ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 12-7 on the road, going 4-2-0 in series play....they are on a 4-game road winning streak, tying a season high (also 3/29-4/9)....the team went 40-38 on the road last season, going 13-11-2 in series play.

MANAGER: **Craig Counsell** is in his fourth season as manager of the Brewers (242-257) and third full season....he was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing **Ron Roenicke**....bio is on p. 44 of the media guide.

COACHES: Hitting coach **Darnell Coles** (4th season), pitching coach **Derek Johnson** (3rd season), coach **Jason Lane** (3rd season), bench coach **Pat Murphy** (3rd season), third base coach **Ed Sedar** (12th season, 8th as 3B coach), first base/infield coach **Carlos Subero** (3rd season) and bullpen coach **Lee Tunnell** (6th season) all returned from the 2017 staff.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made six replay challenges, going 1-5....their last challenge (won) came on 5/4 vs. Pittsburgh as an out call at second base involving Francisco Cervelli was overturned....team was 17-27 in 44 replay challenges in 2017.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: #53 - RHP BRANDON WOODRUFF (5g, 1gs, 1-0, 3.86)

WOODRUFF AT A GLANCE: Brandon Woodruff, 25, is making his sixth appearance and second start for the Brewers this season....he was recalled from Triple-A Colorado Springs, where he was 2-0 with a 1.89 ERA in 4 starts (19ip, 13h, 4r, 4er, 10bb, 17k, 1hr)....he last started last Saturday at Oklahoma City (2.2ip, 3h, 1r, 1er, 3bb, 3k, 1hr, 1wp, 1bk)....he had no decision in the 4-1 loss....this his his third stint with Milwaukee this season (Opening Day-4/6 and 4/25-4/30)....his only start for the Brewers this season came on 4/6 vs. Chicago-NL as he received no decision in a 5-4 win (3.2ip, 4h, 2r, 2er, 2bb, 3k, 1hbp, 1wp)....his last outing with Milwaukee came in relief on 4/30 at Cincinnati as he earned the win (1.1ip, 2k)....Woodruff was selected by Milwaukee in the 11th round of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft....he entered the 2018 season as the top prospect in the organization according to *Baseball America*....bio is on p. 151 of the media guide.

LAST SEASON: Woodruff entered 2017 as the seventh-best prospect in the organization according to *Baseball America*....he went 2-3 with a 4.81 ERA in 8 starts with Milwaukee....he had three stints with the team (6/13, 8/4-8/19 and 9/1-end)....the team went 3-5 in his starts....he produced 3 quality starts....opponents batted .259 (43-for-166, 5hr)....Woodruff went 1-1 with a 1.52 ERA in his first 4 starts (23.2ip, 4er) and 1-2 with an 8.84 ERA in his last 4 starts (19.1ip, 19er).

MLB DEBUT, TAKE 2: Woodruff originally joined the Brewers last season to start the first game of a doubleheader on 6/13 at St. Louis, but did not pitch due to a pre-game injury....he was placed on the 10-day disabled list that day with right hamstring tightness....he was reinstated on 7/25 and optioned to Triple-A Colorado Springs....Woodruff was recalled on 8/4 and made his MLB debut that night at Tampa Bay, earning a 2-0 victory (6.1ip, 7h, 2bb, 6k).

CAREER: Is 3-3 with a 4.64 ERA in 13 games / 9 starts (52.1ip, 27er)....is 2-3 with a 4.82 ERA as a starter (46.2ip, 25er) and 1-0 with a 3.38 ERA in relief (5.2ip, 2er).

CAREER AT MILLER PARK: Is 1-3 with a 6.08 ERA in 8 games / 7 starts (37ip, 25er)....is 0-0 with a 5.40 ERA in 2 games / 1 start this season (5ip, 3er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 2-0 with a 1.17 ERA in 5 games / 2 starts (15.1ip, 2er)....is 1-0 with a 2.08 ERA in 3 relief appearances this season (4.1ip, 1er).
