### Shut Down

RHP Dan Winkler stranded two more runners last night after retiring the only batter he faced.

Winkler has not allowed a hit over his last 6.1 innings spanning eight outings, while striking out 10 over this stretch.

For the season, Winkler has limited right-handed hitters to a .036 batting average (1-for-28) with 15 strikeouts.

He has struck out 21 of 53 batters faced (40%), the ninth-best percentage in the majors (minimum 53 batter faced)

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Braves and Giants finish a three-game set today with the third and final game of the Braves' third homestand of the season...This is the third meeting between the clubs this season; the Braves will travel to San Francisco for three games, September 10-12.

*A* The Braves took three of the four games against San Francisco at SunTrust Park last season, the club's first series win against the Giants in Atlanta since the 2013 season...The Giants took this set with last night's 11-2 win, handing the Braves their first home series loss of the season.

*A* LHP Andrew Suarez is set to make his first career road start...Faced San Diego and Arizona at AT&T Park in his first two starts this season.

*A* RHP Mike Soroka is making his SunTrust Park debut today...Tossed 6.0 innings to win his MLB debut on May 1 at Citi Field against New York (NL).

**ROSTER MOVE:** The Braves today selected RHP Luke Jackson from Triple-A Gwinnett and optioned RHP Lucas Sims to the Stripers...This will mark Jackson's second stint with the Braves this season...He was also up from April 15-18.

*A* Jackson, 26, allowed two runs in 1.1 innings over two games with the Braves earlier this season.

*A* The right-hander went 1-1 with a 3.86 ERA (4 ER/9.1 IP) in five games out of the bullpen for the Stripers.

*A* Sims tossed 3.2 innings in relief last night, allowing two runs, earned, and six strikeouts.

**SOROKA:** RHP Mike Soroka tossed 6.0 innings and allowed just one run, earned, with no walks and five strikeouts to win his major league debut, May 1 at New York (NL).

*A* Soroka needed just 80 pitches to complete his 6.0 innings, becoming just the second Braves pitcher to go that long in as few pitches during his major league debut...RHP Ryan Weber went 6.0 innings in 74 pitches on September 8, 2015.

*A* Soroka won his debut at the age of 20 years, 270 days, becoming the youngest Braves pitcher to win his debut since LHP Charlie Vaughan beat Houston in game one of a doubleheader on September 3, 1966.

*A* Soroka beat the NL East-leading New York Mets in his debut...The last time a pitcher as young as Soroka won his major league debut against a team in first place at the time was 1997, when the Dodgers' Denny Reyes beat the San Francisco Giants on July 13...Reyes was 20 years, 85 days at the time, while the Giants were 52-39 and leading the NL West by four games over the Dodgers.

**FIRST INNING:** The Braves led 1-0 after the first inning yesterday and have now scored a MLB-high 35 runs in the first inning this season.

*A* They also have the most hits (52) and doubles (15) and are second with 10 home runs.

*A* The club also has a .361 batting average and a .701 slugging percentage in the first inning, both tops in the majors.

*A* The Braves lost last night despite taking a lead into the second inning and are now 10-4 when ahead after the first.

**NICK MARKAKIS:** OF Nick Markakis extended his hitting streak to a Braves season-high 12 games last night, finishing 3-for-4 with a double.

*A* The outfielder is hitting .479 (23-for-48) with four home runs, eight walks and just one strikeout during his run, which dates to April 23.

*A* Markakis' .354 average and 45 hits are both tops in the N.L.

*A* Markakis has multiple hits in all five games this month, tied for the longest such streak of his career...Also had five-game runs in 2011 and 2008.

**THE OFFENSE:** The Braves offense leads all of baseball in batting average (.274) and on-base percentage (.342), while its 316 are one off the lead...The club leads the N.L. in runs (178), doubles (76), slugging percentage (.451) and extra-base hits (120).

*A* The Braves have struck out 252 times, the fewest times in the N.L.

