WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox have lost five consecutive games but won 14 of 25 and 19 of 36 as they begin their penultimate trip of the season tonight with the series opener at Kansas City.
- RHP Lucas Giolito, who has made six consecutive quality starts on the road since 7/8, will make the start for the White Sox.
- The Sox went 3-7 on their last homestand, their second-to-last of the season ... they were swept by Angels over the weekend, lost two of three to Detroit and split a four-game series vs. Boston.
- Following this three-game series at the Royals, the Sox will continue the trip with an off day Thursday, three games at Baltimore (9/14-16), an off day next Monday and finish with three games at Cleveland (9/18-20).
- The Sox went 5-2 on their last trip to Detroit (3-1) and New York-AL (2-1) from 8/23-29.

TONIGHT'S STORYLINES

- The White Sox have lost five consecutive games, their longest losing streak since 7/4-10 (six straight).
- Chicago needs to win seven of its final 19 games to avoid the fourth 100-loss season in franchise history (on pace to go 63-99).
- The Sox are 5-6 over the last 11 games vs. Kansas City after winning the first five in the season series.
- The Sox have scored four runs or less in each of the last six games (2.3 R/G), batting .205/.259/.300 with four homers ... they have been held to five hits or less three times during that span.
- Lucas Giolito is 3-0 with a 2.01 ERA (7 ER/31.1 IP), .191 average and 1.05 WHIP in five career starts (four QS) vs. the Royals.
- Matt Davidson needs one home run to set a new club record for homers vs. Kansas City in a single season.

ROSTER MOVE

- Prior to tonight's game at Kansas City, Chicago reinstated 1B José Abreu from the disabled list ... he was placed on the DL on 8/22 following successful surgery to relieve a testicular torsion.
- Following the move, the Sox active roster increases to 31.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

- José Alvarez struck out pinch-hitter Nicky Delmonico with the tying run on third base and the winning run on first to close the Angels' 1-0 win, completing a series sweep.
- Kole Calhoun drove in the only run of the game with a RBI single in the seventh off rookie Caleb Frare.
- Starter Reynaldo López received a ND despite allowing just two hits with a season-high tying 10 strikeouts over 6.0 scoreless IP ... rookie Ian Hamilton (1 ER/0.2 IP) suffered his first MLB loss.
- Yoán Moncada (2-3) recorded the Sox only multihit effort.
- The White Sox were limited to five hits (all singles), did not walk, struck out 14 times, went 0-5 with RISP and left six on base.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME

- Lucas Giolito is 7-4 with a 4.27 ERA (41 ER/86.1 IP) and .224 opponents average over his 14 road starts ... he has allowed three earned runs or less in 11 of the outings.
- He has made six straight QS on the road, going 4-1 with a 2.97 ERA (13 ER/39.1 IP), .188 opp. average and 1.02 WHIP.

POSTSEASON VOYAGE

- Advanced Rookie Great Falls will face Grand Junction in the best-of-three Pioneer League championship series.
- Game 1 is set for tomorrow (7:40 p.m. CT) at Grand Junction ... Great Falls will host Game 2 on Thursday (8:00 p.m. CT), and a winner-take-all Game 3 on Saturday (8:00 p.m. CT).
- The Voyagers lost to Ogden in the 2017 championship series.

STARTING STRUGGLES

- Chicago starters have allowed 21 earned runs on 30 hits, including seven homers and 12 walks over the last five games (19.2 IP) ... RHP Reynaldo López (yesterday) is the only White Sox pitcher during that span to work into the sixth inning.
- By comparison, White Sox starters went 5-1 with a 2.01 ERA (15 ER/67.0 IP), just six homers allowed, a .176 opponents average and seven QS in the previous 11 games from 8/24-9/3.

ON-BASE MACHINE

- Yolmer Sánchez has reached base safely in 25 of his last 26 games (hit safely in 22), hitting .305 (29-95) with seven doubles, one HR, five RBI, 14 walks, three HBP and seven multihit efforts.
- Sánchez reached base safely in a career-high 22 consecutive games from 8/11-9/3, the longest streak by a White Sox since 1B José Abreu (29 games) from 8/2-9/2/16.

WHITE SOX VS. KANSAS CITY

- The White Sox lead the season series, 10-6, going 5-4 at Guaranteed Rate Field and 5-2 at Kauffman Stadium.
- Chicago is 5-6 over the last 11 games after winning the first five in the season series.
- The Sox are hitting .290/.358/.525 with 31 home runs, own a 3.63 ERA (58 ER/144.0 IP) and have made seven quality starts ... they have outscored the Royals, 94-69.
- The White Sox are 20-15 vs. Kansas City since 2017 after going 40-72 from 2011-16 ... they are averaging 5.7 runs per game (2013 vs. Minnesota) with 47 homers during the 35-game stretch.
- The Sox lead the all-time series, 395-378 ... they are 219-174 at home (127-104 at Guaranteed Rate Field) and 176-204 on the road (165-182 at Kauffman Stadium).

