#### WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox open the home portion of their schedule this afternoon vs. Detroit ... RHP James Shields takes the mound for the White Sox, who are tied with Minnesota for first place in the American League Central.
- The Sox opened the season with a 3-2 trip to Kansas City (2-0) and Toronto (1-2), rallying to win both games of an abbreviated two-game series against the Royals before losing two of three games to the Blue Jays.
- Following today's game and a day off tomorrow, the Sox will continue the homestand with two games vs. Detroit (4/7-8) and three vs. Tampa Bay (4/9-11) ... they then will take a seven-game trip to Minnesota (4/12-15) and Oakland (4/16-18).
- Sunday's game against the Royals was postponed due to weather and rescheduled as part of a split doubleheader on 4/28.

#### TODAY'S STORYLINES

- The White Sox are 62-55 all-time in home openers (12-13 vs. Detroit) and have won 12 of their last 16.
- The Sox have won 10 of their last 14 home games vs. Detroit, outscoring the Tigers by a 69-42 margin.
- The White Sox lead the major leagues with 14 home runs.
- Chicago has led at some point in all five games this season.
- José Abreu is a .392/460/.577 (51-130) hitter in 35 career home games vs. Detroit.

#### LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

- José Abreu hit a game-winning home run off Ryan Tepera in the eighth inning as the White Sox avoided a three-game sweep with a 4-3 victory over Toronto.
- Aaron Bummer (0.2 IP), Danny Farquhar (1.0), Nate Jones (1.1) and Joakim Soria (1.0) combined for 4.0 scoreless IP in relief, with Jones earning his first win and Soria his second save.
- Carson Fulmer posted a no decision, allowing three runs on five hits with one walk and five strikeouts over 5.0 IP.
- Matt Davidson gave the Sox a 1-0 lead in the second with a home run off Aaron Sanchez, his fourth of the season ... Yolmer Sánchez went 2-4 with a double and run scored.

#### GETTING THE NOD ... AGAIN

- James Shields will become the first White Sox pitcher since Mark Buehrle in 2002 to start both a season and home opener.
- Buehrle made his first career Opening Day start on 4/1/02 at Seattle (W; 1 ER/6.0 IP) and also started the Sox home opener on 4/12/02 vs. Baltimore (W; 1 ER/7.0 IP).
- Shields made his eighth career Opening Day start on 3/29 at Kansas City (W, 4 ER/6.0 IP), tying Clayton Kershaw for fourth-most among active pitchers behind Félix Hernández (12) and CC Sabathia and Justin Verlander (11 each) ... source: STATS LLC.

#### HAWK'S FAREWELL

- Ken "Hawk" Harrelson, who is in his 33rd and final season in the White Sox television booth in 2018, will call today's game alongside Jason Benetti and Steve Stone.
- Harrelson will work primarily Sunday home games this season as well as select other contests ... he will serve the organization as a team ambassador throughout the 2019 season, which will mark the beginning of his eighth decade in baseball.

#### WELCOME BACK A.J.

- White Sox great and 2005 World Series Champion A.J. Pierzynski will throw out a ceremonial first pitch.
- The two-time American League All-Star catcher batted .279 (1,087-3,896) with 198 doubles, 118 home runs, 460 RBI and 452 runs scored in 1,068 games over eight seasons with the Sox from 2005-12.
- Pierzynski is tied for the major-league record with 13 consecutive seasons (2001-13) of at least 100 games caught and ranks sixth in major-league history with 16,335.1 IC ... he joined the White Sox this offseason as a team ambassador.

#### ON THE FARM

- The White Sox top four minor-league affiliates begin play tonight, with Class AAA Charlotte at Durham (RHP Dylan Covey), Class AA Birmingham at Chattanooga (RHP Spencer Adams), Class A Winston-Salem at Carolina (RHP Dane Dunning) and Class A Kannapolis home vs. Lakewood (RHP Kade McClure).

#### WHO'S HOT?

- Avisail García is hitting .380/.434/.547 (73-192) over his last 51 games dating back to 8/10/17.
- José Abreu is batting .374/.413/.707 (37-99) with seven home runs and 21 RBI over his last 25 games (since 9/9/17).
- Tim Anderson owns a .336 average (42-125) with six homers, 15 RBI and 26 runs scored over his last 30 games (since 9/3/17).