**VS. LEFTY STARTERS:** The Braves are set to face another left-handed starter today, LHP Andrew Suarez, after losing to LHP Ty Blach last night...The club is also scheduled to see LHP Blake Snell in their next game on Tuesday in Tampa Bay...Prior to this stretch the Braves had faced four left-handed starters all season.

*A* The Braves are hitting .296 against all lefties, the only team in the majors with a mark above .277... They also have the best on-base percentage (.356) and slugging percentage (.496)...The next closest slugging percentage is Pittsburgh at .461.

*A* 2B Ozzie Albies is hitting .484 (15-for-31) against all left-handers, the best mark in baseball among qualifiers...His 1.065 slugging percentage is second to San Diego's Christian Villanueva (1.147)...Albies has fanned just three times against lefties this season.

**DAY GAME:** The Braves are 9-1 in day games this season, having lost their only daylight contest when they blew a 10-2 lead on April 14 in Chicago at Wrigley Field.

*A* The Braves are averaging 7.4 runs (74 total) in their 10 day games this season, while hitting 21 of the club's 39 home runs.

#### Today's Game

**A** Set for the second start of his major league career...Made his major league debut on Tuesday, 5/1 at NYM.

**A** Is the youngest pitcher in the majors at 20 years, 275 days.

**A** Earned the win in his debut after allowing just six hits and one run over 6.0 innings, 5/1 at NYM...He fanned five in Atlanta's 3-2 win.

**A** Won his debut at the age of 20 years, 270 days, becoming the youngest Braves pitcher to win his debut since LHP Charlie Vaughan beat Houston in game one of a doubleheader on September 3, 1966.

**A** Beat the NL East-leading New York Mets...The last time a pitcher as young as Soroka won his major league debut against a team in first place at the time was 1997, when the Dodgers' Denny Reyes beat the San Francisco Giants on 7/13...Reyes was 20 years, 85 days at the time, while the Giants were 52-39 and leading the NL West by four games over the Dodgers.

**A** Made four starts with Triple-A Gwinnett prior to his selection and pitched to a 2-0 record with a 1.99 ERA (5 ER/22.2 IP)...Allowed just 17 hits and five walks while fanning 24.

**A** Tossed the first shutout of his career in his last minor league start, 4/23 at Rochester...Allowed just three hits and three walks over 7.0 scoreless innings in the first game of a doubleheader.

**A** Following his last start, ranked among IL pitching leaders in shutouts (1st, 1), complete games (T1st, 1), GO/AO ratio (3rd, 2.15), wins (T4th, 2), strikeouts (5th, 24), innings (T-5th, 22.2) and WHIP (T-8th, 0.97).

**A** Entered the 2018 season tabbed by Baseball America and MLB.com as Atlanta's No. 3 prospect...MLB.com named him as the No. 27 prospect overall in the minors.

#### 2018 Recap

**A** Beat the New York Mets in his major league debut, 5/1 at Citi Field...Tossed 6.0 innings of one-run ball and allowed six hits with five strikeouts.

**A** Became the eighth Braves pitcher to start against the Mets in his major league debut...The eight starters, including Hall-of-Famer John Smoltz on 7/23/88, have combined to go 5-2 with a 1.95 ERA (11 ER/50.2 IP).

**A** Needed just 80 pitches to complete his 6.0 innings, becoming just the second Braves pitcher to go that long in as few pitches during his major league debut...RHP Ryan Weber went 6.0 innings in 74 pitches on September 8, 2015.

**A** Made his major league debut at the age of 20 years, 270 days...Became the youngest pitcher to make his debut in a start for Atlanta since RH Julio Teheran debuted at 20 years, 100 days on 5/7/11.

**A** Since the Braves moved to Atlanta in 1966, only five starting pitchers have debuted at a younger age than Soroka - LH Charlie Vaughan (18 years, 332 days - 9/3/66), LH Mike McQueen (19 years, 033 days - 10/2/69), LH Steve Avery (20 years, 060 days - 6/13/90), Teheran and RH AJ Santorini (20 years, 114 days - 9/10/68).