RAISED VS. THE ROYALS

- Matt Davidson is 17-45 (.378) with eight home runs and 14 RBI in 12 games vs. Kansas City this season.
- He is tied with Albert Belle (1998) and José Valentin (2003) for the most homers by a Sox vs. the Royals in a single season.
- The last player to hit eight homers vs. a team was Adam Dunn (2013 vs. Minnesota), and the last to hit nine was Roy Sievers (1960 vs. Washington) ... Gus Zernial, who hit 11 vs. the St. Louis Browns in 1950, owns the club record (STATS LLC).

LOOKING FOR CENTRAL COMMAND

- Chicago is 27-36 against the American League Central in 2018, going 13-21 at Guaranteed Rate Field and 14-15 on the road.
- The Sox need to win 11 of their final 13 games vs. the division to record a .500 mark, and 12 to finish above .500.
- The White Sox have won four of the last six games, and 10 of the last 15 by a 76-66 margin ... they have won three straight games and six of the last seven on the road.
- The White Sox are 318-413 vs. the AL Central since 2009, posting a losing record every season except 2012 (37-36).

PALKA POWER

- Daniel Palka, who was claimed off waivers from Minnesota on 11/4/17, ranks among the American League rookie leaders in home runs (3rd, 21), RBI (3rd, 55), extra-base hits (T3rd, 38), total bases (5th, 168) and runs scored (T5th, 47).
- Palka's 21 homers are the second-highest total in Sox history by a LH rookie, one behind Pete Ward's club record of 22 in 1963.
- His three pinch-hit homers this season are tied with Oscar Gamble (1977), John Romano (1959) and Ron Northey (1956) for the White Sox franchise record, and his nine RBI are the most by a Sox pinch-hitter since Jerry Hairston in 1987 (10).

POWER AND SPEED

- Tim Anderson (18 HR/26 SB) is one of four players in the major leagues with at least 18 home runs and 26 stolen bases this season, joining Boston's Mookie Betts, Pittsburgh's Starling Marte and Cleveland's José Ramírez.
- Anderson is attempting to become the first White Sox shortstop to record a 20-HR/20-SB season, and could join Alex Ríos (2010) and Tommie Agee (1966) as the only players in franchise history to post 20 homers and 30 steals in one season.

GRAB SOME BENCH

- Chicago has struck out 1,384 times in 2018, the most in MLB ... it is 13 shy of tying the club record of 1,397 set last season.
- Yoán Moncada leads MLB with 194 strikeouts in 2018 ... he is 28 shy of tying Adam Dunn (222 in 2012) for the club record.

ABREU'S HISTORIC RUN

- José Abreu needs three homers to become the ninth player in MLB history with 25-plus homers in his first five-plus seasons.
- He is on-pace for 25 HR/88 RBI in 2018, and was on-pace for 29 HR/102 RBI before missing 18 games while on the DL.
- Abreu (2014-17), Hall-of-Famer Joe DiMaggio (1936-41) and Albert Pujols (2001-10) are the only players in major-league history to begin their careers with at least four consecutive seasons of 25-plus home runs and 100-plus RBI.
- He already has joined Al Simmons (11, 1924-34), Pujols (10, 2001-10), Ted Williams (1939-42, '46-49) and DiMaggio (1936-42) as the only players in history to record 100 or more RBI in each of his first four seasons.

QUALITY AND QUANTITY

- The White Sox have made 1,380 quality starts since the start of the 2003 season, tied with the New York Mets for the highest total in the major leagues, and 52 more than Oakland (1,328), the next-closest American League team.
- The Sox rank third in the AL with 64 quality starts in 2018 ... RHP James Shields is tied for seventh in the AL with 17 QS.

GIOLITO AT A GLANCE

- The 24-year-old makes his 29th start of the season (15th on the road) and fourth against Kansas City ... his 28 starts have more than doubled his major-league total of 11 entering the season.
- Leads the team with 10 wins (Carlos Rodón and James Shields are second with six apiece).
- Is 3-1 with a 4.05 ERA (12 ER/26.2 IP), 30 strikeouts and a 1.13 WHIP over his last five starts and 5-3 with a 4.31 ERA (30 ER/62.2 IP), 60 strikeouts and a .213 (49-230) opponents average over his last 11.
- Owns a 3.75 SO/BB ratio (30 SO/8 BB) over his last five starts, down from 1.18 over his first 23.
- Has made six straight quality starts on the road, going 4-1 with a 2.97 ERA (13 ER/39.1 IP).
- Has gone 3-6 with an 7.91 ERA (58 ER/66.0 IP) over 14 starts at home this season and 7-4 with a 4.27 ERA (41 ER/86.1 IP) in 14 road starts.
- Made his first career Opening Day roster.
- Was acquired from Washington on 12/7/16 with RHP Dane Dunning and RHP Reynaldo López in exchange for OF Adam Eaton.

LAST START

- Suffered his 10th loss on 9/5 vs. Detroit, allowing five runs (four earned) on four hits over 1.1 IP, matching the shortest start of his career ... walked two and struck out three ... pitched a 1-2-3 first inning before giving up all of his runs and hits in the second ... left with a 4-0 deficit after throwing 50 pitches (31 strikes) ... Sox lost, 8-3.

