SAN DIEGO NOTES

- **Clayton Richard** earned his first career win against the Braves and his 55th win as a Padre, tying Bruce Hurt for the second-most wins by a Padre lefty...has worked at least 6.0 innings in six consecutive starts, the longest active streak of throwing 6.0-plus innings...over that stretch, he has posted a 3-2 record with a 3.32 ERA (16 ER, 43.1 IP) with 34 strikeouts against seven walks.
 - Threw a season-high 109 pitches in tonight's game.
- **Cory Spangenberg** homered in consecutive games for the second time this season (also: March 30-April 2)...is riding a five-game hitting streak vs. ATL, batting .368 (7-for-19) with a double, two triples and a homer...has hit safely in nine of his 10 career games against the Braves with four multi-hit efforts.
 - Recorded his 10th-career multi-extra-base hit game and first since Aug. 15, 2017.
- **Eric Hosmer** has hit in seven of his last eight games, going 16-for-31 (.516)...also has six multi-hit games in his last seven contests...his 23 multi-hit games lead the Padres.
- **Raffy Lopez** recorded a career-high three hits in tonight's game...this homestand, he is batting .278 (5-for-18) with a home run and five RBI.
- **Franmil Reyes** has homered in four of his last seven games and in five of his last 11 (owns a .684 SLG since his first homer on May 21 at WSH).
- The Padres recorded nine extra base hits in tonight's game, the most in a game this season for the club.

ATLANTA NOTES

- **Julio Teheran** snapped his four-game winning streak against the Padres (dating back to July 26, 2014), his longest active streak against any one team...is 4-3 with a 4.13 ERA (26 ER, 56.2 IP) in nine career starts vs. SD.
- **Nick Markakis** went 2-for-4 in tonight's game with a double and two runs scored...is batting .325 (38-for-117) with 10 doubles and 17 RBI in his career against the Padres.
 - Leads the National League with 25 multi-hit games.
- **Tyler Flowers** has hit safely in eight of his last nine games (.300, 9-for-30) with a .447 OBP over that time, which dates back to May 22.
- **Charlie Culberson** is riding a five-game hitting streak, batting .438 (7-for-16), with two doubles, a homer and five RBI during that span...logged his third multi-hit game of the season.
