THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 2-1 through three games on their five-game seven-day roadtrip...today the Twins are playing the first of three at PNC Park (off-day tomorrow)...after the roadtrip finale Wednesday night, the Twins will travel home to begin their ninth season at Target Field with a 10-game, 11-day homestand with three against the Mariners, three against the Astros and four against the White Sox...they will continue on after that with two "home games" in Puerto Rico against the Indians.

YES WAY, JOSÉ!: The Twins beat the Orioles yesterday afternoon at Camden Yards by a score of 7-0, winning their first series of the season...José Berríos (1-0) was the starter and winner, pitching his first career complete game shutout...the offense recorded 10 hits, six going for extra-bases, including two home runs from Brian Dozier, the eighth multi-homer game of his career (also 28th leadoff)...Byron Buxton stole his 26th straight base, extending the club record.

WHO NEEDS RELIEVERS?: Berríos' complete game yesterday gave the Twins seven complete games since the start of 2017, which ranks second in baseball since, trailing only Cleveland (8)...an April 1 complete game is the earliest in Twins history, passing the previous mark set by Dave Goltz on April 5, 1978, beating the Mariners in Seattle 3-2.

IL STREAK: They have won 10 straight IL games, their longest streak since June 17-27, 2008, when they also won 10 straight; the club record is 12, done June 22, 2006-May 19, 2007...they are the only team to ever have three 10-plus IL win-streaks; the all-time record is 13, held by Los Angeles-NL, Miami, Tampa Bay and New York-AL...below are the Twins streaks:

MAUER'S OUT OF THEIR LEAGUE: Joe Mauer is hitting .322 (269-for-835) with 57 doubles, five triples, 21 home runs, 113 RBI, 133 runs scored, 112 walks and a .402 on-base percentage in 227 games against the National League...below are his ranks among actives in IL Play:

IL PLAY, FOR THE RECORD: The Twins went 13-7 in Interleague Play last season, playing mostly NL West opponents...13 wins were the third most in club history, trailing 2006 (16-2) and 2008 (14-4)...they are 203-179 all-time in Interleague Play, tied for eighth most wins in MLB since IL began in 1997...they are 90-102 all-time in road IL games and 113-77 at home.

TWINS AND PITT: The Twins are playing the Pirates for the 29th and 30th time ever this week...they are 16-12 all-time, going 8-4 at the Metrodome, 0-2 at Target Field, 2-4 at Three Rivers Stadium and 6-2 at PNC Park...the Twins last played the Pirates in a two-game series at Target Field July 28-29, 2015, getting swept...their last trip to PNC Park came May 19-20, 2015, sweeping the Bucs in two...these two teams met in the Grapefruit League four times, as the Twins went 1-3.

Ⓢ Left-handed pitcher Zach Duke was drafted by the Pirates in the 20th round of the 2001 First-Year Player Draft and pitched six seasons with Pittsburgh from 2005-10...Robbie Grossman was drafted by the Pirates in the sixth round of the 2008 First-Year Player Draft and was traded from Pittsburgh to Houston in July of 2012.

FOR STARTERS: Starting pitchers Jake Odorizzi (6.0 IP), Kyle Gibson (6.0 IP) and José Berríos (9.0 IP) have combined for 21.0 scoreless innings to start the season...additionally, they have combined to allow five hits (2 doubles, 0 home runs), eight walks, 19 strikeouts and an opponent batting average of 0.74...Twins starters posted a 4.73 ERA (869.2 IP, 457 ER) last season, an improvement of 0.66 in earned run average from the prior season (5.39 in 2016).

HOLY HARDWARE!: On November 14, 2017 it was announced that Paul Molitor was the AL Manager of the Year, marking the third time in club history for a Twins Manager to win the award, joining Tom Kelly (1991) and Ron Gardenhire (2010)...Brian Dozier and Byron Buxton each were recipients of an AL Rawlings Gold Glove Award as Dozier became the second second baseman in club history to win, joining Chuck Knoblauch (1997)...Byron Buxton also was awarded with the AL Platinum Gold for best defensive player in the AL...Buxton posted the fourth-best Zone Rating (.951) for a centerfielder in baseball history and ranked third in baseball in defensive runs saved (24).

NEW BLOOD: The Twins have eight new players on roster for 2018: **Zach Duke** was signed to a one-year contract December 28...**Tyler Kinley** was selected in the Rule 5 Draft...**Lance Lynn** was signed to a one-year contract March 12...**Jake Odorizzi** was acquired via trade with Tampa Bay February 17...**Addison Reed** was signed to a two-year contract January 15...**Fernando Rodney** was signed to a one-year contract (club option in '19) December 15...**Logan Morrison** was signed to a one-year contract February 25...**Ryan LaMarre** was signed to a minor league contract with an invite to spring training November 22.
