TRIBE TOP THREE

» The Indians have scored at least six runs in each of their last six games, which is tied for the club's 2nd-longest such streak since the start of 2013.
» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** went 2-for-5 last night and recorded his sixth consecutive multi-hit game, a new career-long streak and the longest such streak in MLB this season.
» **TREVOR BAUER** starts today for Cleveland...went 2-0 with a 1.38 ERA vs. New York-AL last season.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians tied the game with five runs in the top of the 8th inning after trailing early, but ultimately fell 7-6 as the Yankees walked off in the bottom of the 9th...marked the Tribe's 3rd walk-off loss of the year and first since April 18 at Minnesota in Puerto Rico.
» **BRADLEY ZIMMER** got the Tribe on the board with a three-run homer in the 8th, his second of the season as well as his second off of left-handed pitching this season...the left-handed batter has recorded seven of his nine RBI on the year against southpaws.
» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** then tied the score with a two-run homer, his third career game-tying or go-ahead homer in the 8th inning or later...homered in consecutive games for the 8th time in his career and second this season, after doing so April 21-22...finished the game 3-for-5, recording his team-leading 6th three-hit game.
» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** went 2-for-5, recording his sixth consecutive multi-hit game, a new career-long streak and the longest by an Indians batter since **Ramírez** had a nine-game streak from June 14-21, 2017...streak is also the longest such streak in MLB in 2018.
» **JOSH TOMLIN** tossed a season-high 7.0 innings and did not factor into the decision (8H, 5R, 4ER, 3HR, 2BB, 4K)...extended his streak of consecutive starts allowing three-or-fewer walks to 134 starts, which is the longest such streak in franchise history, as well as the 4th-longest in MLB in the *Baseball Reference Play Index* era (1908-).
» **ALEXI OGANDO** was saddled with the loss in his Indians debut, tossing 1.0 inning (2H, 2R/ER, 3BB, 1K).

START SPREADIN' THE NEWS

» The Indians travel to Yankee Stadium this weekend for a three-game set at New York-AL in the first matchups between the clubs this season...the Yankees will head to Progressive Field for a four-game set from July 12-15.
» Cleveland posted a record of 5-2 against New York-AL in 2017, winning all three games at Yankee Stadium including a double-header sweep on August 30...in a rivalry dating back to 1903, the Indians have gone 867-1099-12 (.441) in 1,978 regular-season contests against the Yankees...Tribe is also 9-4 in their last 13 games at Yankee Stadium.
» The two teams both qualified for the 2017 Postseason and faced off in the ALDS...after Cleveland won both of the first two games at Progressive Field, including a dramatic 9-8 Game 2 win in 13 innings, the Yankees won the final three contests to take the series, three games to two.

HEADING EAST

» The Indians have played eight games of their 33-game slate against the American League East division so far this season, posting a 4-4 record...this includes a loss to Toronto on April 13, a 3-1 series win in Baltimore April 20-23, Thursday's doubleheader split vs. Toronto and last night's loss here in The Bronx.
» Cleveland posted a record of 22-12 (.647) against the A.L. East in 2017, going 11-6 at Progressive Field and 11-6 on the road...since Tampa Bay joined the A.L. East in 1998, the Indians have gone 390-373 (.511) against the division.

INNING BY INNING

» Cleveland scored five runs in the top of the 8th inning last night, marking the club's 4th consecutive game featuring an inning of five-or-more runs...is the Indians longest such streak since also doing so from April 13-17, 2012.
» The Indians have four innings with five-or-more runs scored, which currently ranks T5th in the American League and T7th in MLB...Colorado leads with six such innings, followed by five from Boston, Houston, New York-AL, Philadelphia and Seattle.

2011: Cleveland scores two runs in the top of the 12th inning en route to a 4-3 win over the A's in Oakland...**Jack Hannahan** (1-for-5) and **Lou Marson** (3-for-5, 3B) each delivered an RBI single in the aforementioned inning to put the Tribe ahead...the victory improved the Indians to 21-9 on the season through the first 30 games, marking the best 30-game start in franchise history.

