- TRIBE HEADLINES

 » Cleveland leads the Majors in a number of categories this July,
- including runs scored (143), extra-base hits (90), stolen bases (22), team batting average (.284) and runs per game (6.22).

 » The Tribe holds a 30-14 record against the A.L. Central this season, posting a 2.75 ERA (121ER/396.2IP) that ranks as the lowest intradivisional mark in MLB...Tribe's .682 intradivisional winning percentage is the 2nd-best in the Majors, behind Boston (.702).
- » Cleveland's bullpen has posted a 0.96 ERA (2ER/18.2IP) over its past six games...Tribe relievers rank 2nd in the American League
- since the All-Star break with a 3.07 collective ERA (10ER/29.1IP). » YONDER ALONSO ranks 3rd in the American League with five second-half home runs...he has slugged five longballs in his past eight contests after hitting just five in his previous 61.
- "SHANE BIEBER is set to make his third career start against the Minnesota Twins tonight, owning a 1-0 record with a 3.97 ERA (5ER/11.1IP) in two previous outings...his rate of 1.60 walks per 9.0 innings ranks 2nd-lowest among MLB rookies (min. 40.0IP).

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

- » The Indians improved to 25-10 in series finales as they won their rubber match, 8-1, Sunday afternoon at Detroit.
- » The win ensured that Cleveland will finish the month of July with a winning record...dating back to May 2016, the Tribe has posted a record of .500-or-better in 14 of their last 15 months, including each of their last eight (went 13-14 in May 2017).
- » Cleveland's offense erupted for 16 hits, with three different players turning in three-hit efforts...**YONDER ALONSO** went 3-for-5 a two-run homer, a double and three RBI overall...**MELKY CABRE-** RA also went 3-for-5, belting a solo shot for his first homer as a member of the Indians...RAJAI DAVIS collected three extra-base hits out of the ninth spot of the batting order, slugging two doubles and a triple in a 3-for-5 effort...EDWIN ENCARNACION (2-4) tacked on a solo homer, his 24th longball of the season, and drove in a pair of runs.
- » COREY KLUBER continued his A.L. Central dominance, earning his 13th win after holding Detroit to one run on five hits over 7.1 innings of work (1BB, 5K)...Kluber is now 8-1 with a 1.62 ERA (11ER/61.0IP) in nine intradivisional starts this season.

SEEING DOUBLE

- The Indians are set to begin their fourth of six series against the
- Minnesota Twins, as well as their last at Target Field this season. » The clubs last met June 15-17 at Progressive Field, when Min nesota claimed two of three games...the Twins took three of four contests from May 31-June 3 in the teams' only previous matchup in Minnesota this season.
- » Overall, the Indians own a 3-6 record vs. the Twins this season, going 1-2 at Progressive Field, 1-1 in Puerto Rico and 1-3 at Target Field...the Tribe is at least five games over .500 against every other team in the A.L. Central division

CENTRAL DOMINANCE

- Cleveland has gone 30-14 against the A.L. Central, with a record of 9-3-2 in series play...the Indians' .682 intradivisional winning percentage ranks 2nd in the A.L. and MLB (Boston - .702)...the Tribe
- has gone 18-4 in divisional home games and 12-10 on the road.

 » In 44 games vs. the A.L. Central, Tribe pitchers have posted a 2.75 ERA (121ER/396.2IP), marking the lowest intradivisional ERA in Major League Baseball.
- » The Tribe has allowed three-or-fewer runs in 31 of those 44 games, posting a 27-4 record in those contests.

SCORE TACTICS

- The Tribe leads the Majors in the month of July in runs scored (143), steals (22), team batting average (.284), runs per game (6.22), extra-base hits (90) and doubles (51, T1st).

 » Cleveland also ranks 2nd in team slugging percentage (.486),
- 2nd in OPS (.835), 3rd in on-base percentage (.349) and T4th in home runs (33) this month.
- » Overall this season, the Tribe's 540 runs scored are 2nd-most in MLB (BOS 569)...they additionally sit 2nd with 147 home runs (NYY 167), 2nd with 80 stolen bases (MIL 84), 3rd with 366 extra-base hits and 3rd with a .259 team batting average.

