**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Braves and Brewers open a four-game set tonight with the first meeting between the clubs this season...The Braves took four of six matchups last season, to win the season series with Milwaukee for the third time in the last four seasons... Since the beginning of 2014, the Braves have won 16 of 27 games with Milwaukee.

*A* Atlanta has not lost a series in Milwaukee since 2013, and over their last 12 games here, the Braves are 8-4.

*A* LHP Max Fried is set for his first career appearance against Milwaukee...The lefty is 2-1 with a 1.69 ERA (4 ER/21.1 IP) with one home run allowed in four career road starts.

*A* RHP Jhoulys Chacín is set to face the Braves for the seventh time in his career and for the third time since the club dealt him to Los Angeles (AL) in 2016...The right-hander is 1-4 with a 3.94 ERA (14 ER/32.0 IP) in his six career appearances, all starts, against the Braves.

**HITS:** 2B Ozzie Albies finished 3-for-5 yesterday and now has 102 hits this season, third most in the N.L. and one more than teammate 1B Freddie Freeman...Both are trailing teammate OF Nick Markakis, who leads the N.L. with 108 hits...Cincinnati's Scooter Gennett is second with 105.

*A* This season marks the first time in franchise history the club has had three players reach 100 hits prior to the All-Star game.

*A* The last time the club had two players reach triple digits before the break was 2012, when Martin Prado and Michael Bourn accomplished the feat.

*A* No other team in the majors has two players with 100 hits yet this season.

*A* The Braves are second in the N.L. with 782 hits, two behind the Chicago Cubs for the league lead.

**TOP OF THE LINEUP:** Since returning to the top two spots in the lineup on June 22, OF Ender Inciarte and 2B Ozzie Albies have combined to hit .349 and compile a .408 on-base percentage with 25 runs scored.

*A* When the pair hit together at the top of the lineup, the Braves are 26-18 (.591).

**FREEMAN IN MILWAUKEE:** 1B Freddie Freeman is hitting .419 (13-for-31) with six home runs, seven walks and a 1.622 OPS over his last nine games in Milwaukee...He has hit two home runs in each of his last three series here.

*A* Freeman enters this series hitting .161 (10-for-62) over his last 15 games...He has struck out 20 times over this stretch that dates to June 17.

**ON THE ROAD:** The Braves are 26-19 (.578) away from Atlanta this season, the N.L.'s best road record.

**LENGTH:** The Braves are 29-9 (.763) this season when their starter goes at least 6.0 innings, including 9-2 in their last 11 such games.

*A* The Braves' .763 winning percentage is the best in the National League, and trails only New York (36-5, .878), Seattle (39-11, .780) and Oakland (31-9, .763) for the best mark in the majors.

**GOOD GAME:** LHP Max Fried tossed 6.2 scoreless innings, struck out a career-best 11 and collected his first career hit to beat St. Louis, 11-4, in his last start on June 30.

*A* Fried became the first Braves rookie to fan double digits in a game since 2016, when Aaron Blair struck out 10 on October 1 vs. Detroit.

*A* The last left-handed rookie to strike out double digits for the Braves was Mike Minor, who fanned 12 on August 22, 2010.

**SCHEDULE:** The Braves entered a stretch last Friday in which they will play 16 of 18 games against teams with winning records, including seven games against teams currently in first place (four with Milwaukee, July 5-8, three with Arizona, July 13-15)...They have started the stretch 4-2.

*A* The Braves are 31-21 (.596) so far this season against teams with winning records, the National League's best record in such games...Only New York (.733) and Boston (.690) are better this season.

**NEVER QUIT WITH SNIT:** The Braves have 11 last at-bat wins this season, tied with tonight's opponent, Milwaukee, for the most such victories in the National League.

*A* Since Brian Snitker took over as interim manager on May 17, 2016, the club leads the N.L. with 48 such wins.

*A* The Braves finished with a N.L.-most 20 such victories in 2017 after leading the league with 19 the year before.

**ALL-STAR VOTING:** 2B Ozzie Albies continues to lead all National League second basemen in All-Star voting, collecting 2,306,487 votes after Major League Baseball released an update for key races this afternoon... Chicago's Javier Báez ranks second with 2,194,717, while Cincinnati's Scooter Gennett is third with 2,157,304.

