**THE LOSS:** The Royals were swept for the 10th time and are winless in 10 consecutive series (0-9-1) since their last win May 28-30 vs. Minnesota (2-1), dropping to 3-21-4 in series of at least two games...they've lost 18 of 21 games overall and are 36 under .500 (25-61) for the first time since ending the 2006 season 62-100.

- + Swept by Cleveland at home for the first time since Sept. 30-Oct. 2, 2016, dropping to 2-7 vs. Cleveland this season and have lost six consecutive series.
- + Held to four runs or fewer for the 25th time in the last 26 games, including a club-record 19-game run from June 5-26...held to five or fewer in all 26 games since June 5, the second-longest streak in the American League within one season in the last 46 years (since 1973), trailing the 2000 Tampa Bay Devil Rays (29).
- + Held to single-digits in hits for the 25th time in the last 26 games since June 5, a stretch in which they're batting .191/.247/.289 (161-for-841) with 55 runs.
- + Have lost 12 of 13 at home, falling to 11-32 (.256) through 43 games, and are on pace to surpass 1998 (29-51) for the worst home record in club history.
- + **Heath Fillmyer** (3.0 IP), **Tim Hill** (1.0 IP) and **Wily Peralta** (1.0 IP) combined for 5.0 scoreless innings, extending the bullpen's scoreless streak to 14.2 IP.
- + The game time temperature was 90 degrees or above (92) for the seventh time in 43 games at Kauffman Stadium this season (and 6th time in the last 10), the third-most 90-degree (or higher) games at an outdoor ballpark in the Majors, trailing only Globe Life Park (19 including tonight) and Busch Stadium (9).

**TREVOR OAKS:** Made his first Major League start since his debut on April 28, dropping to 0-2 with a 7.24 ERA (11 ER in 13.2 IP) in four appearances (2 starts).

- + The steal of home by **Alex Gordon** in the second inning was the first run the Royals have supported Oaks with in his 13.2 innings in the Majors in 2018.
- + Went: walk, RBI double (**Michael Brantley**), one-out sacrifice fly (**Edwin Encarnacion**) to fall behind 2-0 after just 15 pitches, more runs than he'd allowed in any of his previous seven starts with Triple-A Omaha since May 14, a stretch in which he posted a 0.62 ERA (3 ER in 42.0 IP)...allowed back-to-back walks to begin the second, the first of which scored on another sac. fly (**Greg Allen**)...retired nine of the last 11, stranding a two-out walk in the third and leadoff double in the fourth...exited after 4.0 innings, trailing 3-1...pitch count by inning: 18 (1st), 21 (2nd), 18 (3rd), 16 (4th), 73 total.

**HEATH FILLMYER:** Retired nine of 10 batters en route to 3.0 scoreless innings, lowering his Major League ERA to 2.00 (2 ER in 9.0 IP) since his June 19 recall.

**WHIT MERRIFIELD:** Had a sac. fly in the fifth to mark his third straight game with an RBI, on the heels of a 27-game stretch (May 29-July 1) in which he had two RBI.

- + Doubled to leadoff the eighth inning, extending his hit streak to seven games, in which he's batting .379/.387/.517 (11-for-29)...represented the tying run with one out, but was caught stealing third base, just the second time he's been caught at third in 21 career attempts.

**ALEX GORDON:** Reached via hit-by-pitch in the second inning, extending his franchise record to 96, 18 more than second place **Mike Macfarlane**.

- + Stole home on a double steal (**Hunter Dozier**, 1st career) in the second, the 37th steal of home in Royals history and the first since **Alex Rios** on July 20, 2015.
- + Doubled with one out in the ninth, the 496th extra-base hit of his career, four shy of becoming the 14th active left-handed batter with 500.

**INDIANS:** Completed their fifth three-game sweep of the season, joining: April 9-12 vs. Detroit, May 28-30 vs. Chicago, June 18-20 vs. Chicago and June 22-24 vs. Detroit...it's their first three-game road sweep since Sept. 19-21, 2017 in Anaheim and fourth road series win in 2018, improving to 12-11-6 in series play overall.