TODAY'S START

» The 27-year-old right-hander is due to make his seventh start of the season this afternoon in the middle game of this three-game series at New York-AL...will mark his 139th career appearance and 130th career start.
 » Will pitch on regular four days' rest after his most recent start on April 30 vs. the Texas Rangers during the Indians last homestand...pitched into the seventh inning, allowing two runs on four hits in 6.2 innings, with a season-high 11 strikeouts.
 » **Holding opponents to a .189 batting average, which currently ranks 7th in the American League...also ranks 10th in the A.L. with a 2.45 ERA.**
 » Last faced the Yankees in the regular season on August 30 at Yankee Stadium, in Game 1 of a doubleheader...earned the win, tossing 6.0 innings and allowing one run on four hits, with four walks and four strikeouts.
 » Also made two starts against New York-AL in the 2017 ALDS, in Game 1 and Game 4...went 1-1 across the two starts and did not allow an earned run (4 unearned runs) in 8.1 innings.
 » Owns a career 3-4 record and 4.20 ERA (21ER/45.0IP) in eight career starts against New York-AL.

LAST TIME OUT

» Bauer did not factor into the decision in his last start vs. the Texas Rangers on April 30...held the Rangers to two runs on four hits in 6.2 innings as the Tribe won 7-5.
 » **Struck out a season-high 11 batters, marking his 10th career double-digit strikeout game and first since August 14, 2017 at Boston.**
 » Finished April with a 2.45 ERA, his third-lowest career ERA in a month with at least five starts, trailing June 2016 (2.01 ERA) and August 2017 (2.31 ERA).
 » Has also allowed three-or-fewer runs and struck out at least six batters in each of his six starts so far this season.

VS. NEW YORK-AL | A.L. EAST

» Makes his ninth career start vs. New York-AL this afternoon...owns a career record of 3-4 and a 4.20 ERA (21ER/45.0IP) across his previous eight starts.
 » Went 2-0 with a 1.38 ERA (2ER/13.0IP) in two regular season starts last year against the Yankees...earned the win on August 4 at Progressive Field, holding the Yankees to one run on seven hits in 7.0 innings (1HR, 2BB, 7K)...later won again in the first game of a doubleheader on August 30, allowing one run on four hits in 6.0 innings (4BB, 4K).
 » Also started twice vs. New York-AL in the 2017 ALDS...earned the win in Game 1 at Progressive Field (6.2IP, 2H, 1BB, 8K)...took the loss in Game 4, lasting just 1.2 innings (4H, 4R, 0ER, 2BB, 3K).
 » Tonight marks his second start of the season against an American League East division team...took the loss on April 20 at Baltimore, allowing three runs on five hits in 7.0 innings, with three walks and six strikeouts.
 » Owns a career 9-13 record and 8.18 (100ER/110.0IP) ERA in 28 games and 25 starts against the A.L. East...this includes a 6-1 record and 3.83 ERA (18ER/42.1IP) in seven starts vs. the division in 2017.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN

» Tonight marks Bauer's third road start of the season...is 0-1 with a 3.75 ERA (5ER/12.0IP) in his two previous starts.
 » Made his first start of the year in Seattle on April 1, not factoring into the decision after tossing 5.0 innings (5H, 2R/ER, 3BB, 7K, 1HBP)...then took the loss on April 20 at Baltimore (7.0IP, 5H, 3R/ER, 1HR, 3BB, 6K).
 » Went 7-5 with a 4.54 ERA (37ER/73.1IP) in 15 games (14 starts) away from Progressive Field last season...owns a career road record of 20-22 with a 4.23 ERA (154ER/327.1IP) in 63 games (58 starts).

NIGHTTIME, DAYTIME

» Today will mark Bauer's third start of the season during the day...is 0-1 with a 2.08 ERA (3ER/13.0IP) in those starts.
 » In his career, has gone 16-14 with a 3.67 ERA in 47 games (41 starts) during the day and 33-29 with a 4.55 ERA in 91 games (88 starts) at night.

