# CLEVELAND INDIANS

### TRIBE HEADLINES

» **TREVOR BAUER** has gone 2-0 with a 0.71 ERA (1ER/12.2IP) in two Interleague starts this season (2nd-lowest in A.L., min. 10.0IP), both of which came against Chicago-NL (April 25 & May 22)...his 156 first-half strikeouts are currently 16th in club history.

» Last night, **MIKE CLEVINGER** became the Tribe's fourth pitcher with 100 first-half strikeouts, making Cleveland just the fifth team in MLB history with four such pitchers, per *STATS LLC* (also HOU - 2018, BOS - 2018, WSH - 2016, CLE - 2015).

» **YONDER ALONSO** sits one RBI away from becoming the fifth Tribe batter with 50 RBI this season...the Indians have not had five players reach 50 RBI before the All-Star break since 1999.

### YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians scored four runs in the bottom of the 9th inning and brought the tying run to the plate, but ultimately fell 7-5 in the opener of this three-game set vs. Cincinnati.

» **YONDER ALONSO** (1-3) plated the Tribe's first run with a 4th-inning solo homer, his 13th longball of the season...**JASON KIPNIS** went 2-for-4 with a double and a two-run homer, his 8th of the year...**MICHAEL BRANTLEY** and **YAN GOMES** were each 2-for-4 with a double, and six of the Tribe's 10 hits went for extra bases.

» **MIKE CLEVINGER** took the loss, allowing five runs on seven hits over 6.0+ innings of work...**Clevinger matched a career-high with 11 strikeouts, done previously on June 14, 2018 at Chicago-AL.**

### BATTLE OF OHIO

» The Indians and Reds are in the first of their two series this season as the clubs square off for the Ohio Cup...following this three-game set at Progressive Field, the Tribe will travel to Great American Ball Park from August 13-15.

» The two teams were evenly matched in the 2017 season series, as both teams went 2-2 and scored 18 runs each...the Tribe owns an 8-5-7 all-time record in season series play vs. Cincinnati.

» **Dating back to May 23, 2010, Cleveland has won 16 of its last 19 home games vs. Cincinnati, a span in which the Tribe is averaging 6.4 runs per game (121 runs, 19 games).**

### KINGS OF K

» **MIKE CLEVINGER's** 11-strikeout performance last night was the 18th outing with double-digit punchouts by a Tribe starter this season, 2nd-most in MLB (Houston - 19).

» The outing also gave Clevinger 110 strikeouts on the season, making him the fourth Tribe pitcher this season to reach 100 (**TREVOR BAUER** - 156, **COREY KLUBER** - 123, **CARLOS CARRASCO** - 103)...**per STATS LLC, the Indians are one of three teams this season (along with Houston and Boston) boasting four 100-strikeouts pitchers before the All-Star break, and one of just five teams to do so in MLB history...**the only other teams to achieve the feat prior to the 2018 season were the 2016 Nationals and the 2015 Indians (**Klubers, Bauer, Carrasco, DANNY SALAZAR**).

### HOME COOKING

» Cleveland has gone 28-16 at Progressive Field this season, good for a .651 winning percentage that ranks 4th in the A.L. (7th in MLB)...**since the 2017 All-Star Break, Cleveland's 56-24 (.700) home record is the best in MLB.**

» The Indians have won 15 of their last 20 home games, including eight of their last 11...**Cleveland is outscoring opponents 72-32 across their last 11 home games.**

» **Cleveland leads Major League Baseball with 259 runs scored at home, a rate of 5.89 runs per game (2nd-most in MLB).**...the Indians also lead the Majors with 426 hits at home, while they also rank 2nd with a .280 home batting average (Boston - .286), 3rd with 167 extra-base hits and T4th with 64 home runs.

### TODAY'S TRANSACTION

» **JOSH TOMLIN** has been placed on the 10-day Disabled List with a right hamstring strain...**ADAM PLUTKO** has been recalled from Triple-A Columbus to begin his fourth stint in 2018 with the Indians.

» Plutko sits 4-2 with a 4.66 ERA (19ER/36.2IP) in six starts (seven appearances) with Cleveland this season, and 5-3 with a 1.94 ERA (14ER/65.0IP) in 10 starts for the Clippers...he fanned a season-high 11 batters in his most recent start on July 6 at Indianapolis.

