### TRIBE TOP THREE

» The Indians have scored at least six runs in each of their last six games, which is tied for the club's 2nd-longest such streak since the start of 2013.

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** went 2-for-5 last night and recorded his sixth consecutive multi-hit game, a new career-long streak and the longest such streak in MLB this season.

» **TREVOR BAUER** starts today for Cleveland...went 2-0 with a 1.38 ERA vs. New York-AL last season.

### YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians tied the game with five runs in the top of the 8th inning after trailing early, but ultimately fell 7-6 as the Yankees walked off in the bottom of the 9th...marked the Tribe's 3rd walk-off loss of the year and first since April 18 at Minnesota in Puerto Rico.

» **BRADLEY ZIMMER** got the Tribe on the board with a three-run homer in the 8th, his second of the season as well as his second off of left-handed pitching this season...the left-handed batter has recorded seven of his nine RBI on the year against southpaws.

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** then tied the score with a two-run homer, his third career game-tying or go-ahead homer in the 8th inning or later...homered in consecutive games for the 8th time in his career and second this season, after doing so April 21-22...finished the game 3-for-5, recording his team-leading 6th three-hit game.

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** went 2-for-5, recording his sixth consecutive multi-hit game, a new career-long streak and the longest by an Indians batter since **Ramírez** had a nine-game streak from June 14-21, 2017...streak is also the longest such streak in MLB in 2018.

» **JOSH TOMLIN** tossed a season-high 7.0 innings and did not factor into the decision (8H, 5R, 4ER, 3HR, 2BB, 4K)...extended his streak of consecutive starts allowing three-or-fewer walks to 134 starts, which is the longest such streak in franchise history, as well as the 4th-longest in MLB in the *Baseball Reference Play Index* era (1908-).

» **ALEXI OGANDO** was saddled with the loss in his Indians debut, tossing 1.0 inning (2H, 2R/ER, 3BB, 1K).

### START SPREADIN' THE NEWS

» The Indians travel to Yankee Stadium this weekend for a three-game set at New York-AL in the first matchups between the clubs this season...the Yankees will head to Progressive Field for a four-game set from July 12-15.

» Cleveland posted a record of 5-2 against New York-AL in 2017, winning all three games at Yankee Stadium including a double-header sweep on August 30...in a rivalry dating back to 1903, the Indians have gone 867-1099-12 (.441) in 1,978 regular-season contests against the Yankees...Tribe is also 9-4 in their last 13 games at Yankee Stadium.

» The two teams both qualified for the 2017 Postseason and faced off in the ALDS...after Cleveland won both of the first two games at Progressive Field, including a dramatic 9-8 Game 2 win in 13 innings, the Yankees won the final three contests to take the series, three games to two.

### HEADING EAST

» The Indians have played eight games of their 33-game slate against the American League East division so far this season, posting a 4-4 record...this includes a loss to Toronto on April 13, a 3-1 series win in Baltimore April 20-23, Thursday's doubleheader split vs. Toronto and last night's loss here in The Bronx.

» Cleveland posted a record of 22-12 (.647) against the A.L. East in 2017, going 11-6 at Progressive Field and 11-6 on the road...since Tampa Bay joined the A.L. East in 1998, the Indians have gone 390-373 (.511) against the division.

### INNING BY INNING

» Cleveland scored five runs in the top of the 8th inning last night, marking the club's 4th consecutive game featuring an inning of five-or-more runs...is the Indians longest such streak since also doing so from April 13-17, 2012.

» The Indians have four innings with five-or-more runs scored, which currently ranks T5th in the American League and T7th in MLB...Colorado leads with six such innings, followed by five from Boston, Houston, New York-AL, Philadelphia and Seattle.

### AN OFFENSIVE OUTBURST

» The Indians have scored at least six runs in each of their last six games, which is tied for the club's 2nd-longest such run since the start of the 2013 season, after doing so in seven straight games from June 20-27, 2016...the other six-game run was from April 28-May 4, 2013...Tribe has also scored 42 runs on 56 hits over their last four games.

