THE TWINS: The Twins went 6-5 on their 11-day homestand...the Twins traveled to Detroit last night on their off-day and will begin a six-game roadtrip tonight with the first of three against the Tigers at Comerica Park...following the series finale on Thursday, the Twins will travel to Cleveland for three through the weekend before returning home...the Twins are 11-17 on the road this season, including 1-6 in their last seven road games.

CAVE RETURNS TO HELP TWINS AVOIDS SWEEP: The Twins beat the Angels yesterday by a score of 7-5 to avoid the three-game sweep...Fernando Romero (3-2) was the starter and winner for the Twins, allowing three runs (2 earned) on five hits in 5.0 innings...Eduardo Escobar went 2-for-4 with two doubles and Jake Cave went 3-for-4 with his second home run of the season as well as a double and three RBI...Logan Morrison hit his seventh home run of the season.

TWINS AND TIGERS: The Twins have won nine of their last 11 against Detroit, dating back to August 13, 2017...in that span, they have out-scored Detroit 69-29 and out-hit them 101-79.
☞ Brian Dozier has reached safely in 21 straight games against Detroit, hitting .384 (33-for-86) with a .454 on-base percentage in that time...he has multiple hits in 10 of his last 13 games vs. the Tigers.
☞ Max Kepler has a .347 (17-for-49) career average in 16 games at Comerica Park... additionally, Logan Morrison is batting .302 (13-for-43) with two doubles, three home runs and eight RBI in 13 career games at Comerica Park.

TIGER TIES: Twins with Tigers connections:

- ☞ Fernando Rodney was signed by the Tigers as a free agent on November 1, 1997...Rodney pitched seven seasons for the Tigers from 2002-09, going 15-30, 4.28 ERA (330.0 IP, 157 ER) with 70 saves...in fact, he was the losing pitcher in game 163 in 2009 when the Twins beat the Tigers in 12 innings to win the AL Central.
- ☞ Bobby Wilson played five games for the Tigers in 2016, hitting .154 (2-for-13).
- ☞ Twins radio ace Dan Gladden played two seasons for the Tigers from 1992-93, hitting .260 (201-for-773) with 36 doubles, 20 home runs and 98 RBI in 204 games.
- ☞ Hall of Famer and FS North pre/postgame analyst Jack Morris was drafted by the Tigers in the fifth round of the 1976 First-Year Player Draft...he pitched 14 seasons for Detroit, going 198-150, 3.73 ERA (3042.2 IP, 1262 ER) with 154 complete games, 24 shutouts.

ESKY FoGo P.O.W.er: Eduardo Escobar was named the American League Player of the Week for the period ending June 10, as announced by the Commissioner's Office yesterday...Escobar batted .462 (12-for-26) with six doubles, a triple, two home runs and eight RBI in seven games to earn his first career Player of the Week Award.

- ☞ Escobar leads all MLB players with 26 doubles and is tied for the MLB-lead with 39 extra-base hits (also CLE's José Ramírez and LAA's Mike Trout).
- ☞ Escobar is the first Twins player to be awarded Player of the Week in 2018, and the first Twin since Byron Buxton was named POW on August 27, 2017.
- ☞ Escobar's 26 doubles are the most pre-ASG doubles by a Twin since Trevor Plouffe had 27 in 2014...the most pre-ASG doubles in Twins history are 37 by Chuck Knoblauch in 1994...additionally, with 100 games remaining to play this season Escobar needs 21 doubles to tie Justin Morneau for the Twins all-time doubles record (47 in 2008).

MATTY B IS BACK: The Twins announced today they have signed right-handed pitcher Matt Belisle to a major league contract and will join the Twins in Detroit...Belisle began the 2018 season with Cleveland appearing in eight games posting a 5.06 ERA (10.2 IP, 6 ER) before being outrighted May 6...since his outright he appeared in nine games for Triple-A Columbus where he posted a 4.22 ERA (10.2 IP, 5 ER) with one walk and 11 strikeouts...the 38-year-old spent 2017 with the Twins, appearing in 62 games, converting nine saves and posting a 4.03 ERA (60.1 IP, 27 ER) with 22 walks and 54 strikeouts...the Austin, Texas native has a career record of 51-57 with a 4.20 ERA (905.0 IP, 422 ER), 228 walks and 690 strikeouts in 668 games (44 starts) with Cincinnati, Colorado, St. Louis, Washington, Minnesota and Cleveland...to make room on the 25-man roster the Twins have designated infielder Gregorio Petit for release or assignment.

BELIEVE IN RELIEF: The Twins bullpen has posted a 2.86 ERA (145.0 IP, 46 ER) since April 28, the third-best ERA in baseball in that span trailing only New York-AL (2.51) and Chicago-NL (2.70)...they have also posted a 1.13 WHIP, which is also third best in baseball behind only Tampa Bay (1.09) and New York-AL (1.10).

- ☞ In that same span since April 28, the Twins have four relievers with sub-2.00 ERA including Trevor Hildenberger (1.29) who ranks tied 10th among AL relievers in ERA since April 28, Matt Magill (1.31) who ranks 12th among AL relievers in ERA since April 28, Fernando Rodney (1.76) and Zach Duke (1.80).

THIS AND THAT:

- ☞ In their last 13 games against left-handed pitchers, the Twins have hit .238 (29-for-122) with eight doubles and one home run... they are 5-10 against left-handed starting pitchers in 2018.
- ☞ Through games of June 12 of last season, the Twins were 32-27 with a -28 run differential...today they have a run differential of -11.

