MOVING ON: On Tuesday vs. SF in San Diego, the Padres dropped their second-consecutive extra-inning game to the San Francisco Giants, 3-2...in doing so, the Friars suffered their second-straight sweep...SD and Miami are the only teams to have not swept another club this year...Tuesday, starter **Clayton Richard** worked 5.0 innings and allowed two runs (earned) on five hits, and **Eric Hosmer** extended his hitting streak to eight straight games since July 23 (.345).

HURLIN' ERLIN: Starter **Robbie Erlin** makes his return to Wrigley Field, the site of his Major League debut on April 30, 2013...as a relief pitcher this season (27 appearances and 52.2 ip), Erlin has a 2.05 ERA, a .210 opponent clip, a .538 opponent OPS, an 11.00 so/bb ratio and a 0.80 WHIP...as a starter this year (two appearances, 7.0 ip), he owns a 14.14 ERA, a .412 opponent average, a 1.297 opponent OPS, a 3.00 so/bb ratio and a 2.29 WHIP.

HIS NAME IS ERLIN: **Robbie Erlin** has allowed just one run in his seven July relief appearances and 12.0 IP (0.75 ERA)...struck out 10 and walked just one while limiting opposing hitters to a .158 average.

SNAP THAT STREAK: The Padres have now lost seven consecutive games since July 24, the longest losing streak the club has sustained this season...the last time the Friars lost seven-straight games was when they dropped 10 straight from June 29-July 8, 2013...the longest losing streak in club history was 13 games from May 8-21, 1994.

BACK TO THE IVY: Over Padres past 10 games at Wrigley Field (dating back to July 24, 2014), SD starters are 4-2 (.667), having thrown six quality starts with an ERA of 3.54 (21 er, 53.1 ip).

NL CENTRALLY LOCATED: Since the start of the 2017 season, the Friars have a .464 winning percentage vs. the NL West and a .403 percentage against all other opponents...vs. the NL Central, SD pitchers have a 3.92 ERA, a .250 opponent average and 3.16 BB/9.0...against all other opponents in that time, SD arms have a 4.73 ERA, a .260 opponent clip and 3.51 BB/9.0.

RISP AND REWARD: The Padres lead the NL in average with RISP/2 out (.264) and rank second in the majors behind MIN's .268 mark...their clip with RISP/2 out in 2018 is on pace to be the team's highest single season mark in this category since 1995 (.265).

SAYING GOODBYE TO JULY: The Friars are looking forward to August, having accrued a 5-20 record in the month of July (.200 winning percentage)...it was the second-worst month in SD history (behind just August of 1969, when they had a 5-22 record and a .185 winning percentage).

COMING UP CLUTCH: As a pinch-hitter, **Hunter Renfroe** has a .462 average (6-for-13), the third-highest mark in the pinch this season, trailing just SF Alen Hanson's .538 and CIN Jesse Winker's .636...Renfroe's .462 clip as a pinch hitter is on pace to be SD's highest mark (minimum 10 AB) since Gene Kingsale's .545 mark in 2002.

PADRES ON DECK: Wednesday night for San Antonio (AA), RHP **Cal Quantrill** allowed two runs on five hits and a walk with two strikeouts in 5.0 innings...INFs **Owen Miller** and **Olivier Basabe** were voted starters to the Northwest League All-Star team...they will join **Henry Henry**, **Dan Dallas** and **Jordan Guerrero** in the Northwest-Pioneer Leagues All-Star Game on Aug. 7 in Grand Junction, CO.

STARTING PITCHER NOTES

#41 LHP ROBBIE ERLIN (1-3, 3.47)

HURLIN' ERLIN: 27-year-old **Robbie Erlin** is set to make his third start of the season and 28th of his career today to open this four-game set vs. the Cubs...Erlin returns to Wrigley Field, the site of his Major League debut on April 30, 2013

- In his career as a starter, is 8-14 with a 4.95 ERA (81 ER, 147.1 IP)...has been saddled with the loss in each of his last five starts dating back to October 3, 2015.

HOT AS SUMMER: Allowed just one run in his seven July relief appearances and 12.0 IP (0.75 ERA)...struck out 10 and walked just one while limiting opposing hitters to a .158 average.

- Is in the midst of a 9.1-scoreless IP streak since 7/8, having allowed just four hits over the stretch.

GOOD PENMANSHIP: Has worked primarily out of the bullpen this season, making 18 scoreless appearances out of his 27 relief outings and posting a 2.05 ERA (12 ER, 52.2 IP) with 44 strikeouts against four walks.

- His 52.2 IP in relief lead the Padres bullpen...has made five separate long relief outings of at least 3.1 IP, including a career-high scoreless 5.2 IP on 5/28 vs. MIA.

NO WALKS FOR YOU: Has walked just four of the 190 batters he has faced in relief this season.

- His 0.68 walks per nine innings and .021 walks per batters faced ratios lead all Major League relievers, while his 0.80 WHIP ranks tied for fifth.

NICE VS. THE NL CENTRAL: Tossed 2.2 IP of hitless ball on 7/14 vs. CHC in his final appearance prior to the All-Star Break.

- His 2.38 ERA in six appearances vs. the NL Central this season is his lowest mark against any division.
- His 3.38 career ERA against the NL Central is his lowest against any NL division, trailing only his 1.38 mark against the AL Central.

FIRST AND FOREMOST: Has yet to allow a baserunner in the first inning of his previous two starts (4/16 vs. LAD and 5/21 vs. WSH).

- In the second inning, he has surrendered a .615 (8-for-13) average and a .429 (9-for-21) clip in the third frame.

WHEN IT MATTERS MOST: With runners in scoring position and two outs, he is limiting the opposition to a .211 (4-for-19) average

- While pitching in one-run games, opposing hitters are batting .133 (2-for-15) against Erlin.

HISTORICALLY SPEAKING: Erlin has posted a 4.63 ERA (72 ER, 140.0 IP) before the All-Star Break and settled into a 3.42 mark (26 ER, 68.1 IP) post-All-Star Break.

LONGEST TENURED PADRE: Erlin was originally acquired by the Padres along with RHP Joe Wieland from the Texas Ranges in exchange for RHP Mike Adams on July 31, 2011.

- Made his ML debut on April 30, 2013 at CHC...he is the longest tenured pitcher who has appeared for the Padres at the big league level.

SOLID SPRING: Made two appearances (one start) during Spring Training, posting a 2.84 ERA (2 ER, 6.1 IP) while limiting opposing hitters to a .208 average.

LONG ROAD BACK: Began the 2016 season with El Paso (AAA) but did not pitch in a game before being called up by SD on April 8, 2016, making three starts before undergoing season-ending Tommy John surgery on his left elbow on May 17, 2016.

TRIP DOWN MEMORY LANE: Tossed four complete game shutouts his senior season at Scotts Valley (CA) High School, including a 15-strikeout no-hitter.

TOMORROW'S STARTER

READY FOR SOME ROSS: RHP **Tyson Ross** is set to make his 22nd start of the season tomorrow and fourth of his career against the Cubs...will be his first start at Wrigley Field since April 18, 2015.

- Allowed three earned runs or less in nine consecutive outings from 5/12-6/26, posting a 3.04 ERA (18 ER, 53.1 IP).
- Over his five July starts since 7/1, has posted a 8.87 ERA (23 ER, 23.1 IP)
