WINS AND LOSSES: The Rangers suffered a 4-3 walkoff loss to the Royals yesterday and have a 2-1 record to begin this 10-day, 10-game road trip to KC (2-1), BAL (4 G), and TB (3 G)...team has won 2 of 3, 5 of 7 and is 18-14 (.563) since 6/9, 5th-best in A.L. in that stretch and T9th in MLB...club has a 6-5 record in July and has dropped 8 of 14, 9 of 16, and 13 of 24...Texas has won 19 of 34 and 32 of 58...club has 40-36 (.526) record beginning 4/20, T4th-best in A.L./T9th in MLB.

• At 45-46 (.494), Rangers are 9th in the A.L. in winning percentage...club reached .500 mark with Saturday's win for 1st time since 6/28 (39-39), but have not had a winning mark since 6/27 (39-38)...Texas has had a winning record on just 3 occasions in the last 53 days...club was 54-37/54-38 thru 91/92 G in '16.

• Club has been season-high 3 G above .500 twice, last on 5/21 (24-21), and was a 2017 high 7 games under .500 (13-20) on 5/8...season best 10-G win streak 5/9-19 was 4th-longest in franchise history...Rangers are 6-3-2 in their last 11 overall series after securing a series win in KC.

IN THE STANDINGS: The Rangers are T2nd place in the A.L. West w/ SEA, 16.5 games behind HOU...days in each position in 2017 (alone or tied): 1st-0 days, 2nd-36, 3rd-25, 4th-31, 5th-13...Saturday was just 4th time in 29 days to gain ground in the West...season-high 17.0-G deficit both 7/4-5, team's greatest at any point since end of the 2014 season (-31.0 GB)...still just 2.5 GB of a wild card spot in the A.L.

VS. BALTIMORE: Rangers have played 17 opponents in 2017, 13 in the A.L. and 4 in the N.L., but have yet to face the Orioles ahead of this week's 4-G set in Baltimore...club was 4-3 vs. O's in '16 and Rangers have a 10-4 advantage in the past 2 seasons...Texas has gone 11-15 since 7/10/13, but leads 23-18 since start of 2011...club is 4-3 at Camden Yards in 2015-16, but is 4-9 at this park since 7/10/13...both series in '17 take place this month, also 7/28-30 in Arlington...O's have leads in all-time series (251-204-1), in BAL (127-102-1), and at Camden Yards (60-56-1).

HOMER HAPPY: Over the last 10 seasons (2008-17), the Rangers have averaged 1.36 HR/G at Camden Yards (53 HR/39 G), club's highest figure in any A.L. park in that span...it is the 3rd-highest average for any A.L. team at this facility in that 10-season stretch, trailing only BOS (1.54 HR/G) and DET (1.43) - w/ BAL just barely behind TEX with a lower 1.36 HR/G...for comparison's sake, TEX has averaged 1.23 HR/G at Globe Life Park since 2008.

ON THE ROAD: The Rangers have won 2 of 3 and 3 of last 5 away games, but have dropped 5 of 8, 6 of 10, and 8 of last 14 road tilts since a season-best 6-G road win streak from 5/28-6/13...club is still 12-8 in road contests since 5/28...prior to this 11-8 span, the club had won just 6 of its previous 17 away contests...the Rangers' .435 (20-26) road winning percentage is 10th in the A.L...club was 25-21/25-22 in 2016.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Texas is opening the 2nd 'half' on the road for a 4th straight season, matching a club record (2005-08, 1995-98)...also on road post-break for 7th time in 8 years, and 11th time in 13 years beginning 2005...this 10-G road trip would be the longest right after the AS break for Texas since 2006, when team played 11 consecutive road games at BAL/TOR/BOS/CWS, a span which included a one-game makeup date at Fenway on 7/20...this will be 3rd straight year with a 9+ G trip following the break.

FOUR DAYS: Rangers have gone 1-2-1 in 4-G series this season, including 0-2-1 on the road...this marks 3rd time in 4 years to play a 4-G set at Camden Yards, as club was 0-4 here from 6/30-7/3/14 and went 3-1 in last instance 6/29-7/2/15...in the 2015 series, Texas hit 8 HR in the 1st 2 games for wins of 8-1 and 8-6, with Mitch Moreland hitting 2 HR in both contests, before taking a 2-0 victory in the finale.

