NATIONALS NEWS

MOVING ON...

The Washington Nationals fell to the New York Mets, 3-2, on Saturday afternoon and are now looking to avoid their first sweep of the season on Sunday night...The last time the Nationals suffered a sweep at the hands of the Mets was Sept. 7-9, 2015 at Nationals Park.

- Following Sunday night's season finale, the Nationals will continue this 10-game homestand on Monday against Atlanta (3 G) before welcoming the Colorado Rockies to town for a four-game set starting Thursday.

HARPER'S HOMERS

Bryce Harper clubbed his fifth home run of the season on Saturday, a solo shot in in the sixth inning off **Hansel Robles**...His five home runs lead Major League Baseball, as does his .917 slugging percentage...Harper ranks among National League hitters in OPS (1st, 1.403), walks (2nd, 11), RBI (T4th, 10), runs scored (T5th, 8), and on-base percentage (7th, .486).

- With 431 RBI for his career, Harper is just one RBI shy of tying **Ian Desmond** (432) for second-most in Nationals history behind **Ryan Zimmerman** (940).

IT STARTS AT THE TOP

Through the first seven games, **Adam Eaton** is 10-for-23 (.435) with three doubles, two homers, five RBI, three walks and 10 runs scored...He has reached base safely in all six of his starts and in six of seven games total.

- Eaton leads the National League in batting average (.435) and is tied for first with 10 runs scored... He ranks second in the National League (behind Bryce Harper) in slugging percentage (.826) and OPS (1.326).
- Although he has only played in 30 games for Washington since the start of the 2017 season, Eaton has scored 34 runs in those 30 games...All told, he is hitting .325 with 10 doubles, one triple, four homers, 18 RBI, 17 walks and 34 runs scored in 30 games as a National.

VOTE FOR PEDRO

Pedro Severino went 2-for-3 with one RBI and one stolen base on Saturday against the Mets...It was his second multi-hit game of the season and the stolen base was the first of his career...Since being recalled on April 2, Severino has reached base safely in eight of 11 plate appearances (.727 OBP, 4 H, 2 HBP, 2 BB).

HOWIE'S DOIN' IT

Howie Kendrick has reached base safely in each of his first seven games of the season...He has hit safely in six of the games and he was hit by a pitch on April 4 at Atlanta while serving as a pinch hitter...Kendrick has recorded three multi-hit efforts and four of his nine hits have been doubles...His four doubles are tied for third in the National League.

NO INHERITANCE TAX

Nationals relievers have inherited 11 runners so far this season, with only one coming around to score (9.1%)...They are one of six teams in Major League Baseball (one of three in the NL) to allow no more than one inherited runner to come around to score in 2018.

STOLEN MOMENTS

Washington stole five bases on Saturday, the most in a game since July 27, 2017 vs. CHI and tied for the fourth most in a single game in Nationals history (2005-pres)...The Nationals lead MLB with 12 stolen bases.

RIZZO EXTENSION

On Thursday morning, the Washington Nationals announced a two-year contract extension for President of Baseball Operations and General Manager **Mike Rizzo**, keeping him with the club through the 2020 season.

- "Mike's commitment to our shared goal of bringing a World Championship to Washington, D.C. makes this an exciting day for our family and the Washington Nationals," said **Theodore N. Lerner**, Managing Principal Owner of the Washington Nationals. "Mike and his staff have built quite a team—one that brings excitement to our ballpark every night and gives our city something to be proud of."
- "I'm proud of the progress we've made in Washington, DC, building the Nationals from nearly expansion status into one of the winningest clubs in Major League Baseball," **Rizzo** said. "I appreciate the Lerner family for giving me the continued opportunity to see what we can accomplish in the future."

NATIONALS HISTORY

April 8 (5-5 on this date)

2009—**Ryan Zimmerman**'s sixth-inning double off Florida's **Andrew Miller** ignited a 30-game hitting streak, the longest such streak in Nationals' history. Zimmerman's 30-gamer ranked third among DC-based big leaguers behind only **Heinie Manush** (1933 AL Nationals, 33 games) and **Sam Rice** (1924 AL Nationals, 31 games).

NEW YORK METS

Nationals second baseman **Daniel Murphy** spent seven seasons (2008-15) with the New York Mets...Washington's hitting coach **Kevin Long** served as New York's hitting coach from 2015-17 and bench coach **Chip Hale** served as their third base coach from 2010-11.

THE SERIES

The Nationals went 13-6 against the Mets in 2017, outscoring them 115-74 along the way.

