THE WIN: The Royals snapped a six-game losing streak with their first win since a week ago today at the White Sox, improving to 8-11 since the All-Star break.

- + Recorded their eighth shutout win—their most since 2015—first ever vs. the Cubs and their first in Interleague play since April 19, 2017 vs. San Francisco... it was their second-largest shutout win of the season (10-0 vs. Seattle on April 9) and their largest shutout win vs. a National League team in club history.
- + Avoided what would've been their 14th series sweep of the season—and first to the Cubs since 1997—but fell to 5-27-4 in series play and 35-79 overall.
- + Improved to 4-8 in Interleague play this season with games remaining vs. St. Louis (Friday-Sunday), at Pittsburgh (Sept. 17-19) and at Cincinnati (Sept. 25-26).
- + Have won five of nine home games on the heels of a 1-15 skid here from June 3-July 8, but are on pace for a club-record 57 home losses, six more than 1998.
- + Are 14-24 vs. left-handed starting pitchers, and snapped a 10-game skid vs. southpaw starters with their first win since June 27 at Milwaukee (**Brent Suter**).
- + Extended their streak of errorless innings to 84, including nine full games dating back to an E1 on **Hunter Dozier** in the first frame on July 29 at Yankee Stadium.

HEATH FILLMYER: Earned his first career win, becoming the 312th different player to win in a Royals uniform, and the fourth different Royal to earn his first career win this season, joining: **Brad Keller** (May 11), **Scott Barlow** (May 29) and **Tim Hill** (June 2)...he's the fifth Royal to record his first career win in an Interleague game, joining: **J.P. Howell** (2005 at Arizona), **Zack Greinke** (2004 vs. Montreal), **Kyle Snyder** (2003 at Los Angeles) and **Kris Wilson** (2001 vs. St. Louis).

- + Escaped a first-and-second, one-out jam in the first inning and retired the next 12 batters before issuing a one-out walk in the fifth...he allowed back-to-back singles with one out in the seventh, snapping a stretch of 20 batters faced without a hit...struck out **Willson Contreras** and induced a **Kyle Schwarber** popout to escape the threat after a career-high 7.0 scoreless innings...pitch count by inning: 21 (1st), 17 (2nd), 11 (3rd), 8 (4th), 11 (5th), 13 (6th), 17 (7th), 98 total.
- + He's the first Royal to win with 7.0 shutout innings in an Interleague game since **Jason Vargas** on April 19, 2017 vs. San Francisco and, at 24 years, 84 days old, he's the third-youngest Royal to do so, trailing only: the late **Yordano Ventura** (May 19, 2015 vs. Cincinnati) and **Zack Greinke** (June 8, 2004 vs. Montreal).
- + In four appearances (3 starts) at Kauffman Stadium, he's 1-1 with a 1.71 ERA (4 ER in 21.0 IP) and a .194 opponents' average (14-for-72).

ADALBERTO MONDESI: Hit a three-run HR in the seventh inning off **José Quintana** that traveled 437 feet, the longest by a Royals middle infielder in the Statcast Era (since 2015)...it was his seventh career HR—fourth this season—and just his second at Kauffman Stadium (also: April 12, 2017 vs. Oakland).

- + After batting .143 (3-for-21) through his first seven games with Kansas City, he's batting .284 (27-for-95) with nine XBH and 13 RBI in his last 27.

JORGE BONIFACIO: Had his first multi-hit game since July 14—including a two-run double—snapping a 6-for-58 (.103) skid.

HUNTER DOZIER: Had two hits, extending his on-base streak to a career-high 10 games, in which he's batting .323/.417/.452 (10-for-31).

DREW BUTERA: Put Kansas City on the board with a two-out, two-run double in the second inning, and now has five RBI in five plate appearances with the bases loaded this season...he's batting .278 (10-for-36) in his last 11 games on the heels of a 2-for-30 (.067) skid from May 27-July 6.

CUBS: Dropped to 11-10 since the All-Star break—after going 12-3 in their previous 15 games—but remain unbeaten in six of their last seven series (3-1-3).

- + Suffered their eighth shutout of 2018 and their second-worst shutout loss vs. an American League team, trailing only a 12-0 loss to the Angels on June 19, 2010.
- + Fell to 6-6 all-time at Kauffman Stadium, one of three active American League parks in which they have a .500-or-below record (min. 10 games), joining: Guaranteed Rate Field (26-30) and Progressive Field (6-7)...dropped to 10-5 in Interleague play, snapping a club-record tying seven-game win streak vs. the AL.

JOSÉ QUINTANA: Fell to 3-10 (.231) in 25 starts vs. Kansas City, his most losses vs. any team...he's one of six active pitchers with at least 10 losses vs. the Royals, joining: **CC Sabathia** (21-12), **Bartolo Colón** (16-11), **Chris Sale** (11-10), **Ervin Santana** (7-10) & **Justin Verlander** (23-10)...he's 64-55 (.538) vs. all other teams.

- + Loaded the bases in the second and yielded a two-out, two-run double to **Drew Butera**, the second he's allowed with the bases loaded in his last three starts (also: **Marcell Ozuna** grand slam on July 28), snapping a streak of seven at-bats without a hit allowed with the bases loaded dating back to April 1.
- + After Butera's double, he retired the next 12 until **Hunter Dozier's** two-out single in the sixth...allowed three straight hits to begin the seventh, capped by **Adalberto Mondesi's** three-run HR...exited after 6.1 innings, trailing 5-0...pitch count by inning: 6 (1st), 31 (2nd), 17 (3rd), 14 (4th), 5 (5th), 16 (6th), 9 (7th), 98 total.
- + His 18 decisions (10-8) trail only **Max Scherzer** (20) and **Zack Greinke** (19) among National League pitchers.

ANTHONY RIZZO: On his 29th birthday, singled to leadoff the first inning—the 999th hit of his career—to extend his on-base streak to 13 games, in which he's batting .315/.362/.611 (17-for-54)...he's hit leadoff in 23 of his last 24 games since July 13, a stretch in which he's batting .359/.444/.609 (33-for-92).