- THE SHANE EVENT

 » Right-hander SHANE BIEBER is set to make the ninth start of his Major League career in tonight's season opener at Minnesota. » Bieber last pitched on July 24 vs. Pittsburgh, where he took the
- loss in a career-low 1.2 innings of work (7H, 7R/ER, 0BB, 2K). » Will be making his third start against Minnesota, after facing them in each of his first two career outings...took a no-decision at Target Field in his Major League debut on May 31 (5.2IP, 8H, 4R/ER, 1BB, 6K) and picked up his first career win on June 17 at Progressive Field (5.2IP, 10H, 1R/ER, 1BB, 7K).
- » Bieber has allowed two-or-fewer walks in each of his first eight career MLB starts...in the Baseball-Reference Play Index era (1908-), his streak is tied with **T.J. House** (8 starts, 2014) for the 3rd-longest by an Indians pitcher to begin his career, trailing only Cody Anderson (12 starts, 2015) and Eric Raich (9 starts, 1975).

 » Among rookie pitchers with at least 40.0 innings this season,
- Bieber's overall rate of 1.60 walks per 9.0 innings (8BB/45.0IP) is lowest in the American League and 2nd-lowest in MLB (PIT's Edgar Santana - 0.94).

- (ALON)SO HOT RIGHT NOW

 » YONDER ALONSO homered for the fifth time in his past eight
- games with a two-run shot yesterday afternoon.

 » After hitting just five home runs between April 29 and July 20. Alonso's five second-half home runs rank T3rd in the A.L. behind OAK's **Khris Davis** and BAL's **Jonathan Schoop** (7 each).
- » Alonso has batted .308 (56-182) since May 22, 2nd-highest among A.L. first basemen in that span (HOU's **Yuli Gurriel** .309).

THE MELKMAN DELIVERS

- » MELKY CABRERA hit his first homer as a member of the Indians yesterday as part of a 3-for-5 effort.
- » Cabrera has hit safely in all seven of his starts since being recalled on July 20, batting .407 (11-27) with a homer, two doubles and three runs scored in his second stint with Cleveland.

- RAJAI FOR EFFORT

 » RAJAI DAVIS went 3-for-5 with two doubles and a triple yesterday...became the first Tribe hitter with three extra-base hits out of the ninth spot of the order since **Drew Stubbs** did so on May 23, 2013 at Boston (also two doubles and a triple).

 » Davis is batting .323 (10-31) in 13 games (8 starts) since July 2,
- collecting three doubles, a triple and four runs scored in that span.

PARROT SIGHTING

- » EDWIN ENCARNACION belted his 24th homer of the season with a 7th-inning solo shot, and he enters play today ranked T10th in the American League in homers...Cleveland is one of just two MLB teams boasting three players in their respective league's Top 10 (Colorado also has three).
- » Encarnacion is batting .344 (11-32) across his last eight games with three homers, two doubles, 10 RBI and seven runs scored.

LONG BOMBS AWAY

- » Yesterday marked Cleveland's 46th game with multiple home runs, tied with Boston for the 2nd-most in MLB (NYY 48).
- » Cleveland's 147 home runs through 102 team games are their most since slugging 159 at this juncture of the 2000 season, en route to a franchise-record 221 longballs.

MISC. PITCHING NOTES

- The Indians bullpen has performed well in the second half, posting a 3.07 ERA (10ER/29.1IP) since the All-Star break...Cleveland relievers currently rank 2nd in the A.L. (6th in MLB) in secondhalf ERA, and have posted a 0.96 mark (2ER/18.2IP) over the Tribe's last six games
- » Recent acquisitions BRAD HAND and ADAM CIMBER have each made four appearances for their new club...Hand has posted a 2.25 ERA (1ER/4.0IP) with four strikeouts and a save, while Cimber has tossed 2.2 scoreless innings (3H, 0BB).
- » Cleveland starting pitchers have combined for a 3.50 ERA (253ER/660.1IP) this season, the 2nd-lowest mark in the A.L. (4thlowest in MLB)...Tribe starters have also turned in 64 quality starts, 2nd-most in MLB behind Houston (73).