2017 REGULAR SEASON HIGHLIGHTS

» Had a career year in the Indians rotation last year, posting his lowest full-season ERA (4.19) while also recording career highs in wins (17), strikeouts (196), innings pitched (176.1) and strikeouts-per-9.0 innings (10.0)...also struck out six-or-more batters in 22 of his 31 starts, good for 6th in the American League...made one relief appearance, in the 8th inning of the second game of a DH on August 17 at Minnesota (0.2IP, 1H, 1K).
 » **Struck out a career-high 14 batters in 7.0 innings on May 30 vs. Oakland, equaling the highest single-game strikeout total by a Tribe starter last season.**
 » Dominated after the All-Star Break, going 10-2 with a 3.01 ERA (28ER/83.2IP) in his final 15 appearances (14 starts) of the season...his 10 second-half wins ranked T2nd in the A.L. and his 3.01 ERA ranked T5th among A.L. starters (min. 80.0IP).
 » **Won a career-best nine consecutive decisions from July 21 to September 10, spanning 11 starts**...posted a 2.51 ERA (18ER/64.2IP) in that span...streak marked the longest by an Indians pitcher last season.

2017 POSTSEASON RECAP

» Started Games 1 & 4 for Cleveland of the 2017 ALDS against New York-AL...won the first game at home with 6.2 shutout innings (2H, 1BB, 8K)...eight strikeouts in Game 2 marked his most in a postseason start...took the loss in Game 4 in NYC after allowing four runs (all unearned) over 1.2 innings (4H, 2BB/1IBB, 3K).

CAREER SNAPSHOT

» Right-hander is in his sixth season with the Indians organization after being acquired from the Arizona Diamondbacks on December 11, 2012, along with RHP Matt Albers, RHP Bryan Shaw (from Arizona) & Drew Stubbs (from Cincinnati), in a 3-team trade...at time of trade, was ranked as Arizona's No. 1 prospect by *Baseball America* and had just earned Dbacks Minor League Pitcher of the Year honors.
 » Made his Major League debut with Arizona on June 28, 2012, becoming the first player from the 2011 Draft Class to reach the Majors...did not factor into the decision after allowing two runs on five hits in 4.0 innings of work.
 » **In 2017, recorded his best Major League season to date in the Tribe rotation, posting career-highs in wins (17), strikeouts (196) and innings pitched (176.1), while recording his lowest full-season ERA (4.19).**
 » The 2018 season marks his eighth overall in professional baseball after being selected by Arizona in the first round of the 2011 draft out of UCLA, where he went 38-4 with a 2.36 ERA across three seasons for the Bruins...finished his college career holding a number of school records, including a Pac-10 record with 203 strikeouts in 2011.
 » The Southern California native graduated from Hart High School in Santa Clarita, the same HS that produced Kevin Millar, James Shields, Bob Walk and Todd Zeile.

TOMORROW'S PROBABLE STARTER

RHP MIKE CLEVINGER (2-0, 2.82)
 » The 27-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his seventh start of the season tomorrow afternoon in the finale of this series at the New York Yankees...will mark his 51st career appearance and 38th career start.
 » **Has not allowed an earned run in two road starts this season & is T1st in the American League with a 0.00 road ERA...also ranks 2nd in the A.L. with a 0.55 day ERA.**
 » Did not factor into the decision in his last start on May 1 vs. Texas...recorded his third Quality Start of the season, tossing 6.2 innings and allowing three runs on seven hits (one home run), with one walk and a season-high seven strikeouts.
 » **Tossed his first career complete-game shutout on at Baltimore on April 21**...held the Orioles to two hits and struck out three batters while walking two...marked the fewest hits allowed in a complete-game shutout by an Indians starting pitcher since **Carlos Carrasco** allowed one hit in a CGSO at Kansas City on September 25, 2015 (9.0IP, 2BB, 15K).
 » Tomorrow will mark his first career regular season start and second appearance against New York-AL...appeared in relief on August 6 at Progressive Field, allowing three runs on two hits, with one walk and one strikeout.
 » Also made two Postseason relief appearances vs. New York-AL in the 2017 ALDS...allowed three runs (two earned) in 1.1 innings combined between Games 2 and 5.
 » **In 2017 set career bests in wins (12), strikeouts (137), ERA (3.11), innings pitched (121.2), games (27) and games started (21) in three stints with the Indians.**
