### BLUE JAYS NOTES:

- Lost a game while recording 18+ hits for the first time since 9/22/07 at NYY (18H, 10 innings)...Dropped to 2-4 on the homestand and are back below .500 here this season...Fall to 19-13 in one-run games...Hit back-to-back home runs for the 6<sup>th</sup> time...Walked 5 batters in the 5<sup>th</sup> inning, their most in a frame since walking 8 on 4/17/14 at MIN...Issued 9 walks today, their 2<sup>nd</sup> most in a game this season (10-BB on 7/7 vs. NYY).
- SEAN REID-FOLEY** made his 1<sup>st</sup> career start at Rogers Centre...Allowed 6 runs on 5 hits over 4.2 innings...Walked 5 batters for the first time since 5/13 (while with Double-A New Hampshire) while recording 3 strikeouts.
- RANDAL GRICHUK** reached the 20-HR mark for the 3<sup>rd</sup> consecutive season as he hit a solo HR to right field in the 3<sup>rd</sup> inning...Added another homer in the 5<sup>th</sup> for his 21<sup>st</sup> of the year...Came into today with 23 extra-base hits since the All-Star break, tied for 4<sup>th</sup> most in the AL...Added a single for his 8<sup>th</sup> 3+ hit game this season, 2<sup>nd</sup> most on the team (Smook-10)...Over his last 17 games, has gone 23-for-62 (.371) with 7-2B, 5-HR and 8-RBI (1.138 OPS).
- ROWDY TELLEZ** recorded his 1<sup>st</sup> MLB home run as he followed up Grichuk's 5<sup>th</sup>-inning blast with one of his own (both off Plutko)...Formed Toronto's 6<sup>th</sup> set of back-to-back HRs this season (last: Smook/Morales on 8/21 vs. BAL)...**Became the 1<sup>st</sup> MLB player (since 1913) to record 7 extra-base hits in his first 4 career games...Became the 4<sup>th</sup> player in the live ball era to have each of his first 7 hits go for extras (courtesy STATS)...Joined Jesse Barfield (1981) as the only Blue Jays to start their MLB career with a 4-game RBI streak...Added a single in the 8<sup>th</sup> and has now gone 8-for-14 (.571) with 6-2B, 1-HR and 4-RBI to start his career...His 8 hits are the most ever by a Blue Jays batter through their first 4 career games (7H: Snider, Hill, Moseby, Ainge).**
- RICHARD URENA** opened the scoring with an RBI double in the 2<sup>nd</sup> inning...Now has 14 hits to match his rookie-season total from last year while his 5 RBI have bested his 2017 output (4).
- BILLY MCKINNEY** led off with a single and added another in the 6<sup>th</sup>...Has reached base in each of his 18 MLB games with a PA...Is now batting .354 (23-for-65) as a Major-Leaguer and has gone 22-for-61 (.361) with 5-2B, 4-HR and 11-RBI as a Blue Jay...Now has a 17G on-base streak since joining Toronto, the 3<sup>rd</sup> longest all-time to start a Blue Jays career (Dave Martinez-24G in 2000; Roy Howell-18G in 1977)...Now has an 8G hitting streak (11-for-31, .355 AVG), tied for 7<sup>th</sup> longest by a Toronto batter this season.
- ALEDMYS DIAZ** singled, doubled three times and drove in a pair of runs in a 4-for-5 afternoon...The 4-hit effort matched his season best (7/20 vs. BAL)...Became the 4<sup>th</sup> Blue Jay with a 3-2B game this season, tying his career high (3-2B on 6/26/16 at SEA)...Has gone 9-for-21 (.421) with 4-2B, 1-HR and 6-RBI so far this homestand.
- LOURDES GURRIEL Jr.** bunted for a base hit in his 1<sup>st</sup> at-bat...Doubled and scored in the 6<sup>th</sup>...Has reached base safely in 28 of his last 30 starts...Now has 57 hits, 3<sup>rd</sup> most all-time by a Blue Jay through their first 51 MLB games (Hill - 63, Felix - 63).
- KEVIN PILLAR** doubled to lead off the 2<sup>nd</sup> inning and added another in the 5<sup>th</sup>...Now has 37 doubles this season, tying his career high from last season.

### INDIANS NOTES:

- Are 2-1 to start their road trip and are now 37-33 in road games this year...Plated 7 runs in the 5<sup>th</sup> inning and have now scored 7+ runs in a frame 6 times this season, 3 of which have come vs. the Blue Jays...Drew 9 walks today, their 2<sup>nd</sup> most in a game this season (10BB on 5/22 at CHI)...Won a game while allowing 18+ hits for the first time since 8/23/06 (19H, 10 innings)...Are now 18-48 in games when out-hit.
- ADAM PLUTKO** gave up 5 runs on a career-high 9 hits over 4.2 innings...Did not walk a batter while recording 4 strikeouts...Has consecutive walk-free starts for the 1<sup>st</sup> time in his career...Surrendered 3 HR in a start for the 3<sup>rd</sup> time.
- ROBERTO PEREZ** hit his 2<sup>nd</sup> home run of the season (also 4/10 vs. DET), a solo homer to lead off the 5<sup>th</sup> inning...Had gone 50 games without a home run, the longest homerless stretch of his career...Added 3 more RBI that inning with a bases-clearing double...Set a new career high with his 4-RBI day.