» **Lynchburg (High-A): 41-44 (2nd Half: 12-6)** » **7/9: W, 6-3 vs. Potomac** » **Today: 6:30 vs. Potomac**  
Mitch Longo (4-4) had a solo homer & a career-high four RBI...Zach Plesac tossed a quality start (6.2IP, 4H, 2R/ER).

» **Lake County (A): 38-51 (2nd Half: 8-10)** » **7/9: W, 10-6 vs. West Michigan** » **Today: OFF**  
Nolan Jones went 3-for-3 with a solo homer and three RBI...Joshua Rolette (2-4) belted a three-run homer.

» **MV Scrappers (Short-A): 16-7, 1st (+2.0G)** » **7/9: W, 6-3 vs. Williamsport** » **Today: OFF**  
Hosea Nelson (2-4) hit a go-ahead three-run homer in the 6th inning...Mitch Reeves (2-4) doubled and drove in a run.

### ON THE BAUER PLAY

» All-Star **TREVOR BAUER** is starting on extended five days' rest after making his last start on July 4 at Kansas City...**earned his eighth win of 2018 after holding the Royals to two runs on seven hits over 7.2 innings of work (1BB, 8K) in the Tribe's 3-2 victory.**

» Tonight marks Bauer's third Interleague start of the season, following a pair of starts against the Chicago Cubs on April 25 and May 22...**went 2-0 with a 0.71 ERA (1ER/12.2IP) in those outings, and owns a lifetime Interleague record of 9-5 with a 2.81 ERA (42ER/134.1IP) in 22 starts (23 appearances).**

» Has made four career starts against Cincinnati, posting a mark of 1-2 with a 4.95 ERA (11ER/20.0IP).

» **Bauer enters play tonight ranked 3rd in the American League with 156 strikeouts, currently T6th-most with Sam McDowell (156 in 1969) in franchise history by a Tribe pitcher before the All-Star break...**Bauer trails only **Bob Feller** (190 in 1946), three additional seasons by **McDowell** (183 in 1970, 168 in 1968, 164 in 1965) and **Luis Tiant** (157 in 1968).

» In eight starts at Progressive Field this season, Bauer has gone 4-1 with a 2.52 ERA (15ER/53.2IP), good for the 8th-lowest home ERA in the American League...he also currently ranks 5th in the A.L. with his 2.45 overall ERA and T6th with 121.1 innings pitched.

### SMOOTH SAILING

» **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** continued his strong play at home last night, going 2-for-4 with an RBI-double.

» The now three-time All-Star is batting .352 (58-165) at Progressive Field this season, marking the 5th-highest home batting average in the American League...35 of his 50 RBI this season have come at home, 4th-most in the A.L.

» Brantley has reached safely in 28 of his last 29 home games, including a career-long 27-game home on-base streak from May 1 - July 7...he is batting .355 (44-124) in that span with five homers, 15 doubles, 29 RBI and 24 runs scored.

### YONDER APPRECIATED

» **YONDER ALONSO** belted his 13th longball of the season with a 4th-inning solo homer in last night's ballgame.

» Despite hitting just two home runs over his past 30 games, Alonso is batting .287 (33-115) in that same span with nine doubles, 19 RBI and 14 runs scored.

» Alonso enters play today with 49 RBI, one shy of becoming the 5th Indians player with 50-or-more RBI this season (**EDWIN ENCARNACION** - 62, **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** - 59, **FRANCISCO LINDOR** - 57, **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** - 50)...Cleveland is already the only team in MLB boasting four players with 50-or-more RBI, and they could become the first Indians team to have five such players before the All-Star break since the 1999 club (**Roberto Alomar, David Justice, Manny Ramírez, Richie Sexson & Jim Thome**)...the last team in MLB to have five 50-RBI players in the first half was Baltimore in 2016 (**Davis, Jones, Machado, Schoop, Trumbo**).

### KIP IT ROLLING

» **JASON KIPNIS** posted his 17th multi-hit game of 2018 last night, going 2-for-4 with a double and a two-run homer.

» The 9th-inning longball marked Kipnis's eighth of the season, seven of which have come over his past 34 games...his seven homers since May 26 rank T2nd with HOU's **José Altuve** among A.L. second basemen in that span (LAA's **Ian Kinsler** has 9).

» Kipnis also extended his home on-base streak to 23 games, dating back to May 3...marks the 3rd-longest active streak in MLB, trailing BOS's **J.D. Martínez** (33G) and TEX's **Shin-Soo Choo** (25G)...Kipnis is batting .300 (24-80) across the streak at Progressive Field with six homers, four doubles, 14 RBI and 15 runs scored...the Indians are 16-7 at home since the streak began.

