### CHICAGO WHITE SOX (29-55) at CINCINNATI REDS (37-48)

#### WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox have lost four of the last five games and 13 of the last 18 as they continue a season-long, 10-game trip tonight with the second game at Cincinnati.
- RHP Lucas Giolito is scheduled to start for the White Sox, who are trying to avoid falling a season-high 27 games under .500.
- The Sox opened the trip by losing two of three at Texas, avoiding a sweep with a 10-5 in Sunday's finale.
- Following tomorrow night's series finale at Great American Ball Park, the White Sox will conclude the trip with four games at Houston before ending the first half with a five-game, six-day homestand vs. St. Louis (7/10-11) and Kansas City (7/13-15).
- The Sox went 4-3 on their last homestand vs. Oakland (2-2) and Minnesota (2-1) from 6/22-28 and 0-3 on their last trip to Cleveland from 6/18-20.

#### TONIGHT'S STORYLINES

- Chicago is 1-6 in its last seven road games and has been outscored by a 58-25 margin during that span.
- The White Sox are 1-7 in their eight interleague road games this season, scoring two runs or less five times.
- The Sox are 11-51 (.216) with RISP and have left 40 runners on base over the last five games.
- Lucas Giolito is making his first road start since 6/5 at Minnesota ... he owns a 4.50 ERA (21 ER/42.0 IP) on the road, compared to an 8.65 mark (41 ER/42.2 IP) in Chicago.
- Avisail García owns a career-high, 12-game hitting streak (since 4/22) ... he is hitting .365 (19-52) with two doubles, two triples, four home runs, eight RBI and five multihit efforts.

#### LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

- Cincinnati overcame a two-run deficit by scoring four runs in the bottom of the eighth inning off Chris Volstad in its 5-3 victory.
- The White Sox led 3-1 entering the bottom of the eighth but the Reds loaded the bases with one and scored four times on an Adam Duvall fielders choice, Billy Hamilton sacrifice fly and Alex Blandino game-winning, two-run double.
- James Shields received a ND despite allowing just one run, a Scott Shebler leadoff home run on four hits over 6.2 IP.
- Avisail García went 2-4 with a solo homer to extend his hitting streak to a career-high 12 games ... Yoán Moncada was 2-5 with two doubles and a RBI ... the Sox left nine runners on base.
- José Abreu (0-3) left the game in the seventh with a bruised left ankle ... his 19-game interleague hitting streak was snapped.

#### HE'S ON FIRE ... AVI-OUSLY

- Avisail García is currently on a 12-game hitting streak, the longest of his career, longest active and tied for the 12th-longest in MLB this season ... it is the longest streak by a White Sox in a season since Tim Anderson from 9/9-24/17 (15 games).
- He is 11-24 (.458) with two doubles, two triples, two homers and four RBI in his last five games, and 16-46 (.348) with four homers and seven RBI in 11 games since returning from the DL.

#### HOME AWAY FROM HOME

- Lucas Giolito is 3-3 with a 4.50 ERA (21 ER/42.0 IP) and .238 opponents average (36-151) over his seven road starts ... he has allowed three earned runs or less in six of the outings.
- By comparison, has allowed 42 runs on 47 hits, including 12 walks and eight homers, over 42.2 IP at Guaranteed Rate Field.

#### JOSÉ GOES STREAKING

- José Abreu is batting .385/.402/.744 (30-78) with eight doubles, one triple, six home runs, 15 RBI and nine multihit efforts over his last 20 interleague games since 2017.
- His 19-game IL hitting streak from 7/26/17-6/3/18 was the second-longest in franchise history behind Paul Konerko (20; 2004-05), and the longest in MLB since Minnesota's Joe Mauer and the Angels' Mike Trout from 2013-14 (20).

