16 INNINGS...5 HOURS, 31 MINUTES: Yesterday in downtown Phoenix, the Padres emerged victorious over Arizona with a 16th-inning home run off the bat of **Wil Myers**...the 5 hour and 31 minute contest tied for the third-longest game (by time) this season (longest is the 5 hour and 48 minute bout between CWS @ OAK on April 18), and the 16.0 innings tied for the second-longest game this season by innings (longest: 17.0 inning marathon on March 30, CHC @ MIA)... yesterday was the eighth-longest game in SD franchise history (in time) and their longest since May 22, 2016 vs. LAD (5 hours and 47 minutes).

ROSTER MOVES: The Padres have optioned RHP **Miguel Diaz** to San Antonio (AA) and INF **Cory Spangenberg** to El Paso (AAA) and recalled RHPs **Phil Maton** and **Walker Lockett** from El Paso.

QUITE THE ODYSSEY: Since June 8, the Padres have played 23 of their last 28 games on the road...that's five home games.

THE KERSHAWSHANK REDEMPTION: LAD has won each of **Clayton Kershaw's** last 12 starts vs. SD...the Padres look to turn the tables against the southpaw, as he has a 9-0 record vs. SD with a 0.96 ERA in those 12 starts.

ROOKIE ROUNDUP: For the third time in the past three seasons, rookies are accounting for a higher percentage of the Padres' runs scored than those on any other team...in 2016, accounted for 24.9 percent (first in the majors), in 2017, 30.5 percent (first in the majors) and in 2018, 22.0 percent (first in the majors).

WIL YOU LOOK AT THAT: **Wil Myers** has combined for four homers on Saturday (three) and Sunday (one)...**Nate Colbert** in 1972 is the only Padre to hit more homers in a two-game span (had five in a double-header on Aug. 1 @ ATL)... Colbert (in 1972) and **Brian Giles** (in 2007) both hit five homers over three games, but no Padre has ever hit more than five homers over three-games.

CATCH YOU ON THE FLIPPITY: Last season, Petco Park saw the fewest runs per game of any stadium (7.94), but this season, it has yielded the eighth-most (9.34)...the +1.40 run increase from last season is the second-highest of any park (highest: Progressive Field's +2.03 increase).

REMEMBER ME?: **C A.J. Ellis** has reached base safely via hit or walk in 28 of his last 30 games since April 23 with a .431 OBP...in that time, his OBP is the third-best in baseball (among those with at least 100 PA), behind just Mike Trout (.472 OBP) and Joey Votto (.450 OBP).

GIVE HIM A HAND: Yesterday, **Brad Hand** earned his second-consecutive All-Star bid...the southpaw owns a 2.91 ERA and 64 strikeouts over 43.1 innings, and his 24 saves tie for second-most in the NL, though the Padres' 34 save opportunities this season are tied for fourth-fewest in the NL...said Hand, in A.J. Cassavell's story on MLB.com, *"Two years ago, I didn't know if I was even going to get a big league job once I got designated. I had no clue if any team was going to pick me up. You've just got to work hard, put your head down, keep moving forward...I was lucky to find a home here in San Diego."*

HAPPY BIRTHDAY FROM "HIS PADRES": Join the Padres in wishing the voice of San Diego sports, **Ted Leitner**, a wonderful birthday!

PADRES ON DECK: Last night for San Antonio (AA), RHP **Cal Quantrill** allowed one run on four hits and four walks with three strikeouts over 6.1 innings...for El Paso (AAA), **C Raffy Lopez** hit a grand slam to compete a five-game sweep at Salt Lake...El Paso leads their PCL division by five games at their All-Star break.

THIS DATE IN PADRES HISTORY: On July 9, 1996, **Ken Caminiti** became the first Padre to homer in an All-Star Game in the NL's 6-0 win in the 67th game in PHI.

STARTING PITCHER NOTES

#61 RHP LUIS PERDOMO (1-2, 6.86) [luisperdomo0061](#) 

SOCK'S UP!: 25-year-old **Luis Perdomo** takes the mound tonight to kick off this four-game series against the Dodgers...it will be his second start since being recalled from El Paso (AAA) on 7/4.

LAST TIME OUT: Worked a season-high 5.2 IP on 7/4 at OAK, allowing two runs on four hits and four walks but did not factor into SD's 4-2 defeat.

- Since the beginning of 2017, Perdomo has made 34 starts, with six of those coming against AL foes...he is 3-1 with a 3.21 ERA and 0.27 HR allowed per 9 IP against AL opponents...he is 6-12 with a 5.29 ERA and 1.02 HR/9 IP against NL foes.

