2016 SUMMARY

- For the second year in a row, he split season between Triple-A Salt Lake and Double-A Arkansas in the Angel's system.
- Opened campaign with the Bees, pitching out of their bullpen.
- Went 2-1 with a 5.02 ERA (28.2 ip/16 er) in 20 appearances out of the 'pen, and 0-0, 0.00 (6.0/0) in two spot starts.
- Picked up a win in two of his final four relief appearances for Bees, but was assigned to Arkansas on June 30.
- After allowing nine runs over first four appearances (12.15 ERA) with Travelers, allowed just 10 over his last 11 outings (1.66 ERA).
- Made first start at Double-A on July 20 and proceeded to go 6-0 with a 1.66 ERA (48.2/9) in eight starts down the stretch.
- Also had one win in relief on July 30, giving him career-best in-season winning streak of seven games at the end of the campaign.
- Logged longest career outing on August 11 at San Antonio, shutting out the Missions over 7.2 innings, allowing six hits and one walk, with five strikeouts.

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Opened 2015 at Double-A Arkansas. Spent most of campaign with Travelers, but was promoted to Triple-A Salt Lake from July 1-25.
- Opened the season posting a 1.40 ERA (19.1/3) combined in April and May. Fifteen of his 17 appearances in that time were scoreless, and he converted both of his save opportunities.
- Through June 25, he was 0-2 with a 1.50 ERA (30.0/5), earning Texas League Midseason All-Star honors.

HONORS AND AWARDS

- Promoted to Salt Lake on July 1.
- Five of his seven relief outings with Bees were scoreless, allowing three total earned runs in 8.2 innings (3.12 ERA).
- Returned to Arkansas on August 1 and went 0-2, 5.14 (14.0/8) over nine appearances to close out his season.
- Spent 2014 with Single-A Inland Empire, making 43 relief appearances (4-3, 5 sv, 3.36 ERA) and two starts (0-1, 3.00).
- Combined to go 0-0 with two saves and a 1.41 ERA (32.0/5) over 18 appearances in April and May.
- Did not open 2013 campaign until June 20 with rookie-league Orem.
- After three appearances with Owls, promoted to Single-A Burlington for remainder of season.
- Went 1-1, 3.57 (17.2/7) in 16 appearances out of the 'pen to begin his stint with Burlington, then finished campaign by making five starts, going 2-0, 1.29 (28.0/4) with 21 strikeouts.
- Made professional debut in 2012 with rookie-league Orem.