» After being held under 10 hits for each of the first 11 games of the season, the Tribe has recorded 10-or-more hits in 15 of their last 21 contests...the club has also posted a team batting average of .290 since April 21, which is 2nd in MLB in that span (Tampa Bay -.306).

» Cleveland enters play this afternoon ranking 12th in MLB in batting average (.247), T2nd in home runs (47), 10th in runs (150) and 8th in slugging percentage (.426).

### FRANKIE'S ON FIRE

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** enters this weekend on a sustained offensive run...went 2-for-5 last night and extended his streak of consecutive multi-hit games to six, a new career-long run and the longest such streak in MLB this season.

» Lindor's streak marks the longest by an Indians batter since José Ramírez recorded a nine-game multi-hit game streak from June 14-21, 2017...is batting .455 (15-33) with three doubles and three home runs during his streak, which dates back to April 30.

» He also carries an active seven-game overall hit streak into today's contest, batting .444 (16-36) in that span with three homers, three doubles, eight RBI and nine runs scored in that span.

» After hitting .159 through April 10 with no homers and no RBI, Lindor has raised his average to .278, hitting .340 (32-94) since with seven homers (T1st on team in span), 18 RBI (also 1st) and eight doubles (T1st).

» Lindor currently leads the team in a number of categories, including at-bats (138, T1st in A.L.), hits (39, T6th), and runs scored (24, T7th)...his five steals (T6th in A.L.) are second on the team behind **Rajai Davis's** six (T3rd).

### TREVOR TAKES THE BRONX

» **TREVOR BAUER** is due to make his seventh start of the season this afternoon vs. New York-AL.

» Bauer is 2-2 with a 2.45 ERA through his first six starts of the season...did not factor into the decision in his last outing on April 30 vs. Texas, striking out a season-high 11 batters and allowing two runs on four hits and three walks in 6.2 innings...marked his 10th career game with 10-plus strikeouts.

» Went 2-0 with a 1.38 ERA (2ER/13.0IP) in two starts vs. the Yankees last season...one of those wins came in the first game of a doubleheader on August 30 at Yankee Stadium (6.0IP, 4H, 1R/ER, 4BB, 4K)...also faced the Yankees in Game 2 & Game 4 of the 2017 ALDS, earning the win in Game 2 at Progressive Field, tossing 6.2 shutout innings (2H, 1BB, 8K) and taking the loss in Game 4 at Yankee Stadium (1.2IP, 4H, 4R/ER, 2BB, 3K

» Owns a career 3-4 record and 4.20 ERA (21ER/45.0IP) in eight starts vs. New York-AL...this includes a 1-1 record and 2.87 ERA (5ER/15.2IP) at Yankee Stadium.

### JRAM OFF AND RUNNING

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** tied the game with a two-run homer in the 8th inning last night and homered in consecutive games for the 8th time in his career (last, April 21-22, 2018)...his last two games have been momentous & are part of an impressive offensive month.

» Finished last night 3-for-5, recording his MLB-leading sixth three-hit game of the season...has recorded consecutive three-hit games for the 4th time in his career and first since June 18-19, 2017.

» Additionally, eight of his last 13 hits have been extra-base hits (6 doubles, 2 homers)...tied his career-long streak with two extra-base hits in each of his last two games (4x, last Aug. 28-30, 2017).

» Since April 9 (22 games), Ramírez is batting .378 (34-90) with eight homers, eight doubles, 18 runs scored and 18 RBI.

» His 34 hits in that span are T1st in MLB, while his eight homers are T3rd and his .451 on-base percentage is 6th.

» Ramírez has also struck out just 12 times in 141 plate appearances, ranking as the 2nd-toughest hitter to strike out in the American League (11.8 PA/K).