**A** Went 2-0 with a 1.99 ERA (5 ER/22.2 IP) in four starts for Triple-A Gwinnett...Opponents batted just .207 (17-for-82).

**A** Tossed the first shutout of his career in his last minor league start, 4/23 at Rochester...Allowed just six total baserunners and fanned four over 7.0 innings in the first game of a doubleheader.

**A** The effort was the second career complete game for Soroka and his first since also going 7.0 innings in a doubleheader on 6/28/16 while with Single-A Rome.

**A** Soroka's shutout was the first of any length in the International League this season.

**A** Allowed season highs in hits (6) and runs (3) over 5.0 innings on 4/17 vs. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre...Left the game trailing 3-0 before Gwinnett scored eight unanswered runs to win 8-3.

**A** Fanned a season-high eight over 5.2 innings, 4/12 vs. Rochester...Allowed five hits and two runs in a 7-6, 14-inning loss...The loss was the only defeat for Gwinnett in Soroka's four starts this season.

**A** Named Gwinnett's Opening Day starter and tossed 5.0 scoreless innings on 4/6 at Norfolk...Yielded just three hits and one walk while striking out five.

**A** Became the youngest Opening Day starter in the 10-year history of Gwinnett's franchise...Soroka (20 years, 8 months, 2 days) was nearly two years younger than the previous youngest, RHP Tommy Hanson (22 years, 7 months, 12 days), who pitched the inaugural game in Gwinnett history, 4/9/09.

#### 2017 Recap

**A** Named the Braves' organizational Pitcher of the Year after going 11-8 with a 2.75 ERA (47 ER/153.2 IP) in a career-high 26 starts for Double-A Mississippi.

**A** His 11 wins tied for the fourth most in the SL and were the second most among Atlanta minor leaguers...He finished second in the SL with a 2.75 ERA (47 ER/153.2 IP), fourth with 153.2 innings and third with a 1.09 WHIP...His 153.2 innings were the most by a Braves minor leaguer.

**Jesse Biddle • LHP • 6-5 • 220 • 26 yrs • #63**

**Saves/Opp:** 0/0 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 6/4 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 3/3

- Right-handed batters have just two hits in 20 at-bats (.100) against him...Lefties are hitting .400/.500/.800 with four hits, two walks, one double, a home run and five RBI.
- Allowed the first two runs of his major league career in his last outing, 5/4 vs. SF...Surrendered a two-run home run to Brandon Crawford in the top of the seventh.
- Went 2.0 innings and fanned a career-most five batters, 4/29 at PHI...Became the first Atlanta reliever to strike out at least five batters in 2.0 or fewer innings since Dario Álvarez did so on 6/15/16...Just four Atlanta relievers have had an outing of five strikeouts in 2.0 or fewer innings since 2000.
- Made his major league debut, 4/21 vs. NYM, and tossed 1.0 scoreless inning...Earned the win when Atlanta walked off in the bottom of the ninth...Became the first Atlanta reliever to earn the win in his debut since Jed Bradley on 9/3/16 at PHI.
- Recalled from Triple-A Gwinnett, 4/17, for his first appearance on an active roster.

**Shane Carle • RHP • 6-4 • 210 • 26 yrs • #51**

**Saves/Opp:** 0/1 **Holds:** 5 **1st Batter/Retired:** 15/12 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 10/3

- Returned to action yesterday and tossed 1.0 scoreless inning...Threw two pitches and left with numbness in his right index finger and thumb in his last outing, 5/1 at NYM.
- Holding right-handed batters to a .150 (6-for-40) average...Lefties are hitting .273 (9-for-33).
- Converted his fifth hold of the season, 4/28 at PHI...Five holds pace the club and are tied for second most in the majors among rookie pitchers...No rookie has paced the Atlanta staff in holds since Jonny Venters in 2010 (24).
- Holding batters to a .171 (6-for-35) average with men on base and has allowed just three hits (3-for-25, .120) with runners in scoring position...Batters are hitting .257 (9-for-35) with no one on base.
- Tallied his first career win, 4/3 vs. WSH...Tossed 3.1 scoreless innings, while also stranding the bases loaded after entering the game in the third.
- Took the loss in his Braves debut, 3/30 vs. PHI...Allowed one run over 2.0 innings...The loss was his first major league decision.

