MARINERS NOTES:

- The Mariners fall to 9-2 over their last 11 games.
- Denard Span** (3x4, R, HR, RBI) extended his hitting streak to 5 games, batting .444 (8x18) with 2 runs, 2 doubles, 1 home run, and 2 RBI during that span.
 - Is batting .311 (32x103) with 14 runs, 6 doubles, 4 home runs, 12 RBI, and 6 walks since joining the Mariners on May 28.
 - Recorded his 1st 3-hit game of the season...marks his 9th multi-hit game with the Mariners.
- Félix Hernández** has pitched 5+ innings and allowed 3 runs or fewer in 5 consecutive starts... holds a 3.41 ERA (11 ER, 29.0 IP) with 23 strikeouts during that span.
 - Has allowed 31 of his 60 earned runs this season in the 1st and 2nd innings.
- Dee Gordon** (1x3) has hit safely in 5 consecutive games and 20 of his last 23 games, batting .300 (30x100) with 12 runs, 2 doubles, 1 triple, 6 RBI, and 2 walks during that span.
- Roenis Elías** made his 2nd relief appearance of 3+ innings this season.
 - In 7 appearances this year, he holds a 2.35 ERA (4 ER, 15.1 IP) with 9 strikeouts.
- Jean Segura** (1x4) ranks second in the AL with 113 hits this season, trailing only Jose Altuve (119).
- Andrew Romine** (1x1) extended his hitting streak to 6 games, batting .444 (8x18) with 3 runs during that span.
- Chris Herrmann** (1x3) has reached base safely via hit or walk in 5 of his 7 starts this season.
- Guillermo Heredia** (1x3) has hit safely in 7 of his last 13 games (6/23-c), batting .256 (10x39) with 5 runs, 2 doubles, 1 RBI and 4 walks over that stretch.

ROCKIES NOTES:

- The Rockies are 7-1 over their last 8 games.
- The Rockies lead the Majors with 73 runs scored in the 1st inning this season.
- The Rockies recorded 10+ hits for the 32nd time this season, ranks 5th in the National League (best: Cincinnati and Chicago-NL, 37).
- German Márquez** is 5-3 with a 2.61 ERA (16 ER, 55.0 IP) on the road this season.
 - Has tossed 6+ innings and allowed 1 run in each of his last 2 road starts... is 2-0 with a 1.28 ERA (2 ER, 14 IP) with 14 strikeouts during that span.
- Tony Wolters** (2x4, 2 R, 2 3B, 3 RBI) is the first Rockies player with 2 triples in a game since Trevor Story (4/23/16 vs. SF)...is the first Rockies player to record 2 triples on the road since Cory Sullivan (4/9/06 at SD)...is the first Rockies catcher in club history with 2 triples in one game.
 - Becomes the 4th player in Safeco Field history to record 2 triples in a game and the first visiting player to do so...he joins Mark McLemore (10/5/01 vs. TEX), Ichiro Suzuki (4/21/02 vs. TEX) and Carlos Guillen (5/9/03 vs. CWS).
 - Is the 5th player in the Majors this season to hit 2 triples in a game.
 - Tonight marks the 5th time in his career he has recorded multiple extra-base hits in a game (last: 8/21/16 vs CHC – 2 2B).
 - Tallied 3 RBI for the 1st time this season.
- Charlie Blackmon** (3x5, 2 R, HR, RBI) ranks 6th in the Majors with 12 home runs on the road this season.
 - Recorded his 26th multi-hit game of the year and his 6th 3-hit game.
- Carlos Gonzales** (2x5, 2B, RBI) is batting .322 (38x118) in his last 32 games (May 27 – c).
 - Recorded his first multi-hit game since June 22 vs. MIA.
- Raimel Tapia** (1x3, 2 R, 2B BB) picked up his 1st hit of season with a double in the 2nd inning.

ROCKIES MANAGER BUD BLACK:

On throwing out Dee Gordon in the 1st inning:

“Well, that was big for sure. I think that anytime a leadoff guy gets on, especially a guy like Gordon that can impact the game with his legs. Tony made a great throw, quick release on the money and Trevor put the tag on, so that was big.”

On Tony Wolters tonight:

“Tony had really good game. Two triples, was part of the offense, contributed there, caught German very well, stuck some pitches that I think were probably borderline that we got some calls on, which was great, which Tony does so well. How about the play that we got Gordon at the plate? That was a great play there too. Good all-around game for Tony. Tony is hanging in there with three catchers, and Chris is playing well. Murph has got some base hits and we want to see what Murph can do. Murph is contributing, so I think it's great that all three catchers in their own way are contributing, so it's good stuff.”
