**GETTING STARTED:** Tonight's first pitch was at 7:08 p.m....Game-time temperature was 79 degrees.

**TONIGHT'S ATTENDANCE:** was 11,714....The 69-date (71 game) season total is 1,405,556...Average attendance is 20,370.

## ORIOLES NOTES

**VS. OAKLAND:** The Orioles defeated the Athletics in the final game of the three-game series by a score of 5-3...Finish the season 1-5 against the Athletics...Are now 25-46 at home....**RHP Mychal Givens** recorded his seventh save of the season after tossing 1.2 innings with one walk and two strikeouts.

**PITCHER NOTES: RHP Dylan Bundy** earned the win after allowing two runs on six hits, one home run, with eight strikeouts over 6.0 innings of work...Was his first win since July 29 vs. Tampa Bay...Was his longest outing, and fewest runs allowed since tossing 6.0 innings and allowing two runs (one earned) on August 4 at Texas...Fifth outing without walking a batter...Struck out at least eight batters for the eighth time this season...The home run allowed to Stephen Piscotty was the 38<sup>th</sup> he's surrendered this season; leads all Major League pitchers in home runs allowed...Threw 90 pitches, 64 strikes.

**WELCOME TO BALTIMORE: 2B Breyvic Valera** recorded an RBI-single in the fourth inning, his second career hit at Oriole Park, and his first RBI at the home ballpark...In seven games played since joining the Orioles, he is batting .263 (5-for-19).

**RIGHT AT HOME: CF Cedric Mullins** singled and scored the Orioles first run of the game...Has recorded a hit in 17 of 28 games (in which he has had an at-bat) for the Orioles...Is batting .292 (14-for-48) in games at Oriole Park.

**BOOM BOOM: 1B Trey Mancini** has hit safely in two-straight games, and is averaging .337 (28-for-83) in 22 home games since the All-Star break...Led-off the fourth inning with a single; is batting .327 (51-for-156) when leading off an inning.

**KEEPING IT GOING: SS Jonathan Villar** has hit safely in 10 of his last 11 games; he is batting .333 (14-for-42) with three home runs, six runs scored, and eight RBI during this stretch...With a single in the fifth inning, **RF Joey Rickard** has hit safely in eight of 10 games since being recalled on August 31; is averaging .316 (12-for-38) during this span...Singled in the fifth and seventh innings for his 11<sup>th</sup> multi-hit game of the season.

**ODDS & ENDS: DH Tim Beckham** got the Orioles on the board first with a two-RBI single in the first inning...Averaging .359 (14-for-39) with three RBI in the first frame...Also singled in the eighth inning for his 18<sup>th</sup> multi-hit game...**LF John Andreoli** notched an RBI-single in the fourth inning, his second RBI with the Orioles...Has hit safely in three of four games against the AL West this season; averaging .333 (3-for-9) against the division...**3B Jace Peterson** put the O's up 5-3 in the eighth inning with a RBI-double; entered the game at third base in the eighth inning.

## ATHLETICS NOTES

**VS. BALTIMORE:** The A's fell to the Orioles in the final game of the three-game series by a score of 5-3...Finish the season 5-1 against Baltimore...Are now 43-29 on the road...Drop to 20-9 against the AL East...Snapped their season-high-tying six-game winning streak.

**PITCHER NOTES: LHP Brett Anderson** suffered the loss after allowing four runs on seven hits with one walk and two strikeouts over 3.1 innings of work...Fourth start lasting 3.1 innings-or-less, and the second consecutive time doing so...Has walked one batter-or-fewer in each of his last nine starts...Has allowed at least four runs in five starts...Second-straight start allowing seven hits, the sixth time this season...Did not surrender a home run for his fourth straight start, and the eighth time this season...Threw 59 pitches, 43 strikes.

**MAJOR LEAGUE BEST: RF Stephen Piscotty** extended his hitting streak to a career-high 14 games; is hitting .373 (19-for-51) during this stretch; is the longest active streak in the majors, and the longest by any A's player this season...Slugged his 24<sup>th</sup> home run of the season in the second inning; 16 of his 24 home runs have come on the road.

**MULTIPLES: LF Nick Martini** collected his 10<sup>th</sup> multi-hit game of the season, his third with three hits, after hitting an automatic double to lead off the third inning, an RBI-single in the fifth, and a single in the seventh...Batting .305 (32-for-105) against right-handed pitchers, and .317 (20-for-63) on the road.

**TWO BAGS: SS Marcus Semien** recorded his 33<sup>rd</sup> double of the season, the fourth-most among A's batters...Oakland entered play today ranked second in the majors in doubles (now with 300)...Semien is averaging .287 (33-for-115) against AL East opponents this season.

**KHRIS WITH A K: DH Khris Davis** extended his current hitting streak to seven games, hitting .346 (9-for-26) in this stretch...In 26 games against the AL East, he is batting .306 (30-for-98).

**ODDS & ENDS: 3B Matt Chapman** is batting .325 (66-for-203) in 50 games since the All-Star break; entered play ranked tied for second in hits since the break...Hitting .316 (75-for-237) in 62 road games; entered play ranked eighth in the AL in road hitting.