- + Have won four straight to improve to a season-high 11 games over .500 (48-37)...completed this nine-game road trip 5-4, despite losing four of the first five.
- + Won a road game on Independence Day for the first time since 1973 in Detroit, snapping an 11-game skid (STATS) & improving to 90-77-2 overall on the holiday.
- + Swept a three-game set in Kansas City for the first time since Sept. 30-Oct. 2, 2016, and have won six straight series vs. the Royals, improving to 7-2 in 2018.
- + Are 28-13 vs. the AL Central, including 10 straight wins, their longest intra-division win streak since a run of 15 straight wins from Aug. 25-Sept. 14, 2017.
- + Since allowing a four-run eighth inning on Saturday in Oakland, the bullpen has recorded 10.1 scoreless innings on just six hits over the last four games.
- + **Alex Gordon** stole home in the second as part of a double steal (**Hunter Dozier**), the first vs. Cleveland since **Chris Taylor** on June 14, 2017 (double steal).
- + Starting pitchers are 19-2 with a 2.34 ERA (51 ER in 196.1 IP) in series finales this season, including wins in each of their last 11 decisions.

**TREVOR BAUER:** He's held opponents to three earned runs or fewer in 15 consecutive road starts since Aug. 14, 2017, a stretch in which he owns a 2.25 ERA (25 ER in 100.0 IP)...it's the longest such streak by an Indians pitcher since **Corey Kluber** had an 18-start streak on the road from April 13, 2014-April 17, 2015.

- + He's recorded at least 100 pitches in 18 consecutive starts, the longest streak by an Indians pitcher since 1988 (when *Baseball Reference* pitch-count data is available)...it's the longest streak in the Majors since **Chris Archer** went 24 consecutive starts with at least 100 pitches since Aug. 12, 2016-June 17, 2017.
- + He's had at least eight strikeouts in eight straight starts, the third-longest streak in Indians history behind **Corey Kluber** (14 in 2017) & **Bob Feller** (9 in 1946).
- + He's 6-3 with a 2.19 ERA (17 ER in 70.0 IP) and 89 strikeouts (11.4 K/9) in 10 starts vs. AL Central teams, the most strikeouts by any pitcher vs. one division.
- + He's 3-1 with a 2.28 ERA (10 ER in 39.1 IP) in seven career starts at Kauffman Stadium, his best ERA in any ballpark (min. 4 starts) ahead of Safeco Field (2.45).
- + Recorded just one clean inning (4th), but held Kansas City to 0-for-4 with runners in scoring position...stranded a two-out single in the first, but allowed **Alex Gordon** to score from third on a double steal in the second...erased a one-out single in the third with an inning-ending, strike-em-out, throw-em-out double play...allowed three to reach in a four-batter stretch in the fifth, but just one scored on a **Whit Merrifield** sac. fly...retired seven straight before allowing two of the first three to reach in the eighth...exited after 7.2 innings, leading 3-2 in favor of **Oliver Pérez**, who stranded the inherited runner...pitch count by inning: 11 (1st), 19 (2nd), 13 (3rd), 10 (4th), 20 (5th), 15 (6th), 7 (7th), 13 (8th), 108 total.

**CODY ALLEN:** Recorded his 18th save in 19 chances and the 140th of his career, breaking a tie with **Bob Wickman** for the Indians franchise record.

**JOSÉ RAMÍREZ:** Did not record a hit, but had his eighth career multi-steal game and first since May 9 at Milwaukee...he's the first Indians player to start a game and record multiple steals but no hits since **Jason Kipnis** on April 14, 2016 at Tampa Bay.

**MICHAEL BRANTLEY:** Put Cleveland on the board with an RBI double in the first inning, his 500th career RBI, becoming the 10th left-handed batter in franchise history to reach the 500-RBI milestone and first since **Travis Hafner**, who ended his Indians career with 688...Brantley is now 18 shy of **Kenny Lofton** for ninth.

**CLEVELAND CHALLENGE:** The Indians challenged the out call on **José Ramírez** at second base in the eighth inning...call was overturned (0:26 delay).