ABOUT THAT VELO: In his last start on Independence Day, his pitches averaged at 91 mph and he topped at 95.8...the exit velocity off his pitches averaged to 81.5 mph, while his average opponent exit velocity on the season is 91.2 mph.

STATCASTED: Perdomo relies on primarily four pitches: sinker (48.1%), slider (30.3%), four-seamer (14%) and split finger (7.5%)...opposing batters are hitting just .125 against his split-finger this season, but they are hitting .538 vs. his fastball.

TIME TO TURN THE TABLES: Perdomo has a 9.55 career ERA vs. LAD (35 er, 33.0 ip), the second-highest ERA of any pitcher vs. the Dodgers (min. five starts) since 1958 (behind Glendon Rusch's 10.95 ERA).

WHILE YOU WERE AWAY: Perdomo made 11 starts with El Paso (AAA) from 4/23-6/27, going 6-2 with a 3.10 ERA (24 ER, 69.2 IP)...he allowed two runs or less in seven of his 11 outings and tossed a complete game on three hits and one run on 5/4 at Albuquerque.

VERSUS THE CHAMPS: Earned the win in his first career start against the Astros on 4/6, holding the defending World Series champs to one run in his 5.0 innings of work in SD's 4-1 victory.

- Perdomo and the rest of the Padres pitching staff didn't surrender an extra-base hit to the Astros in the first two games of their series...it was the first time HOU was held without an extra-base hit in back-to-back contests since September 17-18, 2014 vs. CLE.

PITCHERS WHO RAKE: Last season, Luis became the first pitcher to hit four triples in a season since PHI's Robin Roberts in 1955...only three pitchers had one triple in 2017, resulting in Perdomo having more triples in his 46 at-bats than all other MLB pitchers in their 4,534 at-bats.

THE GROUNDER GAMES: Last season, he led all NL pitchers with a 62.0 ground ball percentage, behind only TOR **Marcus Stroman's** 62.9 mark for the Major League lead...teammate **Clayton Richard** (60.0) and former teammate **Jhoulys Chacin** (49.2) ranked third and 14th, respectively.

LET'S TURN TWO: Forced opponents to ground into 32 double plays last season, which ranked tied for first in the National League and tied for second in MLB with teammate Clayton Richard.

QUOTABLE: Manager Andy Green on Luis Perdomo returning to the big league club on 7/3.

- "He could very well be here for the rest of the baseball season. If he is, we'll all love that."

TOMORROW'S STARTER

LAUER HOUR: LHP **Eric Lauer** is set to make his 15th career start and second against the Dodgers tomorrow night.

- After posting a 7.67 ERA from April-May (his first seven starts), he tallied a 2.76 mark in June (six outings) for a -4.91 ERA differential, the highest improvement among all ML pitchers (min. 25 IP in each split).

- Yesterday, Hand earned his second-consecutive All-Star bid.
- His 24 saves tie for fourth in the majors and tie for second in the NL with LAD's Kenley Jansen (though the Padres' 34 save opportunities this season are tied for fourth-fewest in the NL).
- Since joining the Padres in 2016, he has allowed just one earned run in nine games and 11.0 IP vs. LAD (0.82 ERA).
- Since trading closer Brandon Maurer on July 24, 2017, his 42 saves in that time rank second in MLB, behind only SEA Edwin Diaz (51).
- 52.4 percent of his pitches this season have been sliders...253 of his sliders have been thrown for strikes, the highest total among major league relievers this season.

- Recalled today from El Paso (AAA)...has pitched to a 5.20 ERA (53 er, 91.2 ip) this season for the Chihuahuas.
- Made his Major League debut earlier this season in a spot start on June 1 vs. CIN...worked 3.2 innings and was saddled with the loss, allowing four hits on four runs (earned) and five walks...he allowed just one hit and one run in his first three innings he tossed.
- In his lone start, he averaged 91.0 mph on his fastball and relied on four pitches: four-seamer (50.6%), changeup (25.9%), curve (19.8%) and cutter (3.7%).
- Back on June 1 vs. CIN, he became the fifth pitcher to debut with the Padres as a starter since the 2017 season...coincidentally, all five have a last name starting with 'L' (joined Dinelson Lamet, Kyle Lloyd, Joey Lucchesi and Eric Lauer).
- Since being optioned back to El Paso on June 2, he's owned a 5.01 ERA (18 er, 32.1 ip) in six appearances (all starts).

- Returned Friday from the paternity leave list...Yates and his wife, **Ashlee**, welcomed their baby boy, **Kove Kali**, into the world on July 3.