#### ON THE MEND

- Class AAA Charlotte OF Eloy Jiménez and Class A Winston-Salem OF Luis Robert have been placed on the disabled list.
- Jiménez has been diagnosed with a strain of his left adductor muscle, and is expected to return in approximately two weeks.
- Robert has been diagnosed with a moderate sprain to the ligament in his left thumb ... he is expected to return to game action in approximately 4-8 weeks.
- Jiménez is hitting .293/.383/.463 with two home runs and four RBI in 12 games with Charlotte this season ... Robert was 9-30 (.300) with one double and five RBI in eight games with the Dash.

#### WHITE SOX VS. CINCINNATI REDS

- The White Sox and Reds are meeting for the first time since 2015, and first at Great American Ball Park since 2009.
- Chicago has won four of the last six games and 13 of the last 16 ... it won nine straight from 6/5/00-6/18/06.
- The Sox won two of three vs. the Reds in the last meeting from 5/9-10 in Chicago, and earned a series victory in the last matchup in Cincinnati from 6/19-21/09.
- Chicago leads the all-time series, 16-5, going 6-2 at Guaranteed Rate Field and 10-3 in Cincinnati (5-2 at GABP).

#### WINDY AND QUEEN CITY CONNECTIONS

- White Sox OF Adam Engel (1991) and first-base coach Daryl Boston (1963) were both born in Cincinnati.
- Buddy Bell, the Reds' Vice President/Senior Advisor to the GM, previously served as the White Sox Vice President/Assistant GM.
- Reds pitching coach Danny Darwin pitched for the Sox in 1997.
- Chicago and Cincinnati played in the first ever Civil Rights Game during the regular season on 6/20/09 at Great American Ball Park ... the White Sox earned a 10-8 win.

#### INTERLEAGUE INSIGHT

- The White Sox are 3-10 during interleague play, winning three of the last seven after losing each of the first six contests ... they have been held to two runs or less six times this season.
- Chicago has lost 10 of the last 11 games and 18 of 21 IL games on the road ... the club has not won consecutive road IL games since 8/12-13/16 at Miami.
- The Sox went 6-14 during IL play last season and have not recorded a winning record since 2014 (11-9).
- The Sox are 209-187 all-time during IL play (since 1997).

#### BULLPEN BREAKDOWN

- The Sox bullpen has allowed a run in six straight games, recording a 7.29 ERA (17 ER/21.0 IP) and .259 opp. average.
- Joakim Soria has made 14 straight scoreless appearances (14.1 IP), converting all eight save chances with just seven hits allowed, two walks and 16 strikeouts.
- Rookie Jace Fry owns a 2.49 ERA (7 ER/25.1 IP) with 32 strikeouts and a .144 (13-90) opp. average in 25 games in 2018.
- Xavier Cedeño has allowed just one earned run over 12 relief appearances (13 SO/9.2 IP) since joining the White Sox on 6/7.

#### 30/30 THREAT

- SS Tim Anderson (13 HR/17 SB) this season is one of six players in the major leagues with at least 13 home runs and 13 stolen bases, joining Javier Báez, Andrew Benintendi, Mookie Betts, José Ramírez and Mike Trout.
- Anderson is on pace for career highs with 25 homers and 33 steals ... the 26 homers would be the third-highest total by a Sox shortstop behind José Valentín (30 in 2004 and 28 in 2003), and the 33 steals would be the most since Ozzie Guillén in 1989 (36).

#### STOP! THIEF!

- The Sox are tied for the MLB lead with 65 steals ... the Sox are on pace to steal 125 bases, which would be their most since 2010 (160) ... they have not led MLB in steals since 1966 (153).
- Tim Anderson ranks second in the AL with 17 steals in 2018.

#### TRIPLE THE FUN

- The White Sox rank second in the major leagues this season with 25 triples, and are on pace for 48 ... the Sox led the AL with 37 triples last season, their most since 1999 (also 37).
- Yolmer Sánchez is tied for the major-league lead with eight triples in 2018 after ranking sixth last season with eight.

#### QUALITY AND QUANTITY

- Reynaldo López (T12th, 11) and James Shields (T12th, 11) rank in the Top 15 in the American League in QS in 2018.
- The White Sox have made a major-league leading 1,350 quality starts since the start of the 2003 season, three more than the second-place New York Mets (1,347) and 43 more than Oakland (1,307), the next-closest American League team.

