### FISH BITES

The Marlins continue a seven-game road trip and three-game series with game two against the Atlanta Braves tonight at 7:35 p.m. RHP **Dan Straily**, making his 17th start of the season, is facing the Braves for the ninth time in his career, posting a 4-2 record and 4.35 ERA (41.1 ip/20 er); in two starts this season he has gone 2-0 with a 1.50 ERA (12.0/2). The Braves are countering with LHP Kolby Allard, who is making his Major League debut. The Marlins concluded a 3-3 homestand Sunday, splitting a two-game series with the Braves and a four-game set against the Nationals. The current road swing will continue with the Marlins heading north to face the Phillies in a four-game series from Thursday-Sunday. Tonight's game continues a stretch of 13 straight games (3-4) against NL East opponents. Miami plays 37 of their remaining 53 games (71%) against division foes.

### LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

Miami jumped out to a quick lead but couldn't add on late in a 5-3 loss to Atlanta. **Derek Dietrich** led off the game with a walk and **Brian Anderson** followed with his ninth home run of the season to give the Marlins a quick 2-0 advantage. The Braves countered with two runs in both the second and third frames to go ahead 4-2. In the fifth, Dietrich drew his second walk of the game and came around to score on an RBI double by **J.T. Realmuto**. Both **Starlin Castro** and **Martin Prado** had two-hit games, and Realmuto extended hit hitting streak to six games. **Wei-Yin Chen** was saddled with his eight loss of the season.

### TODAY'S TRANSACTIONS

The Marlins today made a pair of trades. They acquired minor league RHP **Tommy Eveld** from Arizona in exchange for RHP Brad Ziegler. Miami also acquired INF **Bryson Brigman** from Seattle for OF Cameron Maybin. The Marlins also optioned RHP Ben Meyer to Triple-A New Orleans, returned from rehab and recalled RHP **Tayron Guerrero**, recalled LHP **Jarlin Garcia** from New Orleans, and selected the contract of OF **Isaac Galloway** (#79) from NOLA. Galloway's first appearance will be his Major League debut.

### VS. THE BRAVES

Miami trails the 2018 series, 3-7, which includes a 1-3 mark in Atlanta. The Marlins, who trail the all-time series, 177-247, have gone 81-133 in Atlanta (4-10 at SunTrust Park). Miami is in search of its first series win in Atlanta since taking two of three from September 12-14, 2016 at Turner Field.

### FLIPPING THE SCRIPT

Coming into this season, **Dan Straily** had performed much better at home than on the road, boasting a home record of 18-10 with a 3.76 ERA in 57 appearances (52 starts). In 62 road games (57 starts), he was 19-20 with a 4.69 ERA. This season, he has performed better on the road than at home, as he is 2-3 with a 3.27 ERA in visiting ballparks, compared to 2-1 with a 4.85 ERA at Marlins Park. He ranks 13th among National League starters (min. 8 GS) in road ERA, and 10th in average against on the road (.213).

### HISTORY REPEATS ITSELF

Miami began the season with just a .225 team average over its first 28 road games, which ranked 27th in the Majors. Over their last 23 road games since June 1, the Marlins have hit at a .271 clip to rank third in the Majors behind Atlanta (.276) and Oakland (.273). Since 2014, Miami leads the Majors in road average with a .261 mark, ahead of Houston (.258) and Kansas City (.256).

### ASCENSION

With today marking the final day of the month, the Marlins are looking to do something that has been done only twice previously in franchise history: increase team average every month through July. Colorado is the only other team to increase its average each month through July this season. - *Stats LLC*

### ROAD WELL TRAVELED

The Marlins have two of the best road hitters in the National League in **Derek Dietrich** (.322) and **J.T. Realmuto** (.318), who rank seventh and 11th in road average, respectively. Dietrich has hit in 10 of his last 12 road contests, batting .442 (19x43) with four doubles, five home runs, and nine RBI in that span. He has scored 34 runs in visiting ballparks, tied for 10th in the NL, while his .397 OBP is tied for ninth and .550 SLG ranks 10th. Realmuto has hit in 12 of his last 14 road games with an average of .350 (21x60), seven doubles, two home runs, and 13 RBI. The All-Star catcher is 17th in runs with 32, 18th with an OBP of .376, and ninth with a SLG of .565.

### NO NICKELS AND DIMES...ALL QUARTERS

**Starlin Castro** is one of six active players to record 25+ hits in five-or-more consecutive months. Whit Merrifield has recorded 25+ hits in nine consecutive months, followed by Freddie Freeman (7), Francisco Lindor (7), Castro (5), J.D. Martinez (5) and Trea Turner (5). - *Stats LLC*

### FLIPPING THE M

Since June 5, the Marlins have gone 26-23, and have won nine of 15 series in that span (two splits), including consecutive series wins against then-first-place Milwaukee and Philadelphia to end the first half. Miami opened the season 20-39, and dropped a season-high six straight games just prior to this current stretch.

- The Marlins have gone 10-10 on the road since June 4, and since being swept in a three-game series in Arizona from June 1-3, have won four of their last six road series.

### LET THE CONVERSATION START

In his final game before the break, **Brian Anderson** recorded his sixth three-hit game of the season to run his season hit total to 109. His hit total prior to the break tied Rocco Baldelli for the second-most by a Major League rookie since 2003, behind only Hideki Matsui (114 in 2003). He is the only Marlins rookie in franchise history to record 100+ hits prior to the break.

