### SAN DIEGO NOTES

- **Tyson Ross** made his third career start against MIA and first since July 23, 2015 at Petco Park...has worked five-or-more innings in 10 of his 11 starts this season...remains 4-3 with a 3.29 ERA (24 ER, 65.2 IP).
- **Franmil Reyes** belted his third career homer and his second in as many days...has now hit three home runs in his last six games (owns at .700 SLG in that time).
- **Eric Hosmer** logged three hits in tonight's game, tying his season high (also: April 29 vs. NYM)...has reached base safely via hit or walk in 16 of his last 17 games, owning a .333 OBP with six walks during that span.
  - His 17 doubles are the most in the National League.
- **Travis Jankowski** has seven of the Padres' eight leadoff hits to start a game...hitting .321 with a double, two triples, a homer and eight walks when batting leadoff.
- **Cory Spangenberg** recorded his third multi-hit game of the season (last: April 18 vs. LAD).

### MIAMI NOTES

- **Dan Straily** threw a season-high 108 pitches...tonight's loss snapped his five-game winning streak against NL West opponents...his last loss against an NL West team was on May 25, 2017 vs. LAD (a span of 10 starts)...is now 7-2 vs. the NL West with a 3.79 ERA in 17 career games (15 starts).
- **JT Riddle** hit his first career inside-the-park home run...is the first Marlins player to hit an inside-the-park homer since J.T. Realmuto (Aug. 24, 2017 at PHI).
  - Was the first inside-the-park home run against the Padres since Orlando Arcia (June 17, 2017 at MIL) and first at Petco Park since Kurt Suzuki (May 20, 2014 vs. MIL)...this was the seventh inside-the-park home run that has been hit against the Padres at Petco Park.
- **Justin Bour** recorded his seventh multi-hit game of the season...is riding an eight-game hitting streak vs. SD and is batting .462 (12-for-26) with a homer, two doubles and five RBI in that time.
- **J.T. Realmuto** logged his 15th career triple...has lead all Major League catchers in triples since his debut in 2014...extended his hitting streak at Petco Park to eight games, going 11-for-35 (.314) with two triples, a homer and six RBI.
- **Brian Anderson** tallied his 16th multi-hit game of the season, tying Starlin Castro for the team lead...is ranked second among Major League rookies behind Miguel Andujar (17).