#### PITO STILL FIRST AT FIRST

- José Abreu continues to lead American League first basemen in fan balloting for the MLB All-Star Game ... All-Star starters and reserves will be announced on Sunday, 7/8 on the ASG Selection Show presented by Camping World starting at 6:00 p.m. CT.
- Abreu is the first White Sox to lead at any point in the balloting process since Frank Thomas won the fan election at 1B in 1996.
- He would be the sixth Sox player (11th time) to be fan-elected as a starter to the All-Star Team, joining Thomas (1994-96), Carlton Fisk (1981-82), Richie Zisk (1977), Dick Allen (1972-74) and Luis Aparicio (1970).

#### GIOLITO AT A GLANCE

- The 23-year-old makes his 17th start of the season (eighth on the road) and fourth in interleague play.
- Is 1-0 with a 3.38 ERA (5 ER/13.1 IP) and 11 strikeouts over his last two starts.
- Is 2-4 with an 8.65 ERA (41 ER/42.2 IP) in nine starts at home and 3-3 with a 4.50 ERA (21 ER/42.0 IP) in seven road starts this season.
- Ranks last among major-league pitchers (minimum 15 starts) in ERA (6.59) and SO/BB ratio (1.00) and third-to-last in walks per 9.0 IP (5.42) and on-base percentage (.372).
- Owns an 8.44 ERA (15 ER/16.0 IP) and .449 opponents on-base percentage in the first inning this season but has lowered that mark to 1.80 (1 ER/5.0 IP) over his last five outings.
- Has received zero runs of support seven times and one run on two occasions.
- Made his first career Opening Day roster.
- Lost 10 pounds in the offseason, dropping from 255 to 245.
- Was acquired from Washington on 12/7/16 with RHP Dane Dunning and RHP Reynaldo López in exchange for OF Adam Eaton.

#### LAST START

● Posted a no decision on 6/28 vs. Minnesota despite allowing one run on four hits over 6.1 IP ... walked four and struck out three ... issued three walks in the first inning but did not allow a run ... carried a no-hitter through 5.1 IP before yielding a double to Eddie Rosario ... gave up a solo homer to Logan Morrison leading off the seventh ... left with a 1-0 deficit after throwing a season-high 104 pitches (62 strikes) ... Sox rallied to tie the game at 1-1 before losing, 2-1, in 13 innings.

#### 2018 STARTS OF INTEREST

- Pitched into the eighth inning for the first time in his career on 6/22-2 vs. Oakland.
- Allowed a career-high nine hits on 5/29 at Cleveland but did not issue a walk for the first time this season ... lasted 1.1 IP on 5/24 vs. Baltimore, the shortest start of his career ... won 5/13 at the Cubs despite walking a career-high tying seven batters ... became the third Sox pitcher since 2005 to earn the victory while issuing seven-plus walks, joining Derek Holland on 8/8/17 vs. Houston (seven over 5.2 IP) and Gavin Floyd on 4/13/09 at Detroit (seven over 5.0 IP).
- Earned his first victory of the season and first career road win on 4/26 at Kansas City ... allowed career highs of nine runs and seven walks over 2.0 IP on 4/21 vs. Houston ... his three HBP on 4/7 vs. Detroit were the most by a Sox starter since Chris Sale on 9/21/16 at Philadelphia (also three).

#### DAY AND NIGHT

- Has gone 5-3 with a 4.08 ERA (29 ER/64.0 IP) and .201 (47-234) opponents average over 11 starts during the day since 2017, compared to 3-7 with a 6.14 ERA (45 ER/66.0 IP) and .276 (67-252) opponents average in 12 starts at night.
- His 0.99 ERA during the day in 2017 would have led the American League with the required IP.

