THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 3-2 through five games on their current homestand, going 1-1 vs. Seattle (postponed Sunday) and 2-1 vs. Houston...tonight they will begin a four-game series vs. the White Sox through the weekend...they will travel to Puerto Rico post-game Sunday evening, enjoy an off-day on the island on Monday, followed with two "home games" in Puerto Rico against the Indians next Tuesday and Wednesday at Hiram Bithorn Stadium.

TWINS TAKE ANOTHER SERIES: The Twins beat the Astros yesterday afternoon by a score of 9-8, improving to 2-0-2 in series play this season...Kyle Gibson was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing five runs on seven hits in 4.1 innings pitched...Fernando Rodney blew a two-run lead in the ninth but earned the win...the offense set a season-high in runs...Max Kepler went 3-for-4 with his fourth career multi-homer game, hitting a two-run homer in the fourth inning and a walk-off solo shot in the bottom of the ninth off Brad Peacock.
Ⓢ Kepler, at 25 years, 60 days is the youngest player in MLB history with a multi-HR game, including a walkoff, against defending World Series champ...Kepler replaces Hall of Famer Jimmie Foxx who was 25 years, 294 days old when he accomplished the feat on August 12, 1933 against the Yankees. (STATS, INC.)

MINNESOTA'S GREATEST HITS: With one more hit yesterday Joe Mauer now needs two hits to reach 2,000 for his career, which would join Kirby Puckett and Rod Carew as the only players in club history to reach the mark...11 active players have reached the 2,000 hit plateau, most recently Adrian Gonzalez in August of 2017.

AVERAGE JOE: Joe Mauer enters today ranking third in the AL in batting average (.387) and fourth in all of baseball, trailing Robinson Canó (.406), Mookie Betts (.405) and Buster Posey (.389)...additionally, he ranks second in baseball in on-base percentage (.525), trailing only Canó (.537).

TWINS AND SOX: Today marks the first of 19 meetings between the Twins and White Sox this season...last season the Twins went 12-7, going 6-3 at Target Field and 6-4 at Guaranteed Rate Field...they out-scored the Sox 90-67...their last meeting came August 29-31 at Target Field as the Twins swept the Sox in three games...the Twins have won nine of their last 13 vs. the Sox and 14 of their last 21.

Ⓢ Brian Dozier is hitting .342 (39-for-114) with 10 doubles, 11 home runs, 22 RBI and a .423 on-base percentage in his last 29 games vs. the White Sox.

Ⓢ Miguel Sanó has homered seven times in his last 15 game vs. the Sox.

MAUER AND CHICAGO: Joe Mauer is hitting .298 (221-for-742) with 51 doubles, 18 home runs, 100 RBI, 102 walks, 117 runs scored and a .385 on-base percentage in 198 career games against the Sox...below are the active leaders vs. the Sox:

TWINS AT THE TOP: Brian Dozier has hit safely in all 10 Twins games this season...Joe Mauer has hit safely in nine straight to start the season, setting a new career-high to start any season, passing his previous high of eight in 2010...Dozier's streak is tied with Marcell Ozuna, Asdrubal Cabrera and Dee Gordon for longest active streak in baseball...Dozier and Gordon are the only players in baseball (min. 9 games) to hit in all their team's games.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2010, the Twins played their first ever game at Target Field, hosting the Boston Red Sox and winning 5-2...Carl Pavano was the starter and winner while Jon Rauch earned the save...Joe Mauer went 3-for-5 with two RBI and Jason Kubel went 3-for-4 with a home run and two RBI.

ADJUST YOUR BUNNY EAR ANTENNAS: This Friday night's game vs. the White Sox will be televised on Fox Sports North PLUS due to Minnesota Wild playoff hockey vs. the Winnipeg Jets.

THIS AND THAT:

- Ⓢ The Twins have a slugging percentage of .431, the third best in the AL, trailing Los Angeles (.471) and Chicago (.445).
- Ⓢ The Twins bullpen has allowed 30 hits, the third fewest in the AL, trailing Cleveland (20) and Kansas City (24).

SPOILED HOMECOMING: Berríos' suffered his first loss of 2018 on April 5 vs. Seattle... in 4.2 IP, allowed five earned runs on six hits and one walk with seven strikeouts... after completing 3.0 perfect innings to start the game, Berríos allowed an RBI-single to Robinson Canó and a two-run home run in the fourth to Kyle Seager...chased in the fifth inning after allowing a two-run single to Dee Gordon.

NO PLACE LIKE HOME: Berríos went 9-1, 2.41 ERA (67.1 IP, 18 ER) in 11 appearances (10 starts) at Target Field in 2017...conversely, Berríos was 5-7, 5.17 ERA (78.1 IP, 45 ER) on the road... suffered 10 consecutive road losses before winning at Detroit May 21, 2017...opponents only hit .199 against him at Target Field in 2017 with only three home runs.

SPRING RECAP: In Berríos' fourth spring training with the Twins, went 2-1, 1.42 ERA (19.0 IP, 3 ER) with 16 strikeouts and six walks in six starts...in final exhibition start against Washington at Nationals Park on March 27, allowed no runs, no hits and one walk and three strikeouts in 3.0 IP.

2017 RECAP:

- Berríos started 25 games, a single-season career-high.
- In first full season, Berríos finished 14-8 with 139 strikeouts and 48 walks over 145.2 innings.
- Set career highs in wins (14), strikeouts (139), innings (145.2) and ERA (3.89)...he ranked second on Twins staff in wins, and strikeouts, and third in starts and innings pitched.
- Tied for ninth in the AL in wins.
- The youngest pitcher in baseball to record an 11-strikeouts game last year against Colorado on May 18.
- Made first career postseason appearance against New York-AL in the Wild Card Game... allowed three runs in three innings and was credited with a loss.

AGAINST THE SOX: Berríos is making his fifth career start against Chicago-AL...career 3-1, 2.13 ERA (25.1 IP, 6 ER) with eight walks and 31 strikeouts...in 2017, 2-1, 2.21 ERA (20.1 IP, 5 ER) with five walks and 28 strikeouts...at home in Berríos' career, 2-0, 1.20 ERA (15.0 IP, 2 ER) with two walks and 19 strikeouts, both starts coming in 2017...has lasted until through the fifth inning in all four starts against the White Sox...last win came in last start, August 30, 2017 at Target Field, pitching 7.0 shutout innings with four hits allowed, one walk and a career-high 11 strikeouts.

ROAD WOES: In 23 career road starts, Berríos is 8-9 with a 5.65 ERA over 113.0 innings...of the 27 home runs Berríos has surrendered in his career, 19 have been at opposing ballparks... Berríos lasted more than 5.0 innings in only eight of his 17 road starts in 2017, which was an improvement from only two such outings in 2016.

NO PLACE LIKE HOME, PART 2: The Twins are playing Cleveland in a two-game series in Berríos' home country of Puerto Rico April 17 and 18...Berríos is slated to pitch in one of those two games...Berríos pitched for Team Puerto Rico in the WBC last spring, going 1-0, 8.10 ERA (6.2 IP, 6 ER) with two walks and 10 strikeouts in two games (1 start).

UP IN THE AIR: Berríos knows how to pitch to his ballpark...in 2017, Berríos only allowed three home runs at home and boasted a meager 2.41 ERA...the low scoring is due in large part to his 60.2 fly ball rate, keeping the ball in the air for his outfield to make plays...his fly ball rate was good for 11th best in the AL among pitchers with more than 140 IP.