TONIGHT'S START

» The 23-year-old rookie is set to make his ninth career start tonight in the Tribe's series opener against the Minnesota Twins

» The 23-year-old rookie is set to make his ninth career start tonight in the Tribe's series opener against the Minnesota Twins.
» Will be pitching tonight on extended five days' rest after his last start on July 24 vs. Pittsburgh...suffered his second career loss, allowing a career-high seven runs on seven hits in just 1.2 innings (2HR, 2K).
» Bieber is due to face the Twins for the third time this season and has posted a 1-0 mark and 3.97 ERA (5ER/11.1IP) in his two prior starts...last started vs. Minnesota on June 17 at Progressive Field (W, 5.2IP, 10H, 1R/ER, 1BB, 7K).
» Makes his fourth road start of the season tonight...has posted a 2-0 record and 4.58 ERA (9ER/17.2IP) in his three outings...earned the win in his last road start on July 3 at Kansas City (6.0IP, 9H, 4R/ER, 1HR, 1BB, 2K)...last pitched at Target Field in his Major League debut on May 31 (ND, 5.2IP, 8H, 4R/ER, 2HR, 1BB, 6K).
» Bieber has allowed just eight walks in his eight Major League starts this season (45.0IP)...his 1.60 BB/9 is the lowest among American League rookie pitchers and 2nd-lowest in MLB (min. 40.0IP), trailing Pittsburgh reliever Edgar Santana (0.94)... Bieber's 1.60 BB/9 also leads all MLB rookie starting pitchers (min. 40.0IP).
» Has posted a 5.50 SO/BB ratio, the top mark among MLB rookie starting pitchers (min. 40.0IP) and 2nd-best by any rookie pitcher, behind Pittsburgh's Santana (8.80).
» He has also allowed two-or-fewer walks in each of his first eight career starts, which is tied with T.J. House (8GS, May 23-July 10, 2014) for the 3rd-longest streak by an Indians starting pitcher in the Baseball Reference Play Index era (1908-)...only CODY ANDERSON (12GS, June 21-September 13, 2015) and Eric Raich (9GS, May 24-July 4, 1975) have posted longer streaks.
» Bieber has 44 strikeouts in his first eight career starts, which is tied with Steve Dunning (1970) for the 3rd-most in Cleveland franchise history, behind Herb Score (77) and DANNY SALAZAR (54).<

2018 CLEVELAND RECAP

» Earned his fifth win on July 13, marking the first Indians pitcher with five wins in his first seven career starts since CC Sabathia did so in 2001.

» Won his fourth career game on July 3 at Kansas City, becoming the third Tribe pitcher in the Baseball Reference Play Index era (1908-) with four wins in his first five career starts, joining John Farrell (1987) and Scott Lewis (2008-09).

» On June 22 vs. Detroit, Bieber became the sixth Indians pitcher since 1908 to record a start with 7.0-or-more shutout innings and four-or-fewer hits allowed within his first three career starts, and the first since Scott Lewis did so on September 10, 2008 at Baltimore...at 23.022 years old marked the youngest pitcher in franchise history to achieve that feat, surpassing Ray Benge (23.157), who did so on Sept. 26, 1925 at Philadelphia.

» Bieber fanned a career-high nine Tigers hitters in the outing, becoming the first

» Bieber fanned a career-high nine Tigers hitters in the outing, becoming the first Indians pitcher since Luis Tiant in 1964 with six-or-more strikeouts in each of his first three career appearances...his 22 strikeouts combined across his first three career starts tied him with DANNY SALAZAR (also 22) for the 3rd-most strikeouts in a

pitcher's first three career appearances in Indians franchise history.

» Earned his first career win on June 17 vs. Minnesota...allowed one run on 11 hits in 5.2 innings, with one walk...fanned seven batters, becoming the fourth pitcher in Indians franchise history to strike out six-or-more batters in each of his first two career starts and first since DANNY SALAZAR did so in his first two appearances from July 11 - August 7, 2013.

Made his Major League debut against the Twins at Target Field on May 31...did not factor into the decision in the Tribe's 9-8 win (5.2IP, 8H, 4R/ER, 2HR, 1BB, 6K)...struck out six batters, including his first career batter faced (Brian Dozier), marking the most punchouts in a Tribe pitcher's first Major League start since SALAZAR fanned seven in his MLB debut on July 11, 2013 vs. Toronto.
Bieber became the first pitcher in Indians franchise history to make his Major League debut on his birthday, as well as the second player after outfielder Daye Clark

League debut on his birthday, as well as the second player after outfielder Dave Clark on September 3, 1986 at Toronto.

