## HOME OPENER REDUX

» The Indians opened their 2018 home slate with a closely-fought 3-2 victory vs. Kansas City yesterday afternoon.

» All the scoring took place in the first inning, with the Indians pulling ahead on RBI-singles from **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** and **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** (2 RBI)...despite mustering just four hits on the day, the Tribe's first-run outburst was enough to secure the victory.

» **CARLOS CARRASCO** was sharp in his second outing of the season, earning the win after allowing two runs on five hits over 6.0 innings of work...after surrendering a pair of runs in the top of the 1st inning, Carrasco retired a string of 13 consecutive batters, striking out four batters and issuing just one intentional walk.

» Cleveland won its home opener for a second consecutive season (W, 2-1 on April 11, 2017 vs. Chicago-AL), marking their first back-to-back wins in Progressive Field openers since a run of three straight victories from 1997-1999.

» The Tribe is now 3-0 all-time in home openers against the Kansas City Royals, 12-12 in openers at Progressive Field, and 61-57 (.517) all-time.

## ROYAL REVIEW

» Yesterday's win over Kansas City improved the Tribe's record to 13-7 (.650) over the Royals since the beginning of last season (8-3 at home in that span)...since **Terry Francona** became Tribe manager in 2013, the Indians own a 56-40 (.583) record vs. KC.

» Dating back to August 18, 2017, Tribe pitching has held the Royals to two runs or fewer in seven of their last ten matchups...most notably, the Indians shut out the Royals in three consecutive games from August 25-27, marking Cleveland's first run of three straight shutouts since August 18-19, 1956 vs. Washington.

## SMOOTH LANDING

» In his first regular-season action of 2018, **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** provided the game's decisive hit, a go-ahead two-run single in the bottom of the 1st inning.

» Marked Brantley's first at-bat after being activated Friday morning from the 10-day Disabled List...had missed 56 of the Tribe's last 58 regular-season contests after an August 8 right ankle injury that required offseason surgery.

» Brantley has now hit safely in each of his last three returns from the Disabled List...opened his 2017 campaign with a 1-for-5 performance on April 3, 2017 vs. Texas, and also delivered a pinch-hit single on September 30, 2017 vs. Chicago-AL.

## CLOSE CALLS

» The Tribe has been embroiled in a number of close contests this season, as five of the first seven games of the season have been one-run affairs.

» In 2017, the Indians played in 35 one-run games, posting a record of 20-15 (.571)...thus far in 2018, the Indians are 2-3 in such contests...Cleveland's five one-run ballgames already this season rank as the most in MLB.

## LOOKING FOR A SPARK

» After recording 10-or-more hits in 59 games last season (51-8 in those contests), the Indians are one of just three teams in MLB (also Kansas City and Tampa Bay) yet to reach double digits in the 2018 campaign.

» The Indians currently rank last in MLB with a .157 team average (37-235) and 28th with 37 hits...they rank T8th in the American League with eight home runs this season, while they lead the A.L. with seven steals (T2nd in MLB).

## CENTRAL FOCUS

» This series vs. Kansas City serves as the beginning of the Tribe's 76-game slate against divisional foes.

» Success against the A.L. Central has proven critical to Cleveland's consecutive division championships...after posting a club-high 49 intra-divisional wins in 2016 (49-26, .653), the Tribe broke that record last season, going 50-26 (.658) in divisional matchups.

» Cleveland enters play this afternoon in 3rd place in the A.L. Central, 1.5 games behind leaders Minnesota (4-2)...the Indians have been in 3rd place for six days this season, having spent seven days in 3rd place in 2017 (last on April 18).

## MINOR LEAGUE REPORT

» **Columbus (AAA): 1-0, T1st (+0.0 G)**

The Clippers scored nine times in the 6th inning to blitz past Indianapolis, punctuated by a Mike Napoli grand slam.

» **Akron (AA): 1-1, T2nd (-1.0 G)**

The Ducks erased a 6-0 deficit over the final three innings, capped by a go-ahead two-run homer by Bobby Bradley.

