**THE GIANTS:** Return home for a two-game series against Houston and a four-game series against Pittsburgh...SF is coming off their first winning road trip this season and the first since going 4-2 at Pittsburgh and Detroit last year from June 30-July 6...the Astros are on the final leg of a three-city road trip, during which they've gone 4-2 (2-1 at Seattle; 2-1 at Los Angeles-NL).

**INSIDE THE SERIES:** Beginning with the 2009 season, the Giants have gone 13-5 (.722) against Houston here in San Francisco, holding the Astros to two runs or fewer in 12 of the 18 games...this is the first time the Giants will have hosted the Astros since 2015.

**INTERLEAGUE PLAY:** The Giants are 6-9 in interleague play this season...SF is batting .246 against AL opponents while the pitching staff has a 3.65 ERA in those games...the Astros are 8-5 in interleague games with a .224 team batting average... Houston pitching has a 1.63 ERA against NL opponents.

**ON THE MOUND: RHP Dereck Rodriguez** has emerged as one of the top rookie pitchers this season...he has posted a 1.60 ERA (7er, 39.1ip) over his last six start, striking out 29 batters while allowing 10 walks.

**HEATING UP: C Buster Posey** has reached base safely in 13 of his last 22 plate appearances (11 hits, two walks) and is batting .519 (14-for-27) with six runs, three doubles and five RBI over his last seven games.

**LONGORIA VS. THE AL: IF Evan Longoria**, who is hitting .357 (15-for-42) since returning from the DL, has hit AL pitching better than NL pitching.

**SIGH OF RELIEF:** Over the last nine games, San Francisco relievers have combined to allow seven runs (six earned runs) on 24 hits and eight walks with 31 strikeouts in 34.2 innings pitched (1.56 ERA)...overall this season, the Giants' bullpen has posted the third-best ERA in the National League (3.47 ERA).

**SOLID PITCHING:** Beginning June 1, Giants' pitchers have posted a 3.37 ERA, which ranks as the second-best figure in the Majors over that span, behind the Boston Red Sox (3.28 ERA).

**IN NEED OF CLUTCH HITS:** San Francisco is hitting .205 with runners in scoring position and two-outs this season, which ranks as the lowest figure in the National League and the third-lowest in the Majors behind Texas (.190) and Baltimore (.191).

**ON THE FARM: C Joey Bart** was named the Northwest League's Player of the Month for July after batting .333 and leading the Northwest League in home runs (nine), RBI (24), extra-base hits (18), total bases (65), slugging pct. (.747) and OPS (1.126)...he posted a 10-game hitting streak from July 8-19.

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER**

**#57 RHP Dereck Rodriguez**  
**6-1, 215, 26 years old (June 5, 1992)**  
**5-1 Record, 2.59 ERA**

- 26-year-old right-hander is slated to make his 11th Major League start (13th appearance) today...the Giants are 8-2 overall when he takes the hill as a starter.
- Since making his big league debut on May 29, he's been one of the best Giants pitchers and one of the top NL rookies...leads all NL rookies in ERA (2.59), tied for second in wins (5), fourth in OPS (.680) and fourth in opponents batting average against (.226).
- His ERA is the fourth-lowest among all rookie starters in the big leagues behind TB's Ryne Stanek (2.13), TOR's Ryan Borucki (2.30), and BOS' Brian Johnson (2.57) (min. 25.0ip).
- Beginning June 24, his 1.49 ERA (7er, 42.1ip) is the third-best in the Majors behind Boston's Chris Sale (0.23) and Philadelphia's Vince Velasquez (1.35) (min. 25.0ip).
- Last pitched Tuesday afternoon at San Diego and received a no decision in the Giants' 3-2 victory... limited the Padres to one run on three hits in 7.0 innings with a season-high seven strikeouts.
- Is 4-1 with a 2.72 ERA (18er, 59.2ip) in ten starts compared to a 1-0 record with a 1.42 ERA (1er, 6.1ip) in two relief outings.
- His last six starts: 2-0 record, 1.60 ERA (7er, 39.1ip), 29 strikeouts, 10 walks, .188 avg. against.
- Has allowed three runs or fewer in nine of his ten starts this year.
- The last Giants pitcher with an ERA of 2.89 or better in his first eight career MLB starts was **Madison Bumgarner** in 2009-10 (2.77) (Stats, LLC).
- Opponents are just 3-for-their-last-31 (.097) off him with runners in scoring position.
- Prior to being called up by San Francisco May 28 he posted a 4-1 record with a 3.40 ERA (19er, 50.1ip), 53 strikeouts and 11 walks allowed in nine starts for triple-A Sacramento this season.
- Signed a minor league contract with the Giants on November 15, 2017...was invited to Major League camp as a non-roster invitee.
- Is the son of former Major League catcher and Hall of Famer, Ivan Rodriguez...his dad has traveled to watch him pitch against the Nationals in Washington, the Marlins in Miami and against the Cardinals in San Francisco.
- Was drafted in the sixth round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft by the Minnesota Twins...spent his first three professional seasons as an outfielder before converting into a pitcher in 2014.

**TOMORROW'S STARTER: LHP MADISON BUMGARNER**

**2018: 4-4, 2.97 ERA / Career: 108-80, 3.01 ERA**

**NOTES:** The four-time All-Star (2013-16) takes the hill tomorrow for his 12th start of the season...the Giants are 5-6 in his outings this year, going 4-2 here at home...needs just one more win for sole possession of fourth-place on the SF-era wins list (see chart on right)...earned his fourth win of the season in his last outing on Thursday at Arizona in San Francisco's 8-1 victory...Bumgarner put 10 runners on base in just 5.0 innings, but stranded nine of them...he outdueled Zack Greinke, who had been named NL Pitcher of the Month for July earlier in the day...is 4-1 with a 2.45 ERA (10er, 36.2ip) in five career starts against the Houston Astros...has won each of his last four starts against them, going 4-0 with a 1.20 ERA (4er, 30.0ip)...last faced them in 2015, tossing a complete-game, five-hitter with 12 strikeouts on Aug. 11.