#### IT'S ALL ME

- Is one of 35 members of the Taylor Hooton Foundation advisory board, which is recognized as the leader in advocacy against appearance and performance enhancing drug use by the youth of America.
- The advisory board is comprised of at least one member from each of the 30 Major League clubs ... the players will participate in the THF 2018 public service campaign, including "It's All Me" themed PSAs which will appear in MLB's 2018 All-Star Game, League Championship Series and World Series programs.

#### 2017 RECAP

- Made 24 starts with Class AAA Charlotte and seven with the White Sox in his first season in the organization.
- Went 3-2 with a 1.83 ERA (8 ER/39.1 IP), 30 strikeouts, a .177 (25-141) opponents average and 0.94 WHIP over his final six starts ... five of the outings were quality.
- Was recalled on 8/23 and made his White Sox debut that night vs. Minnesota (4 ER/6.0 IP; 3 HR) ... earned his first win with the Sox on 8/27 vs. Detroit, allowing just three hits over 7.0 scoreless IP.
- Allowed one run and struck out a career-high 10 over 7.0 IP on 9/3 vs. Tampa Bay ... became the first Sox pitcher to strike out 10-plus batters within his first three starts with the club since Chris Sale in 2012.
- Received a ND on 9/13 at Kansas City, allowing one run on four hits in 6.1 IP ... became the 15th Sox pitcher to make four-plus straight starts of 5.0-plus IP and four hits or less allowed ... earned the win in his final start on 9/24 vs. Kansas City (1 ER/7.0 IP).
- Began the season with Charlotte ... threw his first professional no-hitter on 5/25-1 vs. Syracuse (7.0 IP), marking the first no-hitter in BB&T Ballpark history ... was named IL Pitcher of the Week for 5/22-28.
- Entered the season ranked by MLB.com as the No. 12 Prospect in baseball.

- His parents, Rick Giolito and Lindsay Frost, are Hollywood actors ... Rick has appeared in "As the World Turns," "Who's the Boss," "Hunter," "Jake and the Fatman," "Twin Peaks" and "Hit the Dutchman" ... Lindsay acted in "The Ring," "Collateral Damage," "Without a Trace," "The Unit," "Boston Legal," "Crossing Jordan," "Lost," "Frasier" and "CSI."
- His uncle, Mark Frost, is a co-creator and writer of the ABC and Showtime drama "Twin Peaks."
- Grandfather, Warren Frost, was a veteran actor who played George Costanza's father-in-law, Henry Ross, on the award-winning sitcom "Seinfeld."

#### CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Was selected by Washington in the first round (16th overall) of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft ... was committed to play baseball at UCLA prior to signing with the Nationals.
- Is a 2012 graduate of Harvard-Westlake High School in Los Angeles, where he was teammates with RHP Max Fried ... Fried was selected by San Diego with the seventh overall pick in the 2012 draft and currently pitches for the Atlanta Braves.

#### VS. CINCINNATI REDS

- Makes his first career start against the Reds and fifth career during interleague play ... is 1-2 with a 5.48 ERA (13 ER/21.1 IP) lifetime in IL play ... won his last start on 5/13 at the Cubs (3 ER/5.2 IP) despite issuing seven walks and throwing three wild pitches ... posted a no decision on 5/8 vs. Pittsburgh (4 ER/4.0 IP) ... lost on 5/2 at St. Louis despite making a quality start (3 ER/6.1 IP).

#### TOMORROW'S PROBABLE STARTER

- RHP Dylan Covey (3-3, 4.82) is scheduled to make his 10th start of the season, sixth on the road and first career against Cincinnati.
- Is 0-2 with a 12.71 ERA (16 ER/11.1 IP), 12 walks and three strikeouts over his last three starts ... was 2-0 with a 1.00 ERA (2 ER/18.0 IP) over his first three starts in June, including a streak of 18.0 consecutive IP without allowing an earned run to begin the month.
- Is 0-1 with a 4.97 ERA (7 ER/12.2 IP) in four career interleague starts ... threw 5.0 scoreless IP on 6/3 vs. Milwaukee (ND) in his only interleague start of 2018.
