SAN DIEGO NOTES

- The Padres finished the month of May with a winning record of 15-3...clinched their first series win vs. MIA since they won two of three from Aug. 26-28, 2016 in Florida...it was the first series victory at Petco Park against the Marlins since July 23-26, 2015 (when they won three of four).
- **Jordan Lyles** threw a season-high 106 pitches in tonight's game and made his first start against the Marlins since August 23, 2014...is now 2-1 in six career games (four starts) against MIA.
 - The Padres are 4-1 in games he has started this season.
- **Christian Villanueva's** 15 home runs before June 1st are the most by a National League rookie since Albert Pujols hit 16 home runs before June 1st in 2001...has the second-most homers in the National League behind WSH's Bryce Harper (18) and leads all rookies in home runs (15) and RBI (35).
 - His 11 homers vs. lefties are the most of any player in the majors.
- **Eric Hosmer** is riding a four-game hitting streak and his last two games have been three-hit efforts...in his past 19 games, he has six doubles, a home run and 12 RBI with a .438 SLG.
- **Hunter Renfro** is batting .324 (12-for-37) at Petco Park this season with five doubles and a triple.
- **Freddy Galvis** played in his 700th Major League game tonight...has started all 58 games this season, the most games started in the majors.
- **Brand Hand** recorded his 17th save of the season and 11th in the month of May...he now has 39 saves as a Padre, tying him for ninth on the Padres all-time saves list with Craig Kimbrel.
- **Phil Hughes** made his Padres debut.

MIAMI NOTES

- **Wei-Yin Chen** drove in two runs on a RBI-single in the second inning, marking his first career RBI...the last Marlins starting pitcher to drive in two-or-more runs in a game was Vance Worley, who had two RBI on August 13, 2017 vs. COL.
- **Odrisamer Despaigne's** 4.1 innings of relief marked the second-longest relief outing of his career...he worked a career-high 4.2 innings in his first Major League relief appearance for SD on April 9, 2015 vs. SF.
- **Derek Dietrich** went 3-for-4 tonight with a home run...recorded his third three-hit game of the season (last: May 11 vs. ATL)...has a hit in his last six games vs. SD (.409, 9-for-22).
- **Brian Anderson** logged his team-leading 17th multi-hit game of the season...is tied with NYY's Miguel Andujar for the most multi-hit games among Major League rookies.
