## CHICAGO CUBS NOTES

**KYLE HENDRICKS** has allowed two earned runs or fewer in five-straight starts, posting a 1.80 ERA (6 ER/30.0 IP) in that stretch.

**KRIS BRYANT** (2-for-3, 2B, RBI, BB) has three doubles and three RBI in his last four games.

**NOTES:** The Cubs lost their first series at home since dropping both games of a two-game set vs. Cleveland on May 22-23 ... were 11-0-3 in their last 14 home series.

- © Tommy La Stella (1-for-1, R) notched his 23rd pinch-hit of the season, 10 more than the next closer player (Chase Utley, 13).
- © Javier Báez (0-for-3, BB) has drawn a walk in a season-high three-straight games.

## MILWAUKEE BREWERS NOTES

**CHASE ANDERSON** allowed zero runs in a start for the third time this season ... also did so against the Cubs, June 12 at Miller Park (7.0 IP, 1 H) ... has a 1.13 ERA (3 ER/24.0 IP) in four starts vs. the Cubs this season.

**CURTIS GRANDERSON** (3-for-4, 3B, HR, 3 R, RBI, HBP) finished a double shy of the cycle ... hit his 94th-career triple in the first inning ... scored a season-high tying three runs ... went 5-for-9 with a triple, two homers, five runs and three RBI in four games vs. the Cubs this season.

**LORENZO CAIN** (3-for-5, R, RBI, SB) batted .338 (24-for-71) in 19 games this season vs. the Cubs, including a .457 mark (16-for-35) in his last nine games.

**CHRISTIAN YELICH** (1-for-3, R, BB, 2 SB, HBP) has reached base safely in a career-high 28-straight games, the longest active streak in the N.L.

**NOTES:** The Brewers are 11-3 in their last 14 games ... have won seven-straight series.

- © The Brewers finished the season series with seven wins in their last 10 games vs. the Cubs ... went 8-11 vs. the Cubs overall.
- © Domingo Santana (1-for-1, 2B) hit a pinch-hit double in the seventh inning, his first extra-base hit since June 15 vs. Philadelphia.
- © Mike Moustakas (1-for-5, 2 RBI) has 87 RBI this season (including Kansas City), a new career-high (previous high was 85 RBI last season).