#### WHITE SOX VS. DETROIT

- The White Sox went 10-9 in 2017 for their first season series victory over the Tigers since 2008 ... they won six of the nine games at home, outscoring Detroit by a 48-26 margin.
- The Sox batted .292/.351/.466 with a 5.01 ERA (93 ER/167.0 IP) and outscored the Tigers, 103-98.
- Chicago is 61-88 against Detroit since 2010 (36-38 at home).
- The White Sox trail in the all-time series, 1,049-1,087 ... they are 562-509 in Chicago (125-94 at Guaranteed Rate Field) and 487-578 in Detroit (78-87 at Comerica Park).

#### TIGER TAMERS

- José Abreu is a career .345/.413/.593 (95-275) hitter with 19 doubles, 15 home runs and 47 RBI in 73 career games vs. Detroit, including a .398 (45-113) average with six homers and 19 RBI in his last 30.
- Avisail García has 52 RBI in 68 games against his former team, including a 5-5 effort with seven RBI on 9/14/17 at Comerica Park ... Matt Davidson owns a .365 (19-52) average with five home runs and 13 RBI in 15 career games.
- Omar Narváez is batting .386 (17-44) with a .471 on-base percentage in 15 career games ... Welington Castillo is 9-17 (.529) with one homer and five RBI in four career games ... Yoán Moncada is 7-19 (.368) with two homers, four RBI and seven runs scored in four games.

#### LOOKING FOR CENTRAL COMMAND

- The White Sox are 2-0 against the American League Central in 2018 after going 33-43 (.434) last season.
- The Sox are 293-377 vs. the AL Central since 2009, posting a losing record every season except 2012 (37-35).

#### QUALITY IS JOB ONE

- The White Sox have made a major-league leading 1,317 quality starts since the start of the 2003 season, five more than the Mets and 46 more than Oakland, the next-closest American League team.

#### AT THE HELM

- Rick Renteria is in his second season after being named the 40th manager in White Sox history on 10/3/16.
- Renteria was the only Latino manager in the major leagues in 2017 but has been joined by Boston's Alex Cora and Washington's Dave Martinez in 2018.

#### ROSTER QUICK FACTS

- The Sox 25-man roster includes 13 pitchers (three LHP), two catchers, six infielders and four outfielders ... the average age is 27.7, including 28.8 for pitchers and 26.4 for position players.
- LHP Aaron Bummer, OF Nicky Delmonico, OF Adam Engel, RHP Carson Fulmer, RHP Lucas Giolito, RHP Gregory Infante, RHP Reynaldo López, RHP Juan Minaya and Moncada have made their first career Opening Day roster.

#### ABREU IN ELITE COMPANY

- José Abreu is one of three players in major-league history to begin his career with at least four consecutive seasons of 25-plus homers and 100-plus RBI, joining Hall-of-Famer Joe DiMaggio (1936-41) and Albert Pujols.
- Abreu also has joined Al Simmons (11, 1924-34), Pujols (10, 2001-10), Ted Williams (1939-42, '46-49) and DiMaggio (1936-42) as the only players in history to record 100 or more RBI in each of his first four seasons.

#### CALL TO THE HALL

- Jim Thome, who played for the White Sox from 2006-09 and serves as a special assistant to the general manager, will be inducted into the Baseball Hall of Fame on 7/29/18.
- Thome, who ranks eighth in major-league history with 612 home runs, received 89.8 percent of the votes to become the fifth former Sox player inducted on the first ballot.
- He will join Chipper Jones, Vladimir Guerrero, Trevor Hoffman, Jack Morris and Alan Trammell in the Class of 2018.

#### ON THE FARM

- The White Sox minor-league system is rated by *Baseball America* as the fourth-best in baseball.
- The Sox organization features five of *Baseball America's* Top 100 prospects: OF Eloy Jiménez (No. 4), RHP Michael Kopech (No. 11), RHP Alec Hansen (No. 57), OF Luis Robert (No. 58) and RHP Dane Dunning (No. 82) ... Jiménez (No. 4), Kopech (No. 10), Robert (No. 28), Hansen (No. 54), RHP Dylan Cease (No. 71), Dunning (No. 92) and OF Blake Rutherford (No. 99) are ranked in MLB.com's Top 100.
