SAN DIEGO NOTES

- **Joey Lucchesi** is the first pitcher this season to record two pickoffs in a single game...Clayton Richard was the only pitcher in baseball last season to accomplish this feat (May 27 vs. Washington).
 - Has tossed 5.0 innings-or-more in seven of his eight starts.
 - Is 2-0 in five starts at Petco Park with a 2.39 ERA (7 ER, 26.1 IP) and 29 strikeouts against six walk...his 2.39 ERA at Petco Park this season leads all Padres starters.
- **A.J. Ellis** has reached base safely in each of his last five games, going 7-for-16 (.438) in that span...logged extra-base hits in consecutive games for the first time this season and the first since he did so in back-to-back games July 9-16.
- **Jose Pirela** has reached base safely in 13 of his last 15 games and has hit safely in four of his last five (.375, 6-for-16)...is hitting .389 (7-for-18) against NL East teams this year.
- **Manuel Margot** logged a career-high-tying three hits tonight (10x; last: September 8, 2017 at Arizona).

WASHINGTON NOTES

- **Gio Gonzalez** owns a 3-2 record with a 3.21 ERA (15 ER, 42.0 IP) in seven career starts against the Padres...is 2-1 in four starts on the road this year with a 2.82 ERA (7 ER, 22.1 IP).
- **Anthony Rendon** belted his second homer of the season in the fourth inning...has gone 6-for-18 (.333) since returning from the disabled list on May 5 with two doubles, a home run, four RBI, three walks and three runs in that time.
- **Wilmer Difo** has posted a .438 batting average (14-for-32) in 11 games since April 28 with two doubles, two homers, five RBI and seven walks.
- **Ryan Zimmerman** has 1,689 career hits and is just five hits shy of tying Tim Wallach on the Nationals all-time hit list.
- **Howie Kendrick** has reached base safely in 29 of 35 games this season, posting a .324 OBP in that time.