BELTRE CHASING 3000: Adrian Beltre enters this series with 2980 career hits, 32nd all-time and 20 shy of becoming the 31st player in MLB history to reach 3000 hits...the only players w/ 3000 career hits while appearing primarily at 3rd base are HOFers George Brett (3154) and Wade Boggs (3010)...Beltre is currently tied with Barry Bonds for 16th place all-time with 601 doubles, just 2 shy of matching Cal Ripken Jr. (603).

ADRIAN AND THE O'S: Since 2009, Adrian Beltre has been a .340/.383/.632/1.014 (84-247) hitter against Baltimore with 18 HR, 18 2B, 50 RBI, and 45 runs in 63 G...among batters with 200+ PA's vs. BAL in that span, his 1.014 OPS ranks 3rd and the .340 avg. is 4th...Beltre has 11 career HR here at Camden Yards, but no HR in this park since a 4-H, 2-HR, 5-RBI effort on 7/9/13.

ANOTHER LATE LOSS: Texas suffered a 4-3 walkoff loss yesterday in KC on a sunball single off Shin-Soo Choo's glove in RF that would have sent the game to extra innings had it been caught...it was the Rangers' 5th walkoff loss in '17, T2nd-most in the A.L. (6-TOR, 5-TEX/CWS/KC) and T6th in MLB...it was the club's A.L.-high 14th last at-bat defeat, T2nd in MLB (16-PHI, 14-TEX/MIL).

ONE-RUN DEFEATS: Texas is now 7-15 (.318) in one-run games, lowest win pct. in the A.L. and 2nd-lowest in MLB (PHI-.314, 11-24)...the 15 one-run defeats are 2nd-most in A.L. and 4th in majors (24-PHI, 18-NYY, 17-STL, 15-TEX).

NAPOLI AT 20: Mike Napoli homered in 2 of the 3 games in KC over the weekend to bring his season total to 20 HR, his 8th career season with 20+ HR, including 3 times with the Rangers (also 2011-12)...he ranks T10th in the A.L. with 20 HR in 2017, 2nd-most among Rangers (Gallo-21)...he has HR in 6 of 10 G this month, and leads all ML players with 6 HR in July.

DREW ROBINSON hit his 3rd HR yesterday, just the 3rd player in Rangers history with 3 HR in his 1st 6 ML games, joining Ruben Sierra (1986) and Taylor Teagarden (2008)...each of his 1st 4 ML hits have been XBH (3 HR, 2B).

TWO RUNS FOR DARVISH: Yu Darvish posted a quality start yesterday for the 4th time in 5 outings, but he remains winless since 6/12...during his 0-4 span over his last 6 starts, he has received a total of 5 runs of support while in the game and his 3.45 run support per 9 average ranks T4th-lowest in the A.L. in 2017.

• With 6 SO yesterday, Darvish now has 943 SO in his career, passing Nolan Ryan (939) for 4th place in Rangers history.

ALEX CLAUDIO appeared in all 3 G in Kansas City, recorded 3 outs in each outing despite 8-or-fewer pitches in all 3 appearances...he is the 1st Ranger with 3+ outs on 8-pitches-or-less in 3 consecutive appearances since pitches were 1st tracked in 1988...only other pitcher to do it in last 7 seasons was LaTroy Hawkins (w/ COL) in April 2014, and no A.L. pitcher had done it since KC's John Bale in Sept. 2008.

• Claudio's average of 12.6 pitches per inning is easily the lowest for any ML reliever, a full pitch less on average than 2nd place T.J. McFarland for ARI (13.6).

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER

#54 Andrew Cashner, RHP (4-7, 3.54)

TONIGHT: The 30-year-old right-hander is slated to make his 15th start of the season in tonight's series opener against the Orioles...earned the win in last start on 7/5 vs. BOS (7.0 IP, 2 R-0 ER), an 8-2 Texas victory...was his 2nd outing without allowing an earned run, but still has gone 2-3 with a 4.66 ERA (15 ER/29.0 IP) in his last 5 starts (beg. 6/3) to raise season ERA from 2.92 to 3.54... was on the disabled list from 6/15-28 with a left oblique strain...did not require a rehab assignment, completing a 41 pitch bullpen on 6/24 in New York...also was struck by a piece of a broken bat on 6/29 at CLE, but did not miss a start...has quality starts in 7 of last 11 outings and his 8 QS overall are T2nd-most among Rangers (14-Darvish) despite a pair of DL stints...has allowed 2-ER-or-less in 9 of 14 starts...has earned wins in 4 of his last 8 starts after a span of 10 straight winless starts dating to 2016...Texas is 6-8 in Cashner's starts this season... began the season on the DL with upper right biceps soreness and was activated on 4/15 prior to start at SEA...signed with Texas as a free agent on 11/21/16 after spending last season with Padres and Marlins.