LAST START: Odorizzi suffered his third loss of the season and fell to 0-2 against the AL Central this season...went 5.0 innings and allowed three runs on six hits, walked only one and struckout seven...he did not allow a home run for the fourth time this season...has not made it through the sixth inning since May 14 vs. Seattle...two of the runs charged to Odorizzi were the result of a single off of and wild pitch by Ryan Pressly.

AGAINST DETROIT: Facing Detroit for the first time this season and fifth time in his career...owns a 2-1 record against the Tigers with a 2.28 ERA (23.2 IP, 6 ER), seven walks, 28 strikeouts and has allowed only one home run...has only one start at Comerica and that came on September 9, 2015, he earned the win after throwing 6.0 innings and now allowing a run while walking just one...three of his four starts against Detroit have been quality starts.

ON THE FIRST PITCH: Through his 13 starts this season, Odorizzi has allowed a .462 (12-for-26) average on the first pitch against a batter...on the 0-0 count, four of the 11 hits have been home runs and four have been doubles...of pitchers who have faced at least 15 batters who have put the first pitch in play, his average against is T-11th highest in the AL.

- On the contrary, when Odorizzi gets two strikes on a batter he is holding hitters to a .176 (27-for-153) average.

QUALITY NOT QUANTITY: Over his 13 starts this season, Odorizzi has averaged just over 5.23 innings/start...of starters with at least 11 starts, his 68.0 innings ranks as the 14th-fewest in the AL...his 18.5 pitches/inning ranks second highest in MLB behind Lance Lynn with 18.8...he averages 4.32 pitches/batter faced which is second most in MLB in the AL...though his starts have been on the short side, his 29 earned runs allowed ranks tied for 17th fewest in the American League among pitchers who have started at least 13 games.

PROBLEMS WITH THE LONG BALL: Last season Odorizzi gave up 30 homers in 143.1 IP...in his 28 starts he had only five outings where he did not give up at least one home run...his 1.88 HR/9.0 IP ranked fourth highest in the AL and sixth in MLB...of the 30 HR, 15 were solo shots, eight were two-run shot five three-run homers, and two grand-slams...had five multi-homer games, four of which were at home (Tropicana Field)...he was slightly better on the road than at home last season, giving up 11 homers on the road as compared to 19 at home.

- Has surrendered 14 home runs this season, tied-eighth most in the AL.

STILL NEED HELP: In Odorizzi's 13 starts in 2018, the Twins offense has supplied 24 total runs, good for a run support average of 3.18 runs per game...his run support average is lowest on the team among starters with at least ten starts, is sixth lowest in baseball and tied for fifth-lowest in the AL.

A BRIGHT START: Odorizzi pitched in his first career Opening Day start and first career start for the Twins...he went 6.0 innings and allowed just two hits, while not allowing a run and striking out seven...only five other times in his career has he notched seven or more strikeouts while not allowing a run in 6.0-plus innings, the first since April 8, 2015 vs. Baltimore...he became the eighth different pitcher to start Opening Day for the Twins in the last 12 seasons.

2017 RECAP:

- In his fourth full professional season, Odorizzi started 28 games and tossed 143.1 innings...with a 10-8 record, this marked his third season of a .500 or better record
- His 7.97 K/9.0 IP ranked T-2nd best in his career (other, 2015 and best, 2014 with 9.32).
- On September 23, Odorizzi recorded nine strikeouts, a season high, while allowing just one run on three hits in 6.0 innings
- Odorizzi held right-handed batters to a .228 average and lefties to a .210 average against

FLY AVERAGE: In 2017 Odorizzi ranked fourth among all major league pitchers in Fly Ball Percentage (min. 140.0 IP) with a rate of 47.3%...he trailed Ariel Miranda of Seattle (52.2%), Marco Estrada of Toronto (50.3%), and Ian Kennedy of Kansas City (47.7%)...since 2014 Odorizzi has ranked in the top-10 in fly ball percentage every season: 2014 (2nd, 48.7%), 2015 (10th, 40.6%), and 2016 (9th, 44.4%)...in 2018, Odorizzi has allowed 90 fly balls, tied for fifth most in baseball.

- Selected by Milwaukee in the first round (32nd overall) of 2008 First-Year Player Draft, traded to Kansas City in 2010, then in 2012 traded to Tampa Bay where he remained until his trade to Minnesota on February 17, 2018.
- 2017 marked his fourth straight year of at least 28 starts.
- On May 29, 2016 vs. New York-AL, retired his first 16 batters-faced, tied for the 3rd-longest perfect game bid in Rays history.
- Established career-highs in 2016 for starts (33) and innings pitched (187.2).
- In 2016 allowed 2 ER or fewer in 13 of his no-decisions, a mark reached by only one other pitcher since 1913.
- Earned his first major league win in his season debut on April 4, 2014 vs. Texas.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - JOSÉ BERRÍOS (SEASON: 6-5, 3.86 ERA ; CAREER: 23-20, 4.75 ERA)

Berrios is 6-5 this year with a 3.86 ERA (74.2 IP, 32 ER) with 14 walks and 74 strikeouts...will make his seventh career start and third of the season against the White Sox...in 2018, is 2-0 with a 2.77 ERA (13.0 IP, 4 ER) with two walks and 13 strikeouts vs. Chicago-AL...last start against the White Sox was May 4, allowed four runs on six hits and two walks with two strikeouts over 6.0 innings...only loss to the White Sox came August 24, 2017, allowed five runs (three earned) on four hits and three walks with nine strikeouts over 5.1 innings.

TEAM BULLPEN NOTES