**Sam Freeman • LHP • 5-11 • 180 • 30 yrs • #39**

**Saves/Opp:** 0/0 **Holds:** 2 **1st Batter/Retired:** 17/12 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 18/3

- Has not allowed a hit to a left-handed batter this season (0-for-14).
- Ranks tied for 10th in the majors with 17 appearances this season...Has pitched in 53% of Atlanta's games...Made a career-most 58 appearances last year.
- Tossed 1.1 scoreless innings to earn his first win of the season, 4/26 at CIN...Retired all four batters he faced and did not issue a base-on-balls...Had walked eight of the last 17 batters he had faced entering the appearance.
- Inherited the bases loaded, 4/19 vs. NYM, and allowed a sacrifice fly before stranding the remaining two runners...Has inherited a majors-most (tied) 18 runners, and has stranded 15 (83%)...Inherited just 19 runners last season.
- Took the loss, 4/23 at CIN...The loss snapped a streak of 190 consecutive games without a loss, the longest such active streak in the majors at the time...Freeman's run, which was the second-longest in MLB history, dated to 10/3/12...Only Trevor Miller (240 games, 2006-09) had a longer streak in MLB history.

**Luke Jackson • RHP • 6-2 • 210 • 26 yrs • #64**

**Saves/Opp:** 0/0 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 2/0 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 0/0

- Had his contract selected from Triple-A Gwinnett today for his second stint with Atlanta this season...Also selected on 4/4 before being designated for assignment on 4/15.
- Is 1-1 with a 3.86 ERA (4 ER/9.1 IP) in five relief appearances with the Stripers...Earned the win in his last appearance, 5/4 at Indianapolis (2.0 IP, BB, 2 SO).
- Made his season debut 4/9 at WSH, tossing 1.0 scoreless inning with two walks and two strikeouts.
- In his first season in the Braves organization in 2017, appeared in 43 games out of the bullpen for Atlanta, while also spending time with Triple-A Gwinnett...Also missed 12 games on the MLB disabled list with a right shoulder strain, 8/18-9/1.
- Allowed a run in just nine of his 43 appearances...Surrendered a career high-tying six runs on 8/16 at COL.

**A.J. Minter • LHP • 6-0 • 215 • 24 yrs • #33**

**Saves/Opp:** 1/1 **Holds:** 4 **1st Batter/Retired:** 15/9 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 3/0

- Has allowed 15 baserunners over his last 7.1 innings (eight hits, seven walks)...Allowed just 15 total baserunners over 15.0 innings last season.
- Earned the first save of his major league career with a scoreless ninth inning, 4/25 at CIN...Became the first left-handed pitcher to record a save for Atlanta since Jonny Venters logged five in 2011.
- Allowed a career high-tying three hits and two runs, 4/24 at CIN...Had surrendered just four hits total entering play...Had not allowed three hits or two runs since 8/27/17 vs. COL, his second career appearance.
- Stranded the only runner he inherited, 4/16 vs. PHI...Inherited two runners vs. PHI on 3/30 and stranded them both in his season debut...Has stranded all seven runners he has inherited in his career.
- Fanned the side, 4/11 at WSH...Needed just 13 pitches to do so.
- Appeared in back-to-back games three times this season...His back-to-back outings on 4/3 and 4/4 vs. WSH marked the first time doing so in his career...Did so just once in the minors (7/23 and 7/24/17 with GWN)...Underwent "Tommy John" surgery in 2015.