DAVE MARTINEZ

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** was named the seventh field manager in Nationals history on Oct. 30, 2017. He joined the Nationals for what will be his 30th season in professional baseball. A 16-year Major League outfielder, Martinez has been a Major League coach for the last 10 seasons, serving as Cubs manager Joe Maddon's bench coach and right-hand man in Chicago (2015-17) as well as Tampa Bay (2008-14). This is the first Major League managerial assignment of Martinez's career.

#57 - TANNER ROARK - RHP

Right-hander is one of MLB's top unheralded pitching performers...Since 2013, is 51-36 with a 3.42 ERA in 112 starts...He has eclipsed the 13-win mark in each of his seasons as a full-time starter (2014, 2016-17)...Since 2014, he ranks third among MLB starting pitchers in hard-hit rate (25.2%), according to FanGraphs.com...Has tossed 7.0 innings in 43 of his 112 career starts (38%), going 26-9 with a 1.47 ERA in those 43 starts...Helped Team USA bring home the Gold Medal in the 2017 World Baseball Classic...Is stellar with the glove, having committed just two errors in 107 games (502.1 IP) since the start of 2015.

AGAINST THE METS: Is 7-2 with a 2.76 ERA in 17 games (11 starts) against the Mets...His 2.76 ERA is his lowest against any National League East opponent...Has surrendered just five homers to Mets hitters, with three of them coming in 2017...In his 11 starts, has pitched to a 2.54 ERA (19 ER/67.1 IP)...Faced the Mets twice in 2017, going 1-0 with a 4.26 ERA (6 ER/12.2 IP).

LAST START: Opened the season with 7.0 strong innings on April 2 at ATL...Allowed one earned run on four hits while striking out six and walking one as Washington topped Atlanta, 8-1...Right-handed batters went 0-for-6 with one strikeout against him.

2017 NOTES

- Was one of the top pitchers in the National League in the season's second half...In 12 starts post-All-Star break, he went 7-5 with a 3.90 ERA in 14 games (13 starts)...He struck out 86 batters in 80.2 IP and held opposing batters to a .223 AVG.
- After the break, he ranked among NL pitchers (min. 13 GS) in opp. AVG (6th, .223), opp. OBP (7th, .292), hits per 9.0 IP (6th, 7.59), strikeouts per 9.0 IP (9th, 9.60).
- He recorded 42 strikeouts against just eight walks in his last six starts.
- His 10.51 strikeouts per 9.0 IP ranked sixth and his 5.25 SO/BB ranked ninth in the National League from Aug. 27 through the end of the season.
- Improved from 7.4 strikeouts per 9.0 IP in 2016 to 8.2 strikeouts per 9.0 IP in 2017.
- Went 6-6 with a 5.27 ERA in 18 games (17 starts) prior to the All-Star break.
- Threw a season-high 7.2 IP on June 5 at OAK. (7.2 IP, 5 H, 4 ER, BB, 4 SO).
- Recorded two 10+ strikeout games (11, 7/22 at ARI and 10, 9/1 at MIL) after entering the season with just two for his career.

2016 NOTES

- In his return to the starting rotation, Roark set career marks in innings pitched (210.0) and wins (16) in 2016.
- Ranked in the National League in wins (T5th, 16), HR/9.0 IP (6th, 0.73), H/9.0 IP (9th, 7.41), and ERA (6th, 2.83).
- Threw 7.0 or more shutout innings nine times, the most MLB...CHI RHP Jake Arrieta was second with eight...
- Per FanGraphs.com, he had the lowest hard-hit rate (24.3%) in Major League Baseball.
- He tossed 7.0 (or more) innings 18 times, third-most in the NL...Teammate Max Scherzer ranked first with 20 and Jhonny Cueto was second with 19...Along with Scherzer, the two combined to throw at least 7.0 innings in 38 starts, and they also combined to pitch at least 7.0 innings while allowing two runs or fewer 33 times...Of the 22 pitchers who put together at least 10 outings of 7.0 (or more) innings with two runs allowed (or fewer), no team had a pair who compiled more such starts.
- Outpaced career marks in SO/9.0 (7.37 in 2016; 6.59 career), H/9.0 (7.41 in 2016; 7.97 career) & swing-and-miss % (21.9% in 2016; 19.7% career).
- Left-handed batters hit just .214 / .315 / .302 against Roark in 2016...Among right-handed pitchers with at least 400 left-handed batters faced (essentially, all right-handed starting pitchers),
- Roark's .302 opponent slugging percentage led the National League, and his .214 batting average against was good for sixth
