IT'S A NEW DAY: The Padres fell to 0-2 in extra-inning affairs last night with the 1-0 defeat, after an infield pop-up single in the 10th inning accounted for the only run of the game...**the Padres pitching staff is yet to surrender an extra-base hit to the Astros so far this series...it's the first time Houston has been held without an extra-base hit in back-to-back contests since September 17-18, 2014 vs. CLE.**

- Both clubs recorded six hits, while the Padres stranded seven runners on base and the Astros stranded eight...the Astros were just 1-for-7 with runners in scoring position while the Padres were 0-for-9.
- **RHP Bryan Mitchell** tossed 5.2 innings of scoreless ball, allowing just three hits yet surrendering a career-high six walks (previous career high: five, 9/28/16 vs. BOS).
- **Craig Stammen** (1.1 IP), **Kazuhisa Makita** (1.0 IP) and **Robbie Erlin** (1.2) allowed just three hits over their 4.0 innings of work in relief...**Kirby Yates** was removed from the game with right ankle inflammation after throwing just one pitch.

WHAT A RELIEF: Stammen struck out three of the four batters he faced last night and is yet to give up a run this season in his five appearances out of the bullpen.

- Stammen and **Jordan Lyles** each have 6.1-scoreless innings streaks to begin the season, tied for the second-longest scoreless streaks by relievers in MLB so far in 2018, behind only LAD Ross Stripling's 6.2 scoreless stretch.
- The Padres bullpen has inherited 15 runners, allowing only two of them to score...their 13.3 inherited runs scored percentage ranks eighth in the majors.
- **So far in this series, Padres relieves have posted a 1.13 ERA (1 ER, 8.0 IP), limited the Astros bats to a .115 average and walked just one batter while striking out 15.**

HOS LIKES HOUSTON: 1B **Eric Hosmer** extended his hitting streak at Minute Maid Park to 12 games last night...he is hitting .392 (20-for-51) during the streak and it's now the longest active hitting streak at the venue.

- His six doubles through the team's first nine games are the most by a Padre in team history and also ranks tied for second among all MLB hitters this season.
- He collected his second-straight multi-hit effort last night and now has five on the season, ranking tied for second in the majors

FINDING BAGS FREDDY: SS **Freddy Galvis** has reached base safely in all nine games to start the season (.444 OBP)...it's the best on-base streak by a Padre to start a season since Justin Upton's 10-game stretch to start the 2015 season.

- His .444 on-base percentage currently ranks tied for 10th in the NL.
- The Padres have produced 18 individual multi-hit performances this season, nine of which have come from Galvis or 1B **Eric Hosmer**.

LET'S TAKE A SERIES: A win today would mark the Padres first series victory over Houston since the Padres took three of four from the Astros in 2012 from 7/16-19 at Petco Park...the last time these two clubs met dates back to the three-game series at Petco from April 27-29, 2015, in which the Padres were swept.

WELL GROUNDED: The Padres have forced 118 ground balls, the most in the National League and second-most in the majors behind OAK's 128...the Friars 48.6 ground ball percentage ranks third-highest.

DOWN ON THE FARM: The Padres No. 16 prospect **Josh Naylor** powered Double-A San Antonio to a pair of wins on Saturday as he combined for four hits and seven RBI in the Missions doubleheader sweep of Arkansas...in the opener, he hit a pair of two-run homers in the fifth and seventh innings...he also made the first non-first-base start in his career (216 games)...he returned to first base for the nightcap and collected two more hits, including a two-run double in the seventh that proved to be the difference maker in the 5-3 win.

- **Franchy Cordero** collected two hits and the newly acquired **Brett Nicholas** put up a three-hit performance in El Paso's 8-3 win, behind RHP **Brett Kennedy's** solid outing (6.0 IP, 4 H, 2 R, 1 ER, 4 SO, 0 BB).

BACK IN ACTION: LHP **Matt Strahm** began his rehab assignment yesterday with Double-A San Antonio and tossed 2.0 innings, allowing one run and striking out six .

- Strahm was acquired by the Padres in a six-player trade last season with the Kansas City Royals and is recovering from a torn left patellar tendon

STARTING PITCHER NOTES

#38 RHP TYSON ROSS (1-0, 4.50)

GUESS WHO'S BACK: RHP Tyson Ross made his season debut and helped guide the Padres to their first win of the season on 4/3 vs. COL, taking the mound in a Padres uniform for the first time since 2016...he tossed 6.0 innings of three-run ball on five hits and three walks while striking out two...it was his first winning decision as a Padre since August 31, 2015 vs. TEX.

- Ross started for the Padres on Opening Day during the 2016 season, but he made just the solitary start before missing the season and undergoing thoracic outlet surgery.
- In 101 appearances (82 starts) for the Padres spanning 2013-18, Ross has a 3.17 ERA (186 ER, 528.0 IP) and a 27-35 record.

TYSON IN H-TOWN: Today will mark Tyson's third career start against the Astros but his first at Minute Maid Park... he is 1-1 with a 5.91 ERA (7 ER, 10.2 IP) against Houston in his previous two starts.

SOLID SPRING: Tyson made five Cactus League appearances (four starts) and pitched to a 3.00 ERA and limited opposing hitters to a .192 average.

A LOOK BACK: In 2017, made 12 appearances (10 starts) for TEX while also making four rehab starts for Round Rock (AAA) and two rehab starts for Frisco (AA).

- While with TEX, he went 3-3 with a 7.71 ERA and 36 SO against 37 BB.

ALL-STAR SEASON: In his first full season as a starter in 2014, he earned his first career All-Star nod and set career highs in starts (31), innings pitched (195.2), strikeouts (195) and ERA (2.81).

- Posted a streak of 14 consecutive quality starts from 6/21 to 9/1 that season, posting a 1.93 ERA over the stretch along with a 9.06 SO/9 IP ratio.
- His 1.88 ERA at Petco was the four-best mark for a home ERA in MLB.

CLAYTON'S TURN: LHP Clayton Richard is set to make his third start of the season tomorrow to kick off the second series off this two-city road trip against the Colorado Rockies.

- Clayton turned in a quality start on Opening Day on 3/29 vs. MIL, tossing 7.0 IP of one-run ball while striking out four and walking one in the Padres' 2-1 extra-inning defeat.
- He was tagged with the loss in his last start on 4/4 vs. COL, allowing five runs on eight hits and three walks in the Padres' 5-2 loss.

- Struck out four of the six Astros batters he faced and recorded his first hold of the season on Friday night against his former club.
- Has allowed just three hits and one walk over 23 batters faced, limiting opponents to a .136 (3-for-22) batting average.

- In eight pre-season games, Yates posted a 1.23 ERA (1 ER, 7.1 IP).
