TWINS NOTES:

- **THE TWINS** lost the first of three games to the Yankees to extend their losing streak against the Yankees to eight games...over the eight game losing streak, have been outscored 51-17...fall to 16-16 against the AL East this year and have lost four straight to AL East opponents...fall to 2-2 on the current homestand and 41-31 at home overall...Twins pitchers walked 10 batters tonight; entered the night with the worst walk rate in baseball over the last 30 days...fall to 26-16 when getting 10 or more hits...fall to 13 games under .500, matching their lowest mark of the season...are now 22-24 in series openers.
- **KYLE GIBSON** suffered the loss after allowing one run against the Yankees over 5.2 innings on four hits and four walks with five strikeouts...induced a ground ball double play in the first inning, his 20th of the year; has now induced at least 20 GIDPs in each of the last five seasons...held the Yankees hitless in six at-bats with runners in scoring position and is now holding opponents to .193 (27-for-140) with RISP this year...in two starts against New York this year, has allowed only one earned run only five hits, but the Twins are 0-2 in both starts...received no runs of support, seventh time this year not receiving a run of support...has now lost four straight starts, tying his longest streak of the season.
- **JORGE POLANCO** (2-for-4) singled twice tonight for his 15th multi-hit game of the year.
- **LOGAN FORSYTHE** (2-for-4) singled twice tonight and now has 52 hits in 51 career games vs. New York...18th multi-hit game this year and his 10th with the Twins.
- **ROBBIE GROSSMAN** (2-for-4) singled and doubled tonight and is now hitting .361 (22-for-61) with eight RBI at Target Field since June 24...24th multi-hit game of the year.
- **GREGORIO PETIT** (1-for-4) doubled in the fifth inning for his first hit in 2018 off a left-handed pitcher.

YANKEES NOTES:

- **THE YANKEES** took the first of three over the Twins to improve to 4-3 on their current road trip...now have 90 wins on the season for the second consecutive year; quickest to 90 wins since they started 90-50 in 2009...improve to 15-8 in their last 23 on the road and 42-30 overall on the road...improve to 15-8 in their last 23 games overall...have now beaten the Twins eight times in a row, their longest streak against any opponent since beating Minnesota eight times from July 25, 2015-June 18, 2016...are now 23-9 against the AL Central and 19-4 vs. the Twins since July 25, 2013...have 233 home runs this year, most in the majors, and are 80-35 in games in which they hit a home run...improve to 62-16 in games in which they score five or more.

- **J.A. HAPP** earned his sixth win as a Yankee after shutting out the Twins over 6.0 innings on six hits with three strikeouts...is now undefeated over his last nine starts, his longest streak of the season...in 11 road starts this year, is 6-2 with a 2.29 ERA (63.0 IP, 16 ER) and is 1-0 with a 1.50 ERA (18.0 IP, 3 ER) in three road starts with the Yankees...now in 42 post-trade games (38 starts) with new clubs in his career, is 21-8 with a 3.16 ERA (222.1 IP, 78 ER)...his 16 wins are tied for fourth most in the AL.
- **MIGUEL ANDUJAR** (1-for-6) hit a two-run double in the seventh inning for his 40th double of the year, which is ties Bob Meusel for third most by a rookie in Yankees history...over his last 56 games, is hitting .327 (70-for-214) with 15 doubles, 40 RBI and 38 runs scored.
- **ANDREW MCCUTCHEN** (1-for-2) reached base four times tonight with a single and four walks, his most times on base in a game since being traded to the Yankees...his average with New York improves to .148 (4-for-27) with eight walks...third game this year with three or more walks, first with the Yankees...scored once and drove in a run on a sacrifice fly.
- **GARY SANCHEZ** (3-for-5) hit a go-ahead solo home run in the sixth inning, singled in the seventh and doubled in the eighth...24 of his last 40 hits have been for extra bases, 13 of which are home runs and 11 of which are doubles...his 12th multi-hit game and his first since June 20 vs. Seattle and his first three-hit game since April 16 vs. Miami.
- **AARON HICKS** (1-for-4) singled and walked twice tonight, both coming in the seventh inning, and has now walked 41 times in 46 games since the All-Star break.