» **Lynchburg (High-A): 1-1, T3rd (-1.0 G)**

RHP Kieran Lovegrove threw 2.0 scoreless innings in relief...Trenton Brooks and Luke Wakamatsu recorded doubles.

» **Lake County (A): 1-0, T2nd (-0.5 G)**

Snow cut short last night's game with the Captains trailing 6-2 in the 4th inning...Ernie Clement was 2-for-2.

## ALLENTOWN

» **CODY ALLEN** collected his second save of the season with a scoreless 9th inning, marking his third consecutive scoreless appearance to open the 2018 season.

» Marked Allen's 124th career save (all with Cleveland), tying him with **Chris Perez** for 3rd-most in Indians franchise history...Allen sits five saves behind **Doug Jones** for 2nd place, while all-time leader **Bob Wickman** sits 15 saves ahead with 139.

» Allen has successfully recorded a save in each of his last 10 opportunities (dating back to September 2, 2017), and has gone 32-for-36 (.889) overall in save chances since the start of last season.

## THE MILLER'S TALE

» **ANDREW MILLER** battled his way through a scoreless 8th inning to preserve Cleveland's 3-2 lead in yesterday's win.

» After issuing a leadoff walk and an ensuing single, Miller struck out each of the next three batters he faced to stunt the Royals' rally.

» Marked Miller's 36th relief outing since the start of 2016 with at least three strikeouts, most in MLB over that span by a sizable margin (Boston's **Craig Kimbrel** is second with 29 such appearances)...he holds a 16-game lead over the closest left-handed pitcher, San Diego's **Brad Hand** (20).

» Since Miller joined Cleveland in 2016, the Indians have posted a 70-16 record (.814) in games which he appears.

## COLD AS ICE

» The Indians have not played a game at Progressive Field with a first-pitch temperature lower than 40 degrees Fahrenheit since the 2016 home opener vs. Boston (34 degrees)...should this afternoon's first pitch come at today's forecasted high temperature of 33 degrees, it would tie the record for the coldest regular-season game in Progressive Field history (April 5 & 7, 1996 vs. Toronto).

» Since 1994, the Indians have gone 11-6 at home in games with first-pitch temperatures below 40 degrees, as well as 14-9 overall.

## HOME COOKING

» The Indians have picked up where they left off in 2017 after posting a 49-32 (.605) record at Progressive Field, the 2nd-best home record in the American League and 4th-best in the Majors.

» Since the 2017 All-Star Break, Cleveland has gone an MLB-best 29-8 (.784) at home, including wins in 18 of their past 21 regular-season games here.

» In the Tribe's last 20 games vs. divisional foes, they own a 16-4 (.800) record, allowing two-or-fewer runs in 15 of those contests.

## BAUER'S TURN

» The Indians will trot out **TREVOR BAUER** this afternoon as they look to secure their first winning streak of the 2018 campaign.

» After taking a no-decision on April 1 at Seattle, Bauer will be making his 2018 home debut...10 of Bauer's 17 wins last season came at Progressive Field, where he posted a 10-4 record with a 3.93 ERA (45ER/103.0IP).

» Bauer enters play today having won 10 of his last 11 decisions, a span of 15 starts...since July 21, 2017, he has gone 10-1 with a 2.66 ERA (26ER/88.0IP), striking out 98 batters in that time.

## MISC. BATTING NOTES

» **EDWIN ENCARNACION** ranks T3rd in the American League with three home runs this season...his 7.7 at-bats per homer (3HR/23AB) this season also ranks T3rd in the A.L.

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** enters play today with 499 career hits, looking to become the 7th current Indians player to reach the 500-hit milestone...his 364 hits since the start of 2016 are 2nd-most on the Indians, one behind **FRANCISCO LINDOR** (365).

## MISC. PITCHING NOTES

» The Tribe bullpen has allowed just one run on five hits in 8.1 innings over the club's last two games...Indians relievers currently rank 6th in the American League with a 3.47 ERA and have worked 3.0-or-more scoreless innings on three occasions (all three of Cleveland's wins this season).