### SCORING EARLY AND LATE

» The Tribe's 9th-inning rally last night was their third time scoring at least four runs in the bottom of the 9th (five runs on May 27 vs. Houston, four runs on May 1 vs. Texas)...Cleveland is the only MLB team that has scored four-or-more runs in the 9th inning at least three times (St. Louis and Atlanta have both done so twice).

» The Indians have also excelled in the 1st inning this season, as their 65 1st-inning runs are the most in the A.L. (T2nd in MLB).

### THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

**2014:** Tribe catcher **Roberto Pérez** makes his Major League debut in Cleveland's 9-3 win vs. the New York Yankees...during the Indians' five-run 8th inning, Pérez hit a two-run homer off Yankee reliever Jim Miller, becoming just the 10th player in franchise history to homer in his first career game...the list of other Cleveland players to do so includes Hall of Famer **Earl Averill** (1929), as well as fellow catchers **Josh Bard** (2002) and **Jim Hegan** (1941).

**TONIGHT'S START**

» The 27-year-old right-hander is due to make his 19th start of the season in the middle tilt of this three-game set vs. the Cincinnati Reds...will mark his 151st career appearance and 142nd start.  
 » Bauer will face the Reds for the fifth time in his career...last faced Cincinnati on May 24, 2017 at Progressive Field (ND, 5.1IP, 4H, 2R/ER, 1HR, 2BB, 6K).  
 » Will be pitching tonight on extended five days' rest after his last outing at Kansas City on July 4...held the Royals to two runs across 7.2 innings (1BB, 8K).  
 » **Per STATS, LLC, Bauer's start marked his sixth consecutive quality start with eight-or-more strikeouts and no homers allowed, matching Hideo Nomo, Pedro Martinez (2x), Justin Verlander, R.A. Dickey and Chris Sale for the longest such streak in the live ball era (1920-).**  
 » He has also struck out eight-or-more batters in each of his last eight starts, dating back to May 27...**streak marks a career-long run for Bauer and the longest such run by an Indians pitcher since COREY KLUBER's 14-start streak from June 1-Aug. 1, 2017.**  
 » **Bauer's 156 first-half strikeouts are tied with Sam McDowell (156 in 1969) for the 6th-most by an Indians pitcher in the first half of the season...also marks the most first-half punchouts by a Tribe hurler since McDowell had 183 in 1970.**  
 » Entering tonight's game, Bauer ranks among the American League pitching leaders in strikeouts (156, 3rd), opponent slugging percentage (.311, 3rd), night ERA (2.39, 4th), ERA (2.45, 5th), strikeouts-per-9.0IP (11.6, 5th) and innings pitched (121.1, 76th).

**VS. CINCINNATI | INTERLEAGUE PLAY**

» Bauer is due to face the Reds for the fifth time in his career, owning a 1-2 record and 4.95 ERA (11ER/20.0IP) in his four prior outings (all starts)...three of his four career starts vs. Cincinnati have come with Cleveland and one has come with Arizona.  
 » Last faced Cincinnati on May 24, 2017 at Progressive Field...did not factor into the decision in the Tribe's 4-3 loss, allowing just two runs on four hits (one home run), with two walks and six strikeouts in 5.1 innings.  
 » Tonight will mark Bauer's third Interleague start of the season...both of his prior outings have come against Chicago-NL, one at home and one on the road...has compiled a 2-0 record and 0.71 ERA (1ER/12.2IP) in those two starts.  
 » Bauer's 0.71 ERA in Interleague play is 2nd-lowest among American League pitchers and 4th-lowest in MLB (min. 10.0IP).  
 » Owns a career 9-5 record and 2.81 ERA (42ER/134.1IP) in 23 appearances (22 starts) vs. Interleague opponents (all with Cleveland)...this includes a 4-2 record and 2.14 ERA (19ER/80.0IP) when facing an Interleague opponent at home.

**AT PROGRESSIVE FIELD**

» Bauer is due to make his ninth home start of the season tonight...has compiled a 4-1 record and 2.52 ERA (15ER/53.2IP) at Progressive Field this season...**entering tonight ranks 8th in the A.L. in home ERA.**  
 » Earned the win in his last home start on June 23 vs. Detroit, striking out 11 batters and allowing one run on five hits (2BB) over 6.1 innings.  
 » In his career is 31-21 with a 4.22 ERA (219ER/467.0IP) in 79 outings (75 starts) at home, across his time with both Cleveland and Arizona...that includes a 30-20 career record and 4.19 ERA (213ER/457.2IP) in 77 games (73 starts) at Progressive Field.

