YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians scored four times in the first two innings and collected 12 hits overall, but saw their five-game winning streak come to an end as the Blue Jays stormed back to beat Cleveland 8-4.
» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** again led the Tribe offense, going 3-for-5 with a pair of doubles and an RBI...**TYLER NAQUIN** also had a multi-hit effort, going 2-for-4 with an RBI single in the 1st inning... each of the other seven Indians starters had one hit, marking the first time all the members of the Tribe starting lineup hit safely since September 2, 2017 at Detroit.
» **MIKE CLEVINGER** did not factor into the decision after allowing four runs on three hits over 4.0 innings of work...all of the damage off Clevinger came in a 39-pitch 4th inning that forced his early exit.

KEEP CALM AND COREY ON

» **COREY KLUBER** will take the mound this afternoon for the Tribe in his fourth start of the season and his second of this homestand... picked up a dominant win on April 9 vs. Detroit, allowing just two hits over 8.0 shutout innings with a season-high 13 strikeouts.
» Kluber currently leads Major League Baseball with 23.0 innings pitched this season, while he ranks 3rd in the American League with 27 strikeouts and 10th in the A.L. with a 1.57 ERA.
» Has worked at least 7.0 innings with at least six strikeouts and two-or-fewer runs in all three of his starts this season...marks the longest streak of such starts to open a campaign by an Indians pitcher since **Sam McDowell's** club record streak of four starts to begin the 1964 season.
» Kluber faced the Blue Jays just once in 2017, taking the win on July 23 at Progressive Field after holding Toronto to one run on five hits over 7.2 strong innings of work...set his 2017 season-high that afternoon with 14 strikeouts.

FRANKIE'S IN FORM

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** has swung the Tribe's hottest bat over the past few games, recording multi-hit efforts in each of his last three contests.
» Lindor has hit .500 (7-14) since Wednesday with a homer, five RBI and five runs scored, raising his season batting average from .159 to .241...marks his 9th career streak of three-or-more consecutive multi-hit games, a feat he achieved just once in his 2017 All-Star campaign.
» Lindor leads the Tribe with 14 hits, 22 total bases and nine runs scored...he is a career .324 (24-74) hitter in 17 games against Toronto with a homer, nine runs scored and six RBI.

MOUND MASTERS

» Cleveland pitching has surrendered 16 runs total over the first eight games of this homestand, good for a 2.00 team ERA (16ER/72.0IP)...opposing batters have recorded just 47 hits in that span, a rate of less than six per ballgame.
» The Indians pitching staff ranks 3rd in the American League (6th in MLB) with a 3.13 ERA this season...their 3.06 starter ERA is 5th in the A.L. and MLB, while their 3.32 relief ERA is 4th in the A.L.
» The Indians have allowed three runs or fewer in 10 of their 14 games this season, tied with Boston for the most in MLB...Cleveland has recorded 103 such games since the start of 2017, also the most in the Majors over that span.
» **COREY KLUBER** is currently the American League leader in innings pitched (23.0) and complete games (1, T1st), while he ranks 3rd in strikeouts (27) and 4th in opponent batting average (.143)...**CARLOS CARRASCO** is tied for the A.L. lead in both wins (3) and complete games (1).

STANDINGS CHECK

» Due to last night's postponement in Minnesota, the Indians have fallen half a game behind the first-place Twins (7-4) in the A.L. Central standings after spending the previous four days in a tie for the lead...the Indians have already played three more games than Minnesota, who will face the Tribe for a two-game series in San Juan, Puerto Rico on Tuesday and Wednesday.
» The Tribe's high-water mark for the season came after Thursday's win vs. Detroit, when they sat three games over .500 (8-5) and spent their fourth day in 1st place...the Tribe spent 132 days in 1st place last season, including every day from June 26 onward.

THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

» **1911:** Cleveland ace Addie Joss passes away unexpectedly at the age of 31 from tuberculous meningitis, days before the start of his 10th big-league season...on July 24, 1911, the first-ever "all-star" game was held at League Park as a benefit for the Joss family, with stars from all eight American League clubs playing and paying tribute...Joss was elected posthumously to the Hall of Fame by the Veterans Committee in 1978; he still ranks 2nd on the all-time MLB leaderboard in ERA (1.89) and 1st in WHIP (0.968).