2018 STARTS OF INTEREST

- Carried a two-hit shutout into the seventh inning on 8/30 vs. Boston ... earned his 10th victory on 8/25 at Detroit, allowing one run on three hits over 7.0 IP ... posted a no decision on 8/3 at Tampa Bay despite allowing one run on two hits over 7.0 IP ... carried a one-hit shutout into the eighth inning.
- Threw 6.1 scoreless IP on 7/15 vs. Kansas City ... lost on 7/8 at Houston despite allowing two runs on three hits over a career-high 7.1 IP ... carried a no-hitter through 5.1 IP on 6/28 vs. Minnesota ... pitched into the eighth inning for the first time in his career on 6/22-2 vs. Oakland.
- Allowed a career-high nine hits on 5/29 at Cleveland but did not issue a walk for the first time this season ... lasted 1.1 IP on 5/24 vs. Baltimore, the shortest start of his career ... won 5/13 at the Cubs despite walking a career-high tying seven batters ... became the third Sox pitcher since 2005 to earn the victory while issuing seven-plus walks, joining Derek Holland on 8/8/17 vs. Houston (seven over 5.2 IP) and Gavin Floyd on 4/13/09 at Detroit (seven over 5.0 IP).
- Earned his first victory of the season and first career road win on 4/26 at Kansas City ... allowed career highs of nine runs and seven walks over 2.0 IP on 4/21 vs. Houston.

BETTER WITH AGE

- Owns a combined 8.23 ERA (50 ER/54.2 IP) in the first two innings this season and 4.00 (39 ER/87.2 IP) from innings 3-6 ... opponents are hitting .256 (53-207) the first time through the lineup, but that number drops to .230 (48-209) the second time and .228 (36-158) the third time.

DAY AND NIGHT

- Has gone 7-4 with a 3.72 ERA (35 ER/84.2 IP) and .195 (59-303) opponents average over 14 starts during the day since 2017, compared to 6-9 with a 6.05 ERA (76 ER/113.0 IP) and .256 (112-437) opponents average in 21 starts at night.

2017 RECAP

- Made 24 starts with Class AAA Charlotte and seven with the White Sox in his first season in the organization.
- Went 3-2 with a 1.83 ERA (8 ER/39.1 IP), 30 strikeouts, a .177 (25-141) opponents average and 0.94 WHIP over his final six starts with the Sox ... five of the outings were quality.
- Was recalled on 8/22 and made his White Sox debut that night vs. Minnesota (4 ER/6.0 IP; 3 HR) ... earned his first win with the Sox on 8/27 vs. Detroit, allowing just three hits over 7.0 scoreless IP.
- Allowed one run and struck out a career-high 10 over 7.0 IP on 9/3 vs. Tampa Bay ... became the first Sox pitcher to strike out 10-plus batters within his first three starts with the club since Chris Sale in 2012.
- Received a ND on 9/13 at Kansas City, allowing one run on four hits in 6.1 IP ... became the 15th Sox pitcher to make four-plus straight starts of 5.0-plus IP and four hits or less allowed.
- Began the season with Charlotte ... threw his first professional no-hitter on 5/25-1 vs. Syracuse (7.0 IP), marking the first no-hitter in BB&T Ballpark history ... was named IL Pitcher of the Week for 5/22-28.

HOLLYWOOD BLOODLINES

- His parents, Rick Giolito and Lindsay Frost, are Hollywood actors ... Rick has appeared in "As the World Turns," "Who's the Boss," "Hunter," "Jake and the Fatman," "Twin Peaks" and "Hit the Dutchman" ... Lindsay acted in "The Ring," "Collateral Damage," "Without a Trace," "The Unit," "Boston Legal," "Crossing Jordan," "Lost," "Frasier" and "CSI."
- His uncle, Mark Frost, is a co-creator and writer of the ABC and Showtime drama "Twin Peaks." ... grandfather, Warren Frost, was a veteran actor who played George Costanza's father-in-law, Henry Ross, on the award-winning sitcom "Seinfeld."

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Was selected by Washington in the first round (16th overall) of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft ... was committed to play baseball at UCLA prior to signing with the Nationals.
- Is a 2012 graduate of Harvard-Westlake High School in Los Angeles, where he was teammates with current major-leaguers RHPs Jack Flaherty (St. Louis) and Max Fried (Atlanta).

VS. KANSAS CITY ROYALS

- Makes his fifth career start against Kansas City and fourth of the season ... has gone 2-0 with a 2.50 ERA (5 ER/18.0 IP) in 2018 and 3-0 with a 2.01 ERA (7 ER/31.1 IP) lifetime.
- Won his last start on 7/15 in Chicago, allowing two hits over 6.1 scoreless IP ... also won his last start at Kauffman Stadium on 4/26/18, giving up two runs on six hits over 5.2 IP ... posted a ND in his first start of the season on 4/1 in Kansas City (3 ER/6.0 IP).
- Posted a ND on 9/13/17 at Kansas City despite giving up one run on four hits over 6.1 IP ... earned the win in his final start of the season on 9/24/17 at Guaranteed Rate Field, yielding just one run on five hits over 7.0 IP.