- Anderson recorded 101 hits over his first 92 games of the season, becoming the 142nd rookie since 1958 to record 100+ hits in 92-or-fewer games. Of those, 34 went on to win Rookie of the Year honors, including most recently Aaron Judge (2017), Corey Seager (2016), Carlos Correa (2015), José Abreu (2014), Mike Trout (2012) and Buster Posey (2010). - *Stats LLC*
- He leads all MLB rookies in games (107), at-bats (415), hits (118), multi-hit games (34), three+-hit games (7), average with RISP (.402), runs (63), and RBI (51); ranks second in walks (42) and on-base percentage (.365), tied for second in doubles (23), is third in slugging percentage (.419), and tied for third in triples (3), fourth in average (.284), and tied for eighth in HR (9).

## THIS DAY IN MARLINS HISTORY

### JULY 31

Paul Lo Duca entered his first Marlins game as a pinch hitter in the bottom of the sixth inning and hit a two-run home run to give the Marlins a 5-4 lead over the Expos. Montreal would score four runs in the following frame to take the victory in 2004. Lo Duca is one of 15 Marlins players to homer in their first game. In 2016, Derek Dietrich hit a walkoff triple in the ninth inning to beat St. Louis, 5-4. It was Dietrich's first career walkoff hit and the first walkoff triple in Franchise history.

## YOUNG GUNS

Of the Marlins' 46 wins this season, 23 have been recorded by rookie pitchers (50.0 pct.). Overall, have 10 different rookies own a win. The 10 different rookies to record a win are tied with three teams for fifth-most in a single season in MLB history. The 2017 Reds, '07 Yankees, '03 Tigers and '02 Padres each had 11. - *Stats LLC*

Dan Straily is making his 17th start of the season in the middle game of this three-game set against the Atlanta Braves.

Is making his ninth career start and appearance against Atlanta, posting a 4-2 record and 4.35 ERA (41.1/20); has gone 2-0 with a 1.50 ERA (12.0/2) in two starts this season. Last faced Braves on May 18 at SunTrust Park, allowing just three hits and three walks, with six strikeouts, over a season-high 7.0 scoreless innings.

Had stretch of five straight quality starts snapped in last outing, as he allowed three runs, five hits, and three walks, with six strikeouts, over 5.2 innings to Washington on July 26 at Marlins Park. His last six games, has gone 2-1 with a 3.08 ERA (38.0/13) and a .199 average against. He has walked 15 batters (3.55 per 9.0) in that time; was averaging 4.89 walks per 9.0 in his 10 starts prior.

His July ERA of 2.84 (31.2/10) ranks 11th among NL starters (min. 5 GS), while his .205 average against ranks sixth.

Miami won his first five starts this season; he went 2-0, 3.12 (26.0/9) in that time, with a .204 (19x93) average against. Since then, Marlins have lost eight of his 11 outings, and he is 2-4, 4.50 (58.0/29) over that span, with a .241 (52x216) average against.

Is striking out 7.39 batters per 9.0 innings this season, down from 8.42 in 2017. Is also walking 4.29 batters per 9.0 this year, up from 2.97 and 3.43 the last two years, respectively.

Snapped a personal three-game losing streak, and a 0-5 skid by the team in his starts, on June 25 vs. Arizona. Picked up win after tossing 6.1 innings (most since 7.0 on May 18 at ATL) and allowing three runs on four hits and a hit batter, with six strikeouts.

Is 2-1 (team 4-4) in eight home starts this season, despite a 4.85 ERA (42.2/23); that is in contrast to a 3.27 ERA (41.1/15) in eight road starts, in which he has gone 2-3 (team 4-4).

He made four Spring Training starts, going 1-0 with a 1.29 ERA (14.0 ip/2 er), before being shut down with right forearm inflammation on March 20.

Made two rehab appearances at Single-A Jupiter, going 1-1 with 8.22 ERA (7.2/7). Allowed seven runs (six earned) and five hits over 2.2 innings in first start, April 13 at Daytona. Limited Lakeland to one run and six hits over 5.0 frames on April 18. Transferred to Double-A Jacksonville and made 5.1-inning start on April 24 at Tennessee, allowing four runs (three earned) on six hits with a walk and six strikeouts.

Last season, set career highs in starts (33) and strikeouts (170), leading the starting rotation in starts, strikeouts, and innings pitched (181.2).

He went 5-3 with a 3.57 ERA (90.2 ip/36 er) in 17 starts at home, and 5-6, 4.95 (91.0/50) in 16 starts on the road.

Was one of just seven NL starters to make 17-plus starts at home, tied with four others for the second-highest total, behind R.A. Dickey, Zack Greinke, and Jon Lester (18 each). Among that group, only Greinke (2.87) and Patrick Corbin (3.15) had a lower home ERA.

Struck out nine batters on September 24 at Arizona, setting a new single-season career high. He finished the game with 167 strikeouts, surpassing his previous high of 162, set in 2016 with Cincinnati.

Had one of the best starts of his career on July 7 at San Francisco. He set a career high with 8.1 innings pitched in picking up his seventh victory of the season. Allowed just four hits, did not walk a batter, and struck out four. He allowed just one run, a solo home run to Denard Span, the final batter he faced. From the second out of the second inning until there were two outs in the seventh, he set a new career high by retiring 16 consecutive batters, according to *Stats LLC*. It surpassed his previous high of 14, which he set over his first two starts of 2017 (April 22-29).
