TONIGHT'S GAME: The Giants are trying to bounce back after being swept in a four-game set in Philadelphia with game one of this three game series in Pittsburgh tonight...San Francisco is 3-4 over the first seven games of their current 10-game road trip to Atlanta (3-0), Philadelphia (0-4) and Pittsburgh.

INSIDE THE SERIES: San Francisco has won eight of their last 12 contests against the Pirates, including each of their last six contests at PNC Park...prior to the current streak, the last time the Giants won at least six in a row in Pittsburgh was in 1953 (also six straight) (*Stats, LLC*).

LOTS OF STRIKEOUTS: The Giants struck out 55 times over their four-game series in Philadelphia, which is the most they have struck out in a 4-game set dating back to 1913...San Francisco's 363 strikeouts overall this season are tied for the second-most in the National League.

ON THE MOUND: LHP Andrew Suarez earned his first Major League win in his last start on Sunday, May 6 at Atlanta in SF's 4-3 victory...he allowed one unearned run on seven hits in 5.1 innings of work...over his first three career starts he's compiled 18 strikeouts and two walks...only three other active pitchers have started their careers with numbers so impressive; Johnny Cueto, Masahiro Tanaka and Joe Ross (*Stats, LLC*)...he'll oppose Pirates right-hander Jameson Taillon, who allowed 10 runs (nine earned) in his last start against the Giants on July 25, 2017.

WELCOME BACK: Former Pirate, OF Andrew McCutchen, returns to Pittsburgh for the first time since being traded on January 15...he is just six hits away from reaching the 1,500 career hit milestone and has reached base safely in each of his last 20 games (19 hits, 17 walks).

DOUBLE THE FUN: IF Evan Longoria is tied for third in the National League with 12 doubles...19 of his 32 hits this season have gone for extra-bases (12 doubles, seven home runs).

JUST SCORE FOUR: San Francisco is 17-3 this season when scoring at least four runs in a game, compared to a 2-16 record when scoring fewer than four.

PITCHING STRUGGLES: Giants' pitchers have struggled over their last four contests, allowing 32 runs (31 earned) in 32.0 innings (8.72 ERA)...opponents are hitting .304 off them with nine homers and 17 walks during the four game span.

TOO MANY MISCUES: The Giants have committed 14 errors in their past eight games...San Francisco's 31 errors overall this season rank as the second most in the Majors behind the Texas Rangers (35).

WITH THE GLOVES: The Giants have turned 13 double plays over their past nine games...their 43 double plays this season are the most in the Majors.

This Date in Giants History: May 11, 1936

Mel Ott starred in a 13-12 slugfest in Philadelphia...the right fielder drove in eight runs with a single, double, and a three-run homer with two men out in the 9th that pulled out the game.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#59 LHP Andrew Suárez
6-0, 187, 25 years old (September 11, 1992)
1-1 Record, 3.06 ERA

- The 25-year-old left-hander is slated to make his fourth career Major League start...has gone 1-1 with a 3.06 ERA (6er, 17.2ip) in three outings, with the Giants going 1-2 in those games.
- Earned his first Major League win in his last start on Sunday, May 6 at Atlanta in SF's 4-3 victory...allowed one unearned run on seven hits in 5.1 innings.
- Has been recalled twice from triple-A Sacramento, first on April 11 to make a spot start and again on May 1 as the Giants needed an extra starter due to a doubleheader April 28...with **RHP Johnny Cueto** being placed on the 10-day disabled list May 1, Suárez slid into the Giants' starting rotation.
- Has registered 18 strikeouts while allowing just two walks in 17.2 innings in his big league career.
- Has held left-handed batters to a .130 clip (3-for-23) with eight Ks.
- Opponents are hitting just .120 (3-for-25) off his slider this year and .222 (4-for-18) off his fastball.
- Made his Major League debut April 11 against the Diamondbacks...he became the sixth pitcher to make his MLB debut in a start for the Giants over the last 10 seasons (2009-18), which ranks as the fewest among all NL clubs.
- Is 2-0 with a 1.16 ERA (3er, 23.1ip) in four starts this season at the minor league level between Class A Advanced San Jose and triple-A Sacramento...allowed one run or fewer in all four outings.
- Went 4-4 with a 2.96 ERA (22er in 67.0ip) for double-A Richmond before being reassigned to triple-A Sacramento in June of last season...made 13 starts for the River Cats, collecting 80 strikeouts while only walking 27 over the final months of the season.
- Was named an Organizational All-Star by MiLB.com following the 2017 season.
- Entered the season with a career 21-18 minor league record with a 3.24 ERA (122er, 338.2ip) in three seasons.
- Was drafted by San Francisco in the second round of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft...entered the season as the 10th-best prospect in the Giants' organization according to MLB.com.
- Attended the University of Miami and was named a third-team All-ACC selection in 2013.