OUR FRIENDS IN THE NORTH

»The Indians welcome Toronto to Cleveland as they conclude this 10-game homestand with a three-game set vs. the Blue Jays.
» Cleveland posted a record of 4-2 against the Blue Jays in 2017... the Tribe swept a three-game series at Progressive Field from July 21-23, punctuated by a **FRANCISCO LINDOR** walk-off homer in the bottom of the 10th inning as the Tribe won, 2-1, on July 22.
» Since the start of 2016 (including the 2016 Postseason), the Indians have gone 12-7 against Toronto, with a 7-2 mark at home.
» The two clubs have met 413 times in the regular season since the Blue Jays' inaugural season in 1977, with Toronto holding a slight 206-205-2 edge...Cleveland has gone 9-4-1 in the season series vs. the Blue Jays since 2004...the Indians' 4-1 victory over Toronto in the 2016 ALCS was the first Postseason matchup between the clubs.

EASTERN PROMISES

» The Tribe's series against Toronto this weekend marks the first contests of the Tribe's 33-game slate against the teams of the A.L. East, 16 of which are scheduled to come at Progressive Field.
» Cleveland posted a record of 22-12 (.647) against the A.L. East in 2017, going 11-6 at Progressive Field and 11-6 on the road... seven of the Tribe's wins during their 22-game winning streak last season came against A.L. East opponents (one vs. Boston, three at New York-AL, three vs. Baltimore).
» Since Tampa Bay joined the A.L. East in 1998, the Indians have gone 386-370 (.511) against the division...Cleveland has played at least one Postseason contest against all five teams, with matchups against A.L. East teams in 13 of their 15 all-time Postseason series at the American League level (including each of their last six).

HOME COOKING

» The Indians have opened their 2018 home slate with a 6-2 record on this 10-game homestand...last season, the Indians posted a 49-32 (.605) record at Progressive Field, the 2nd-best home record in the American League and 4th-best in the Majors.
» Since the 2017 All-Star Break, Cleveland has gone an MLB-best 34-10 (.773) at home, including wins in 23 of their past 27 regular-season games here.
» In addition, Cleveland currently leads MLB with a .183 opponent batting average at home, while they rank 2nd in the A.L. and MLB with a 2.00 home ERA...Tribe starters have posted a 1.82 ERA (11ER/54.1IP) on this homestand.
» This current 10-game homestand (vs. KC, DET & TOR) matches the longest the Tribe will play this season, along with another 10-gamer from July 6-15 (vs. OAK, CIN & NYY).

MISC. NOTES

» After being held to seven-or-fewer hits in each of the first 11 games, Cleveland has collected double-digit hits in three consecutive contests, raising its team batting average over 40 points (from .158 to .200).
» **RAJAI DAVIS** stole his team-high 4th base in last night's game, raising the team total to an American League-high 13 stolen bases (2nd in MLB)...the first Tribe batter to steal their fourth base in 2017 was **Michael Brantley**, who did so on May 19 at Houston (team game #40).
» The Indians plated a pair of runs in the 1st inning last night, continuing a trend of early scoring for the Tribe...Cleveland's 15 1st-inning runs this season are tied with Los Angeles-AL for the most in the American League...overall, 24 of the Tribe's 49 runs scored this season (49.0%) have come over the first three innings.

JACKIE ROBINSON DAY ACTIVITIES

» The Indians and all of Major League Baseball will honor the legacy of Jackie Robinson tomorrow on the 71st anniversary of the Dodgers great and Hall of Famer breaking baseball's color barrier.
» All 30 clubs will wear Robinson's #42 on their jerseys tomorrow, the only number universally retired by MLB...in addition, the Tribe will also present the Most Valuable Diverse Business Partner Award to Ten10 Design of Chardon, Ohio...Esosa Osa, a 2012 Jackie Robinson Foundation/MLB Alumnus, is scheduled to throw out a ceremonial first pitch.
