NEW YORK YANKEES NOTES

- The Yankees are 5-4 on their season-long 11-game homestand...are 8-4 in their last 12G...remain 10.5G behind Boston in the AL East.
 - Trailed, 4-0, after the top of the first...tied for their second-largest deficit overcome in a win this season (trailed by 5R on 6/20 vs. Seattle)...was their first win when allowing at least 4R in the top of the first inning since 5/3/17 vs. Toronto (gave up 4R in the first, won, 8-6).
 - Are 10-4 vs. Toronto this season, their most wins vs. any opponent this season...is their only winning record vs. an AL East team...are their most wins over the Blue Jays in one season since going 11-8 in 2014...are 7-1 in their last eight matchups.
 - Marked their first rain-shortened game since playing two in a 10-day span on 7/23/14 vs. Texas (W, 2-1, in five innings) and 7/13/14 at Baltimore (L, 3-1, in five innings)...have had 19 of their 122 games (15.6%) affected by weather (9 postponed, 5 delayed pre-game, 4 delayed in-game, 1 rain-shortened).
- DH Giancarlo Stanton** (2-for-4) hit his 31st HR of the season in the seventh...was his 298th career HR...was his fifth HR vs. Toronto this season.
 - In 21G since Aaron Judge went on the D.L. on 7/27, is hitting .289/.351/.663 (24-for-83) with 18R, 7 doubles, 8HR, 17RBI and 8BB.
- 3B Miguel Andújar** (2-for-3, 1RBI) hit his 35th double in the first...are the most by a Yankee since Robinson Canó had 41 in 2013...his single in the fifth snapped a streak of seven consecutive hits for extra bases...is the second Yankees rookie since 2006 to reach 60RBI in a season (Judge-114 in 2017).
 - Has 10XBH in his last 11G (since 8/7), batting .364 (16-for-44) with 9R, 5 doubles, 5HR, 12RBI, 1BB, 1HP and 1SB...has at least 1RBI in 8-of-11 games.
 - Was his 39th multi-hit game of the season...are tied for the most by a Yankees rookie since 2006 (Judge-39 in 2017)...has multiple hits in 3-of-4, 6-of-9, and 7-of-11.
- RF Neil Walker** (1-for-3) hit a go-ahead three-run HR in the fourth inning...has 4HR in his last 11G (since 8/6) after hitting only 3HR in his first 73G.
- SS Didi Gregorius** (1-for-3, 1R, 1RBI) tripled in the first...was the first triple by a Yankee since Brett Gardner on 8/2 at Boston.
- CF Aaron Hicks** (0-for-2, 2R, 2BB) has walks in seven of his last nine games and 19-of-26 since 7/15...his 23BB in 25G since the All-Star break are tied for the most in the Majors.
- 2B Gleyber Torres** (1-for-3, 1R, 1 double, 1RBI) doubled in the fourth, his first extra-base hit since hitting a HR on 8/6 at Chicago-AL.
- Yankees batters** hit multiple HRs for the first time since Sun. vs. Texas, snapping a four-game streak with one-or-zero HRs (3HR total during streak)...have hit 197HR through 122G...had scored 1R in each of their previous 2G.
- RHP Lance Lynn** (4.0IP, 6H, 5ER, 3BB, 5K, 1WP) started and took a no-decision...marked his most runs allowed and his shortest start since 7/1 at Chicago-NL (1.2IP, 7ER)...had allowed just 1R in 16.2IP over his first three games (two starts) with the Yankees.
- RHP Chad Green** (2.0IP, 1H, 1K) earned the win...tied his longest outing of the season (ninth time).
- RHP David Robertson** (1.0IP, 2K) tossed a perfect seventh to earn his third save.

TORONTO BLUE JAYS NOTES

- The Blue Jays fell to 2-3 on their seven-game road trip...are 26-35 on the road this season and 13-24 away from Rogers Centre since 5/28.
 - Are 4-10 vs. the Yankees this season...have lost seven of their last eight games vs. the Yankees (since 4/21)...are 1-4 at Yankee Stadium this season.
- **RHP Marcus Stroman** (4.0IP, 6H, 5ER, 2BB, 2K, 1HR) started and did not record a decision...is winless in his last four starts...has allowed at least 5ER in seven of his 18 starts this season.
 - Is 6-5 with a 4.21 ERA (87.2IP, 41ER) in 16 career starts vs. the Yankees...is 2-5 with a 6.15 ERA (41.0IP, 29ER) in nine starts at Yankee Stadium...since the beginning of 2016, is 0-4 with a 7.52 ERA (26.1IP, 22ER) in six starts at Yankee Stadium...in that same span, is 2-0 with a 3.13 ERA (31.2IP, 11ER) in five starts vs. the Yankees at Rogers Centre, with the Blue Jays winning all five of those games.
 - Has been knocked out of the game before the end of the sixth inning in each of his seven starts in the Bronx since the start of 2015...Yankees batters are hitting .302/.384/.527 (39-for-129) with 6 doubles and 7HR against him in those starts.
- **3B Aledmys Díaz** (1-for-3) hit a two-run double in the first...has 4RBI over his last two games.
- **CF Kevin Pillar** (1-for-3, 1R) hit an RBI single in the first...is 7-for-14 (.500) with 3R, 1 double, 1HR and 6RBI in his last four games.
- **DH Kendrys Morales** (2-for-3, 1R) hit an RBI single in the first...has recorded at least 1RBI in back-to-back games for the first time since he did so in three straight from 7/25-28.
 - Marked his first multi-hit game since 7/31 at Oakland.
- **C Russell Martin** (1-for-3) hit an RBI single in the fifth...has reached base safely in a season-high 14 games (since 7/27)...is batting .366/.509/.659 (15-for-41) with 10R, 3 doubles, 3HR, 7RBI and 9BB in that span.
- **RF Curtis Granderson** (1-for-3, 1R, 1 double, 1BB) is hitting .286 (14-for-49) with 10R, 4 doubles, 2HR, 6RBI and 6BB in his last 15 games.
