THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 5-2 through seven games on their 10-game, 11-day roadtrip, going 3-1 at Chicago-AL, 2-0 at St. Louis and 0-1 at Los Angeles-AL...tonight they will play the second of this four-game series against the Angels through the weekend...the Twins have won five of their last six and six of their last eight overall.

TWINS WIN-STREAK HALTED BY HALOS: The Twins lost to the Angels last night by a score of 7-4...José Berrios (3-4) was the starter and loser, allowing five runs on seven hits in 5.1 innings pitched, including two home runs...the offense recorded eight hits, four coming from Brian Dozier, tying his career-high...Dozier and Max Kepler hit back-to-back homers to tie the game in the sixth inning but the bullpen allowed three runs in the sixth and seventh.

TWINS AND ANGELS: The Twins and Angels are playing the second of seven games this season...the Angels will travel to Minnesota for three from June 8-10...the Twins are 9-5 against the Angels since 2016, going 3-1 in those series...this ties for their most wins against any non-divisional opponent in that span (9-5 vs. Texas).

☞ Infielder Gregorio Petit played in a career-high 89 games for the Angels in 2016, hitting .245 (50-for-204) with two home runs and 17 RBI.

☞ Pitcher Fernando Rodney pitched two seasons for the Angels from 2010-11, going 7-8, 4.32 ERA (100.0 IP, 48 ER) with 17 saves in 111 games.

☞ Catcher Bobby Wilson was drafted by the Angels in the 48th round of the 2002 First-Year Player Draft...he played parts of five seasons for the Angels from 2008-12, hitting .208 (81-for-389) with eight home runs in 191 games.

INSIDE THE ROADTRIP: The Twins have gone 5-2 on their current roadtrip...out-scoring opponents 41-25 and out-hitting them 63-50...Twins hitters have a .351 (20-for-57) average with runners in scoring position...Twins pitchers have posted a 3.36 ERA (61.2 IP, 23 ER) with 14 walks, 63 strikeouts and a .227 opponent batting average.

RED HOT ROSIE: Eddie Rosario has hit safely in 11 of his last 13 games, hitting .368 (21-for-57) with seven doubles, five home runs and 15 RBI in that span...he has multiple hits in eight of those.

MIGHTY MOUSE: Eduardo Escobar has hit out of the fourth spot in the lineup in 14 games, second most on the team to Rosario (15)...he has a .582 slugging percentage when in that spot, the sixth highest in the AL, trailing Didi Gregorius (.974), Yangervis Solarte (.610), J.D. Martinez (.606), Nomar Mazara (.600) and Giancarlo Stanton (.589)...his .915 OPS out of that spot ranks seventh.

☞ Since April 17, Escobar is hitting .371 (13-for-35) in eight Twins wins, compared to .260 (13-for-50) in 13 Twins losses.

SOME LEFT FOR THE LEFTIES: Twins batters are hitting .266 (63-for-237) with 21 doubles, six home runs, 34 RBI, 25 walks and a .340 on-base percentage against left-handed pitching this season...in their last nine games, they are hitting .367 (22-for-60) with a .451 on-base percentage.

☞ Max Kepler is hitting .357 (10-for-28) with four doubles, two home runs and a .419 on-base percentage against lefties this season... Joe Mauer is hitting .353 (6-for-17) with a .542 OBP against lefties...their batting averages among left-handed batters rank seventh and eighth in baseball respectively, fourth and fifth in the AL.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY, MIGGY!: Miguel Sanó is celebrating his 25th birthday today...he has missed the Twins last 12 games suffering from a left hamstring strain...Sanó went 1-for-2 with a solo home run on his birthday last season at Chicago-AL.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS/SENATORS FRANCHISE HISTORY: In 1919, Walter Johnson of the Washington Senators pitched 12 scoreless innings in a duel with Jack Quinn of the New York Yankees at the Polo Grounds...Johnson allowed only two hits and retired 28 batters in-a-row...the Senators moved to Minnesota prior to the 1961 season...Johnson is the Senators/Twins franchise all-time leader in wins (417), starts (666), games (802), ERA (2.17), complete games (531), innings pitched (5914.2) and shutouts (110).

LAST START: Lynn earned his first win of the season and first as a Twin in his last start, May 5 at Chicago-AL...he went 6.0 innings, tied for his longest start this season with his start April 20 at Tampa Bay, allowed two runs on eight hits, striking out seven and walking none...this marked the first time this season that Lynn did not walk a batter, after issuing 26 walks over his first five starts...Lynn did not allow a walk or home run in the same start for the first time since July 15, 2017 at Pittsburgh...marked his first quality start of the season.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY: Tomorrow marks Lynn's 31st birthday...in comparison to his same-age peers his 10.01 SO/9 is well above the average of 6.54 SO/9...Lynn is the veteran in the active starting rotation, edging out Kyle Gibson who does not turn 31 until October of this year.