» **MIKE CLEVINGER** (5.1IP), **NICK GOODY** (4.2IP), **CODY ALLEN** (4.0IP) and **MATT BELISLE** (3.0IP) have each allowed no runs thus far in 2018.

» **1994:** In the first night game at Jacobs Field, Eddie Murray hits the first Tribe homer at their new ballpark...Cleveland defeats the Mariners, 6-2.

» **1996:** Kenny Lofton steals third base in the bottom of the 7th inning vs. Toronto...marks his 255th career steal with the Tribe, surpassing Terry Turner (254) for the most in Indians franchise history...Lofton would go on to conclude his career in Cleveland with 452 steals.

# 47 TREVOR BAUER

**TODAY'S START**

» The 27-year-old right-hander is slated to make his second start of the 2018 season and first home outing of the year this afternoon against Kansas City...will mark his 125th career start and 134th appearance.  
 » Will pitch on extended five days' rest after making his 2018 season debut on April 1 in the Tribe's opening series finale in Seattle...did not factor into the decision, tossing just 5.0 innings (101 pitches), while holding the Mariners to two runs on five hits (1HB, 3BB, 7K)...the Indians went on to lose the game 5-4.  
 » Has faced the Royals 10 times overall in his career, owning a 2-3 record and 3.36 ERA (21ER/56.1IP) across those starts...went 1-1 with a 2.70 ERA (4ER/13.1IP) in three starts against Kansas City in 2017.  
 » Was solid in the Indians rotation last year, posting his lowest full-season ERA (4.19) while also recording career highs in wins (17), strikeouts (196) and innings pitched (176.1).

**LAST TIME OUT**

» Bauer did not factor into the decision in his first outing of the year on April 1 at Seattle (5.0IP, 5H, 2R/ER, 1HB, 3BB, 7K)...now owns a 1-3 record and 3.86 ERA (14ER/32.2IP) in his first start of the year.  
 » Tossed 101 pitches in just 5.0 innings...in 2017, reached the 100-pitch mark in 23 of his 31 starts (74.2 percent)...has thrown 100-or-more pitches in 74 of his 124 career starts (59.7 percent).  
 » Also struck out seven batters in the outing...last year, had seven-or-more strikeouts in 15 of 31 starts, a new career-high.

**SECOND TIME'S THE CHARM**

» Bauer's record in his second start of the season is 3-2 with a 5.27 ERA (16ER/27.1IP), a slight improvement from his numbers in his first start of the year.  
 » After winning three consecutive second starts from 2013-15, Bauer is 0-1 in his last two second starts...the Tribe is 4-1 in Bauer's second start of season.

**VS. KANSAS CITY | DIVISION RECORD**

» Today marks Bauer's 11th career start against the Royals...has compiled a 2-3 record and 3.36 ERA (21ER/56.1IP) in those previous outings...made three starts against the division rival in 2017, going 1-1 with a 2.70 ERA (4ER/13.1IP).  
 » Last faced Kansas City on September 15 at Progressive Field...took the loss, allowing four runs on nine hits across 5.1 innings (1BB, 6K)...loss snapped Cleveland's historic 22-game win streak.  
 » Four of his 10 career starts against the Royals have come at Progressive Field...is 0-2 with a 4.74 ERA (13ER/24.2IP) in those outings...fares better against Kansas City at Kauffman Stadium, where he is 2-1 with a 2.27 ERA (8ER/31.2IP) in six starts.  
 » Tossed the first of his two career complete games vs. the Royals, on July 28, 2015 at Progressive Field...took the loss, allowing just two runs on five hits (one home run), with one walk and six strikeouts.  
 » Bauer made 12 appearances and 11 starts against the A.L. Central division in 2017, finishing the year with a 6-4 record and 4.55 ERA (31ER/61.1IP) against the division...his 13.1 innings pitched against Kansas City were his second-most vs. a divisional opponent last year, behind Minnesota (26.2).  
 » Owns an even 16-16 career record in 52 games (48 starts) against the A.L. Central...also has posted a 4.82 ERA (151ER/282IP) across those outings.