LAST START: Earned the win in an 8-2 Texas victory on 7/5 vs. BOS (7.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R-0 ER, 3 BB, 4 SO, 1 HR, 110 pitches/71 strikes)...did not allow a hit until a Xander Bogaerts 2 out, 2-run home run in the 6th inning...eclipsed the 100-pitch mark for the 1st time this season, tossing a season-high 110 pitches...was his 5th career start of 7.0+ IP, 0 ER, and 3-or-fewer hits, 1st since 9/15/14 vs. PHI... marked his 2nd career win in Arlington, improving to 2-2 with a 2.50 ERA (10 ER/36.0 IP) in 6 home starts this season.

VS. BALTIMORE: In only career start vs. Orioles, took no decision for Padres on 5/14/13 at Camden Yards (7.1 IP, 5 H, 2 R-1 ER, 1 BB, 3 SO, 1 HR, 92 pitches/57 strikes)...opposed tonight's counterpart Chris Tillman and allowed solo HR to Ryan Flaherty...was his 5th start after being installed as a full-time starter.

ON THE ROAD: Has gone 2-5, 4.37 (22 ER/45.1 IP) over 8 road starts...posted quality starts in 4 of 8 outings...is 0-2, 9.00 (9 ER/9.0 IP) in last 2 road starts, this after back-to-back road wins at TOR and WAS...is the only A.L. starter to not allow a home run on the road (min. 25.0 IP)...opponents have batted .263/.344/.333/.677 on the road compared to .261/.340/.433/.773 in Arlington... win on 5/28 at TOR snapped a streak of 18 straight winless road starts.

INTENTIONAL GROUNDING: Has allowed one HR in last 7 starts and has permitted just 6 HR in 81.1 IP, as his 0.66 HR/9 ranks 4th in A.L. among starters with 14+ GS...still ranks T15th among A.L. starters with 11 GIDP, T2nd on staff (Martin Perez-17)...ground ball percentage (50.2%) is 7th in A.L. among pitchers with at least 14 starts and 1st among Texas starters.

RUNNERS IN SCORING POSITION: Opponents batting .160 (12-75) w/ RISP, lowest in the A.L., and 2nd-lowest in the majors (Gio Gonzalez-.124)...7 of his 12 hits allowed w/ RISP have come vs. HOU, including 3 in a span of 4 BF on 6/3 vs. HOU...opposing hitters are 1-for-30 (.033) w/ RISP and 2 outs off Cashner... overall, opponents are 28-for-141 (.199) with men on base.

ALL YOU NEED IS LOVE: Received 8 runs of support in last start to raise season run support average from 3.87 to 4.43, 2nd-lowest on staff (Darvish-3.45)...had received 7 total runs of support over previous 3 outings (1-1-5)...had a combined 6 runs of support in his 1st 6 outings...received no runs in his 1st 3 starts...Texas did not score with Cashner on the mound in his 1st 16.1 innings this season...in last 4 starts, run support average has jumped from 1.62 to 3.43...career 3.77 run support average as a starter is lowest among MLB starters since 2010.

2017: Has the 2nd-lowest SO/9 (4.43) figure in MLB among pitchers with at least 50.0 IP (SF's Ty Blach - 4.21) and nearly 3 SO lower than his career rate (7.24)...his 3.98 BB/9 rate is 2nd-highest among Texas starters (Tyson Ross-4.62)...opponents swing and miss on 15.1% of pitches, 4th-lowest mark in MLB (min. 50.0 IP)...his 50.2% ground ball percentage is equal to his career average, but highest since 2013 (53.7)...was winless in his 1st 6 starts of the season for the 1st time in his career...Lucroy has caught 13 starts and Chirinos caught 6/29 at CLE, as well as one inning in last start...nearly identical numbers vs. left/right, as opposing LH hitters are hitting .260 w/ .735 OPS and RH batters have .264 avg. w/ .704 OPS...opp. leading off an inning have .273 (21-77) avg. w/ 9 XBH (7 2B, 2 HR), 9 BB and 13 SO...opponents by time through order, 1st PA: .243 (27-111); 2nd PA: .236 (26-110); 3rd PA: .325 (26-80); 4th PA: 1-4...11 H allowed on 6/3 vs. HOU matched career high...posted 4 straight quality starts from 5/1-17.