MILESTONE ALERT: Lynn eclipsed the 1000.0 inning mark for his career in his start on April 30 against Toronto...there are 71 active players in MLB that have 1,000-or-more innings, 12 of those have 2,000+ IP and just two have 3,000 IP or more...Lynn ranks 72nd in innings among actives with 1007.1 innings.

- First pitcher in Twins uniform to reach 1,000.0 innings pitched since Phil Hughes in April of 2015.
- Lynn currently has 952 career-strikeouts, 48 short of the 1,000 strikeout mark.

AGAINST THE ANGELS: Lynn has faced Los Angeles-AL just once previously in his career, he is 0-1 with a 7.50 ERA (6.0 IP, 5 ER)...his only start and appearance against the Angels came on July 2, 2013 in Los Angeles...he struck out eight batters and walked just one...Lynn has not faced the American League West much in his career...going 0-2 with a 4.34 ERA (18.2 IP, 9 ER) across three starts, two against Houston including his start this year on April 9 where he did not factor in the decision after throwing 5.0 shutout innings on three hits.

APRIL SHOWERS BRING MAY FLOWERS: Lynn had an uncharacteristic April, posting a 8.37 ERA, a .290 opponent average, and failing to record a win...previously Lynn's highest April ERA was 3.60 in 2014 and the highest opponent average against him was .267 in 2015...throughout his career in the month of May, he owns a 3.10 ERA and a .234 opponent batting average...he has a 13-7 record in this month and the lowest slugging percentage (.347) of any month...Lynn also has the most innings-pitched of any month in his career in May (183.0) and has allowed the second fewest home runs (12).

ALL OR NOTHING: In his six starts this season, Lynn is boasting an 10.01 SO/9, which is 16th best in the AL and second-best on the Twins among pitchers with at least five starts...his April SO/9 ratio is the second-best of his career (first 10.55 SO/9 in 2013)...on the other end of the charts, Lynn has a 6.98 BB/9 ratio, which is the highest in the AL among pitchers with five-or-more starts and highest of his career...his next highest BB/9 was in 2013 with a 4.03 ratio and his best walks-per-nine mark was in 2012 with 2.00 BB/9.

2017 RECAP:

- Lynn ranked tied for first in the NL in games started (33) sixth in AVG (.223), sixth in fewest H/9 (7.29), and seventh in ERA (3.43).
- Lynn had five starts of 7.0 or-more innings and 19 starts of 6.0 or-more innings, going 9-2 across those starts with 92 strikeouts.
- On May 5 against Los Angeles-NL, Lynn went 8.0 innings pitched while allowing just two hits, one run and 10 strikeouts.
- From April 17-May 5 Lynn had a season-high four-game win-streak posting a 0.72 ERA (25.0 IP, 2 ER) while striking out 23.

SO LONG ST. LOUIS: Lynn was a first-round pick for the Cardinals in 2008 Draft...over his six years with the Cardinals, he ranked first among starters on the team in games started (161) and ERA (3.38) and second in wins (72) and innings pitched (977.2), despite missing all of 2016 due to "Tommy John" surgery.

TOUGH TO HIT: In 2017 Lynn was among the top-10 pitchers in average against...batters hit .219, ranking him ninth in MLB and sixth in the NL...Lynn ranked 10th in the NL for lowest average against righties with a .203 mark...lefties had more success against Lynn with a .245 average against.

WALK-A-LOT: In 2017 Lynn ranked second in MLB and in the NL for most BB/9 (3.77) behind Arizona's Robbie Ray who had a 3.94 BB/9...his 3.77 mark was the highest of his career (2015 - 3.49, 2014 - 3.18, 2013 - 3.39, and 2012 - 3.27)...in his first season back from "Tommy John" surgery Lynn issued 78 walks in 186.1 innings...Lynn issued 44 walks on the road vs. 34 walks at home and of his 78 walks last season 53 came against left-handed batters...Lynn is among the league leaders in walks in 2018, yielding 23 free passes in five starts, which is tied for most in baseball.

LUCKY LYNN: Last season Lynn was tied for first in the NL in opponents batting average on balls in play (.248), a mark he shared with Cy Young Award winner Max Scherzer (WAS) and Jeremy Hellickson (PHI-BAL)...he has only had two years where opponent's BABIP was below .300, and has a career opponent BABIP of .301, which ranks as the 11th highest in the NL since 2011.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - KYLE GIBSON [SEASON: 1-1, 3.49 ERA ; CAREER: 45-49, 4.63 ERA]

Gibson is making his ninth career start against Los Angeles-AL, is 2-2 with a 5.32 ERA (45.2 IP, 27 ER) with 15 walks and 31 strikeouts...has won his last two decisions against the Halos, his last win coming July 4, 2017, allowed two runs on five hits and two walks with four strikeouts over 6.2 innings...last loss to the Angles came July 21, 2015 when he surrendered six runs (five earned) on 10 hits and one walk with six strikeouts over 5.0 innings...his 4.05 ERA against AL West teams is second best ERA against any division behind the NL West (4.01).