**HOME SWEET HOME**

» In 2017, Bauer's 10-4 record and 3.93 ERA (45ER/103.0IP) at Progressive Field were markedly better than his numbers away from Cleveland (7-5, 4.54 ERA)...his 10 wins at home were tied with Corey Kluber for the team lead, and T2nd in MLB.  
 » Last year, also won a career-best five consecutive home decisions from July 21 to September 10, posting a 5-0 record and 3.13 ERA (11ER/31.2IP) with 34 strikeouts during the streak.  
 » From July 21 to the end of the season, went 6-1 with a 3.06 ERA (17ER/50.0IP) in his final eight home starts.  
 » Overall in his career is 27-20 with a 4.44 ERA (204ER/413.1IP) in 71 outings (67 starts) at home, across his time with both Cleveland and Arizona...that includes a 26-19 career record and 4.41 ERA (198ER/404.0IP) at Progressive Field.  
 » Since the start of the 2015 season, Bauer's 21 home wins rank 6th in the American League and 9th in MLB, among starting pitchers in that timeframe...his 297 home strikeouts rank 5th in the A.L. and 10th in MLB.

**A TREMENDOUS TRIO**

» Last season, Bauer, COREY KLUBER (18 wins, 265K) and CARLOS CARRASCO (17 wins, 226K), were part of the first Indians pitching staff since 1956 to feature three 17-game winners, and the first staff in MLB since the 2003 Yankees.  
 » The trio are also the second in franchise history to each record at least 190 strikeouts in the same season, after KLUBER (245), CARRASCO (216) and DANNY SALAZAR (195) in 2015.  
 » Bauer, Carrasco and Kluber are also the only trio in MLB history with at least 17 wins and 190-plus strikeouts in the same season.

**SPRING STRIKEOUT KING**

» Bauer went 2-1 with a 3.99 ERA (13ER/29.1IP) in seven Spring Training starts, and led MLB with a career-best 39 strikeouts and 29.1 innings pitched, representing the most punchouts in Spring Training by any Indians pitcher since the team returned to Arizona in 2009.

**2017 REGULAR SEASON HIGHLIGHTS**

» Had a career year in the Indians rotation last year, posting his lowest full-season ERA (4.19) while also recording career highs in wins (17), strikeouts (196), innings pitched (176.1) and strikeouts-per-9.0 innings (10.0)...also struck out six-or-more batters in 22 of his 31 starts, good for 6th in the American League...made one relief appearance, in the 8th inning of the second game of a DH on August 17 at Minnesota (0.2IP, 1H, 1K).  
 » Lost two of his first three decisions and went 2-2 with a 6.24 ERA in April, marking his highest ERA in the first month of the season, but rebounded as the season continued.  
 » Struck out a career-high 14 batters in 7.0 innings on May 30 vs. Oakland, equaling the highest single-game strikeout total by a Tribe starter last season.  
 » Dominated after the All-Star Break, going 10-2 with a 3.01 ERA (28ER/83.2IP) in his final 15 appearances (14 starts) of the season...his 10 second-half wins ranked T2nd in the A.L. and his 3.01 ERA ranked T5th among A.L. starters (min. 80.0IP).  
 » Won a career-best nine consecutive decisions from July 21 to September 10, spanning 11 starts...posted a 2.51 ERA (18ER/64.2IP) in that span...streak marked the longest by an Indians pitcher last season.

**2017 POSTSEASON RECAP**

» Started Games 1 and 4 for Cleveland in the 2017 American League Division Series against New York-AL, winning the first game at Progressive Field with 6.2 shutout innings (2H, 1BB, 8K)...eight strikeouts in Game 2 marked his most in a postseason start...took the loss in Game 4 at Yankee Stadium after allowing four runs (all unearned) over 1.2 innings (4H, 2BB/1BB, 3K).