**LAST TIME OUT & 2018 RECAP**

» Bauer finished the month of June with a 2.18 ERA (10ER/41.1IP), **marking his 3rd-lowest ERA in a single month in his career (min. 4GS), behind March/April 2015 (1.80 ERA) and June 2016 (2.01 ERA)...****he also led MLB with 62 strikeouts in June.**  
 » **He has struck out 10-or-more batters in a seven starts this season, which is tied with Seattle's James Paxton for the 3rd-most such starts in MLB, behind Washington's Max Scherzer (10) and Boston's Chris Sale (8).**  
 » Bauer has thrown 100-or-more pitches in each of his 18 starts so far this season, which is the longest such streak of his career and the longest active run in MLB...**streak is also the longest streak of consecutive starts with 100-plus pitches by an Indians pitcher since 1988, the most recent year that Baseball Reference has accurate pitch count data available...**streak marks the longest such run in MLB since Tampa Bay's **Chris Archer** had a 24-game run from August 12, 2016 - June 16, 2017.  
 » Recorded a streak of 10-or-more strikeouts in four consecutive starts from May 27 to June 13...streak the longest such run in MLB this season...**marked just the third pitcher in Indians franchise history to record a streak of four-or-more starts with 10-or-more strikeouts, joining teammate COREY KLUBER (two streaks of five starts in 2017) and Hall-of-Famer Bob Feller (one streak of four starts from 1938-39).**

**2017 REGULAR SEASON HIGHLIGHTS & POSTSEASON RECAP**

» Had a career year in the Indians rotation last year, posting his lowest full-season ERA (4.19) while also recording career highs in wins (17), strikeouts (196), innings pitched (176.1) and strikeouts-per-9.0 innings (10.0)...also struck out six-or-more batters in 22 of his 31 starts, good for 6th in the American League...made one relief appearance, in the 8th inning of the second game of a DH on August 17 at Minnesota (0.2IP, 1H, 1K).  
 » **Struck out a career-high 14 batters in 7.0 innings on May 30 vs. Oakland, equaling the highest single-game strikeout total by a Tribe starter last season.**  
 » Dominated after the All-Star Break, going 10-2 with a 3.01 ERA (28ER/83.2IP) in his final 15 appearances (14 starts) of the season...his 10 second-half wins ranked T2nd in the A.L. and his 3.01 ERA ranked T5th among A.L. starters (min. 80.0IP).  
 » **Won a career-best nine consecutive decisions from July 21 to September 10, spanning 11 starts...**posted a 2.51 ERA (18ER/64.2IP) in that span...streak marked the longest by an Indians pitcher last season.  
 » **POSTSEASON RECAP:** Started Games 1 & 4 of the 2017 ALDS against New York-AL...won the first game at home with 6.2 shutout innings (2H, 1BB, 8K)...took the loss in Game 4 in NYC, allowing four unearned runs over 1.2 innings (4H, 2BB/1BB, 3K).

**CAREER SNAPSHOT**

» Right-hander is in his sixth season with the Indians organization after being acquired from the Arizona Diamondbacks on December 11, 2012, along with RHP Matt Albers, RHP Bryan Shaw (from Arizona) & Drew Stubbs (from Cincinnati), in a 3-team trade...at time of trade, was ranked as Arizona's No. 1 prospect by **Baseball America** and had just earned Dbacks Minor League Pitcher of the Year honors.  
 » Made his Major League debut with Arizona on June 28, 2012, becoming the first player from the 2011 Draft Class to reach the Majors...did not factor into the decision after allowing two runs on five hits in 4.0 innings of work.  
 » **In 2017, recorded his best Major League season to date in the Tribe rotation, posting career-highs in wins (17), strikeouts (196) and innings pitched (176.1), while recording his lowest full-season ERA (4.19).**  
 » The 2018 season marks his eighth overall in professional baseball after being selected by Arizona in the first round of the 2011 draft out of UCLA, where he went 38-4 with a 2.36 ERA across three seasons for the Bruins...finished his college career holding a number of school records, including a Pac-10 record with 203 strikeouts in 2011.  
 » The Southern California native graduated from Hart High School in Santa Clarita, the same HS that produced Kevin Millar, James Shields, Bob Walk and Todd Zeile.
