TONIGHT'S GAME: The Giants open a three-game series in Colorado...San Francisco is coming off a three game sweep of the Diamondbacks...with a win tonight the Giants could secure their first winning road trip since posting a 4-2 record from June 30-July 6, 2017 at Pittsburgh (3-0) and Detroit (1-2).

WINNING WAYS: San Francisco has won each of their last four series and 10 of their last 12 contests including seven of their last eight games.

INSIDE THE SERIES: Dating back to 2017, the Giants have won 11 of their last 18 games versus Colorado, however they have dropped 12 of their last 14 games here at Coors Field...this season the Giants and Rockies have been evenly matched winning five games apiece.

ON THE MOUND: LHP Madison Bumgarner enters tonight's game having tossed 16.0-consecutive scoreless innings, the third longest active scoreless inning streak in the National League...has posted a 1.67 ERA (6er, 32.1ip) and a .203 opponents average over his last five starts against the Rockies...he'll opposed LHP Kyle Freeland, who threw 7.0-scoreless innings against the Giants last Wednesday.

GIANTS PITCHING: Since June 1, San Francisco pitchers have posted a 2.81 ERA (83er, 265.2ip), which ranks as the second lowest ERA in the Majors during that stretch behind the New York Yankees...SF has recorded one shutout in each of their last three series, bringing their season total to 10, which is tied for the MLB lead with the Cubs (Stats, LLC).

NOTABLE MATCHUPS: Several Giants have had success against tonight's opposing starting pitcher, Kyle Freeland...**IF Joe Panik** is hitting .467 (7-for-15), **OF Gorkys Hernandez** is 7-for-18 (.389) with one home run and **C Nick Hundley** is hitting .357 (5-for-14) with two doubles and one home run.

AT COORS FIELD: **IF Joe Panik** has 12 hits in his last 15 at-bats and is hitting .568 (25-for-44) over his last 10 games at Coors Field...**C Buster Posey**, owns the third-highest batting average here at Coors Field among active players, hitting .379 (91-for-240) with 13 home runs and 48 RBI in 64 games...he's hit safely in each of his last 16 games here.

LOAD 'EM UP: The Giants are hitting .328 (22-for-67) with eight doubles, nine walks and 60 RBI with the bases loaded, which ranks as the highest average in the National League and second-highest figure in the Majors behind Cleveland (.379).

ROAD WOES: Despite posting a 8-6 record in their last 14 road games and winning each of their last four contests away from AT&T Park, the Giants .422 (19-26) road winning percentage still ranks as the second-lowest figure in the National League behind Miami (17-26, .395).

CLOSE CALLS: 17 of the Giants last 25 games have been decided by two runs or fewer with five of San Francisco's last seven contests having been decided by one-run...the Giants have posted a 14-13 record in one-run games and a 23-21 record in one or two run games this season.

ON THE MEND: RHP Jeff Samardzija (right shoulder tightness) is scheduled to make his fourth rehab appearance tonight for Sacramento...RHP Johnny Cueto (right elbow sprain) will throw a bullpen tonight.

This Date in Giants History: July 2, 1933

The Giants won an epic doubleheader from the Cardinals at the Polo Grounds...**Carl Hubbell** pitched 18-scoreless innings to win the first game 1-0...in the second game, **Roy Parmelee**, pitching in semidarkness and a steady drizzle, shutout the Cards and the Giants won 1-0 on a fourth-inning home run by **Johnny Vergez**.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#40 LHP Madison Bumgarner
6-4, 243, 28 years old (August 1, 1989)
1-2 Record, 2.51 ERA

- The four-time All-Star (2013-16) takes the hill today for his sixth start of the 2018 season...the Giants are 2-3 in his outings this year, winning his last two trips to the mound.
- Is coming off back-to-back scoreless starts of 7.0+ innings for the first time in his career...logged 8.0-scoreless innings in his start June 21 vs. San Diego and limited the Rockies to just two hits in 7.0-scoreless frames in his last outing on Wednesday at AT&T Park, a 1-0 Giants victory.
- Enters today's outing having tossed 16.0-consecutive scoreless innings.
- Recorded his 1,500th career strikeout in his last start, striking out DJ LeMahieu to lead off the game... he became the fourth-fastest left-hander to reach that total in the live-ball era, having done it in his 239th game...only Randy Johnson (206), Clayton Kershaw (218) and David Price (236) did it faster (*Stats, LLC*).
- Went 0-2 with a 4.67 ERA (9er, 17.1ip), three homers allowed and a .279 opponents average against in his first three starts this year...however, in his last two outings, he's 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0er, 15.0ip), 16 strikeouts and a .100 average against.
- Has received a total of just nine runs of support in his five starts this season.
- Is 5-5 with a 4.00 ERA in 13 starts here at Coors Field...has not pitched in this facility since 2016... has posted a record of 4-1 with a 1.96 ERA (12er, 55.0ip) in his past eight starts versus the Rockies.
- Returned from his rehab assignment and was reinstated from the 60-day DL June 5...made just two rehab starts.
- Missed the Giants' first 60 games with a broken pinkie finger on his left hand, an injury he suffered on his final start in spring training at Scottsdale, Arizona on March 23 after Royals' hitter Whit Merrifield hit a line-drive comebacker off of his left hand.
- Had never been on the disabled list in his first eight Major League seasons but has now twice been placed on the DL the last two years, missing a total of 135 games.
- SF is 59-76 (.437) with Bumgarner on the DL.
- Missed three months last year (mid-April, May, June, mid-July) - 85 days, 75 games) with a left shoulder AC sprain...sustained the injury during a dirt bike accident on the team's off day in Denver, CO on April 20.
- Has 32 double-digit strikeout games, the second-most in Giants franchise history behind **Tim Lincecum** (36).

HITTING NOTES: Is hitless in 12 at-bats this season with seven strikeouts...batted .206 with three homers and five RBI last season...has hit 17 homers in his 10-year career, the most of any active player and the most in Giants franchise history...is the first pitcher to total at least three homers in four consecutive seasons since Earl Wilson achieved the feat in five-straight seasons between 1964 and 1968.

TOMORROW'S STARTER: RHP CHRIS STRATTON
2018: 8-5, 4.45 ERA / Career: 13-9, 4.11 ERA
NOTES: The 27-year-old right-hander is making his 18th start of the season...the Giants are 11-6 in his outings this year, going 6-3 at home and 5-3 on the road...is facing the Rockies for the second time in less than a week as he faced them last Thursday at AT&T Park in the Giants' 9-8 loss...lasted just 4.0 innings while allowing five runs on eight hits...threw just 64 pitches...has actually pitched better away from AT&T Park this year, posting a 4-3 record with a 3.38 ERA in eight starts...has a 3.00 ERA (6er, 18.0ip) in his past three road outings...has an opponents average against of .195 on the road compared to .333 at home.
