2000).
- Worked 5.0 scoreless frames to lead St. Louis to a 5-0 shutout win over the Cubs on ESPN Sunday Night Baseball on Father's Day (6/17) at Busch Stadium.
- Became the 3rd Cardinals starting pitcher 22 years or younger to throw at least 5.0 shutout innings in a start against the Cubs since 1963, joining Andy Rincon (9.0 IP, 4/21/1981) and Shelby Miller (5.0, IP, 6/17/13).