2018 MILB RECAP

» This season, Bieber has compiled a 6-1 record and 1.47 ERA (13ER/79.2IP) in 13 combined starts between AA Akron and AAA Columbus.

» Was called up to the Indians on May 31 and made seven starts for the Tribe be-

tween then and his return to the Clippers on July 14, posting a 5-1 record and 3.53 ERA

(17ER/43.1IP).

» Did not allow a run until his fourth start of the year, a career-long scoreless streak of 22.0 innings, dating back to his last start in 2017...overall this season, has recorded five scoreless starts and allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in 12 of 13 outings.

» Has a 3-1 record with a 1.66 ERA (9ER/48.2IP) in eight starts with Columbus, with 47 strikeouts and just six walks allowed in his 48.2 innings...marks his first career action in Triple-A...from May 3 - June 6, did not walk a batter, a span of 30.1 innings.

» Tossed a rain-shortened no-hitter on May 25 at Gwinnett, striking out seven batters and walking none in the 7.0 inning outing...the lone Gwinnett baserunner reached on an error in the bottom of the 3rd...marked the 8th no-hitter in Columbus franchise history.

» Began the season at AA Akron, where he went a perfect 3-0 with a 1.16 ERA (4ER/31.0IP) in five starts prior to his May 3 call-up to Columbus...was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week for April 5-15.

» Named the pitcher with the Best Control in the Indians Player Development System, according to Baseball America at the beginning of the season...also placed on the Tribe pre-season top prospect rankings in Baseball America - 5th, Baseball Prospectus - 5th and ESPN.Com/Keith Law - 10th.

CAREER SNAPSHOT

» The Orange, California native was selected in the 4th Round (122nd overall) of the June, 2016 MLB Draft out of the University of California-Santa Barbara.

» Posted a 23-12 record and 2.73 ERA (91ER/300.0IP) from 2014-16 for UC Santa Barbara, with 237 strikeouts and just 38 walks...earned several honors over the course of his college career, including being named 2015 All-Big West Second Team, 2016 Preseason Big West Pitcher of the Year, 2016 All-Big West First Team and 2016 Rawlings Second Team All-American

Second Team All-American Second Team All-American.

» Made his professional debut with Short-Season Mahoning Valley in 2016, making eight starts and one relief appearance for the Scrappers...after allowing one run in his first appearance on July 22, did not surrender an earned run in his final eight outings of the year, a span of 21.0 innings...overall on the year, posted a 0-0 record and 0.38 ERA (1ER/24.0IP), with 21 strikeouts and just two walks allowed.

» Divided the 2017 season between A Lake County, High-A Lynchburg and AA Akron, combing for a 10-5 record and 2.86 ERA (55ER/173.1IP).

» Began the year with Lake County and earned his first career win on April 14 at Lansing, tossing 6.0 innings and allowing one run on four hits while walking none and striking out a career-best 11 batters...went 2-3 with a 3.10 ERA (10ER/29.0IP) in five starts

with the Captains prior to his promotion to Lynchburg on May 5.

» After taking a loss on June 6 at Salem, won his next four starts, a then-career long streak...went 4-0 with a 1.05 ERA (3ER/25.2IP) in those outings, with 29 strikeouts... won the Carolina League Pitcher of the Week award for June 19-25, after matching his career high 11 punchouts on June 22 vs. Frederick...overall went 6-1 with a 3.10 ERA (31ER/90.0IP) in 14 starts for the Hillicats.

» Was called up to AAAkron on July 24 and finished the season with the RubberDucks...

earned his first caeer Double-A win on August 4 at Reading, tossing 6.0 innings and allowing one run on six hits, with zero walks and seven strikeouts...posted a 2-1 record and 2.32 ERA (14ER/54.1IP) in nine starts for Akron.

» In 2017, led all pitchers in the Indians organization with 173.1 innings pitched and ranked among the leaders in ERA (2.86, 2nd), strikeouts (162, 2nd) and wins (10, T4th).