DISABLED LIST: Was placed on the disabled list 6/17 (retroactive to 6/15) with a left oblique strain, an injury he 1st felt in his previous start on 6/14 at HOU... did not require a rehab assignment, completing a 41 pitch bullpen on 6/24 in New York...also was struck in the stomach and right forearm by a piece of Edwin Encarnacion's broken bat in the 6th inning on 6/29 at CLE, but didn't miss a start.

RETURN FROM INJURY: Missed majority of spring training with upper right biceps soreness that was originally diagnosed on 3/2...saw Dr. Greg Pearl in Dallas and received 2 injections on 3/10...threw a bullpen on 3/17 in his 1st return to the mound since the injury...earned the save (3.0 IP, 0 R-ER) in only

'A' game appearance on 3/31 vs. KC at Globe Life Park in Arlington...was due to start for Double-A Frisco on 4/10, but was sent to extended spring due to inclement weather forecast in the DFW area.

LIKE TEXAS: Is the 1st native-born Texas pitcher to start for the Rangers since Mesquite's Jason Jennings (6 starts in 2008)...the Conroe native earned his 1st victory in his native state on 5/17 vs. PHI at Globe Life Park, 2nd on 7/5 vs. BOS...had gone winless in his 1st 10 G/5 GS between Globe Life Park and Minute Maid Park to begin career.

TOMORROW'S SCHEDULED STARTER — RHP TYSON ROSS (2-1, 5.33 ERA in 5 games/starts)

The 30-year-old right-hander is slated to make his 6th start and appearance of the season tomorrow night in the 2nd of 4 games at Camden Yards this week...opponents are batting .182 (10-55) over his last 3 starts, but also has 9 BB and 3 HBP in that span...last pitched in a 5-2 Texas win on 7/8 vs. LAA (5.2 IP, 4 H, 1 R-ER, 2 BB, 3 SO, 1 HR, 94 pitches/48 strikes)...has allowed 2 R-or-less in 3 of his 1st 5 starts this season...is averaging 6.39 SO/9 and 4.62 BB/9 over his 1st 5 starts...his 40.3% ground ball rate through 5 starts would be a career low (previous low was 47.6% in 9 G/6 GS w/OAK in 2011)...has gone 0-2 with a 17.10 ERA (19 ER/10.0 IP) over 7 games/one start in his career vs. the Orioles, but has not faced the O's since 2012...is 0-2, 20.25 (15 ER/6.2 IP) over 4 games/one start at Camden Yards, taking the loss in a 10-1 Oakland defeat on 4/28/12 here in Baltimore (4.0 IP, 11 H, 9 R), his lone career start vs. the O's...has no record and a 4.09 ERA (5 ER/11.0 IP) in a pair of starts on the road this season... last road victory was 8/26/15 over the Nationals in nearby Washington, D.C...prior to season debut on 6/16 vs. SEA, had not appeared in majors since Padres' 2016 season opener due to right shoulder issues and eventual 10/13/16 surgery to relieve Thoracic Outlet Syndrome...victory in Texas debut on 6/16 vs. SEA (5.2 IP, 2 R-ER) was 1st win since beating Rangers on 8/31/15 at Petco Park, as Ross became 2nd Texas starter in last 25 years (beg. 1993) to allow 2-or-fewer hits while recording 17+ outs in Rangers debut...made 4 rehab starts for Triple-A Round Rock, going 2-1 with a 7.71 ERA (16 ER/18.2 IP)...named 2015 Padres Pitcher of the Year and was tabbed Opening Day starter last season...signed with Texas as a free agent on 1/19/17 after spending the last 4 seasons with San Diego...selected in the 2nd round of the 2008 June Draft by Oakland and spent his 1st 5 pro seasons with the A's before being traded to San Diego on 11/16/12...previously pitched in his major league career with Oakland (2010-12) and San Diego (2013-16)...the Berkeley native pitched 3 seasons at Cal...brother of Washington Nationals pitcher Joe Ross...Rangers are 3-2 in his 5 starts.