*A* Albies is trying to become the 13th player in MLB history to collect 20 home runs and 30 doubles prior to the All-Star break...He needs two home runs and three doubles over the next nine games... The last to do so was David Ortiz in 2016 (34 doubles, 22 home runs).

*A* Albies and OF Nick Markakis, who led all N.L. outfielders in votes at the last update, are two away from the Braves franchise record for doubles prior to the All-Star game...Marcus Giles had 29 in 2003.

#### Tonight's Game

- A* Makes his third start and seventh appearance of the season, and the seventh start (16th appearance) of his career.
  - A* Faces Milwaukee for the first time in his career.
- A* Set career highs in innings pitched and strikeouts in his last start, 6/30 at STL, fanning 11 over 6.2 innings...Allowed just four hits and three walks.
  - A* Became the seventh pitcher in Atlanta franchise history to record double-digit strikeouts within his first 15 career games, and the first to do so since Aaron Blair fanned 10 on 10/1/16 vs. DET.
  - A* Is just the second Atlanta starter to fan 10 or more batters in a scoreless effort within his first 15 career games...Kevin Millwood struck out 13 in a one-hit shutout on 4/14/98 vs. PIT.
- A* Has not allowed a hit with runners in scoring position this season...Opposing batters are 0-for-14 with two walks and nine strikeouts.
  - A* His 14 hitless at-bats with runners in scoring position are second most in the majors...Batters are 0-for-18 against SD's Kirby Yates.
  - A* Opponents are hitting .265/.405/.441 against Fried with no one on base.
- A* Is 2-1 with a 2.40 ERA (8 ER/30.0 IP) in six career starts...Has pitched to an 0-2 record and a 5.27 ERA (8 ER/13.2 IP) in nine relief appearances.

#### 2018 Recap

- A* Made his first start with Atlanta, 5/28 vs. NYM in the first game of a doubleheader... Was added to the roster as the 26th man, and allowed two runs, one earned, over 5.0 innings.
  - A* Became the first Braves pitcher since Kevin Millwood in 1999 to pick off two runners in the same inning...Millwood did it on 7/18 at TOR... Since Millwood's two pickoffs, only six other major league pitchers have accomplished the feat, with MIN's Kyle Gibson doing it last on 9/7/16 vs. KC.
- A* Tossed 3.0 innings of one-run relief, 4/27 at PHI, but was saddled with his second consecutive loss...The 3.0 innings marked a career high out of the bullpen.
  - A* Was optioned to Triple-A on 5/5 after four total relief appearances with Atlanta.
- A* Recalled from Triple-A Gwinnett on 4/24 for his first stint on the roster and made his season debut that night at Cincinnati...Surrendered a walk and a walk-off home run to the only two batters he faced to take the loss, the first of his career in relief.
- A* Made 10 minor league starts between Triple-A Gwinnett and Double-A Mississippi this season, combining to go 2-4 with a 3.93 ERA (24 ER/55.0 IP) and 57 strikeouts.
- A* Went 1-2 with a 4.66 ERA (15 ER/29.0 IP) in five starts with Gwinnett since being returned to the Stripers following Atlanta's doubleheader on 5/28.
  - A* Seven of the 15 earned runs came in one outing, 6/7 vs. Lehigh Valley...In his remaining four starts, has pitched to a 3.00 ERA (8 ER/24.0 IP).
- A* Fanned a career-best 11 batters over 7.0 one-run innings, 6/13 at Norfolk...Earned his second win of the season.
  - A* Was the fourth double-digit strikeout effort of his minor league career.
- A* Earned the first win of his Triple-A career in his second start, 4/18 vs. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre...Allowed a pair of runs over 5.1 innings.
- A* Tossed 5.2 innings in his Gwinnett debut, 4/13 vs. Rochester...Held the Red Wings to five hits and one run while striking out six.
- A* Opened the season with Double-A Mississippi and made one start with the M-Braves, 4/8 vs. Tennessee...Allowed three hits and three walks over 4.2 innings, fanning six in a no-decision.
  - A* Was transferred to Gwinnett on 4/12.
- A* Made four appearances with Atlanta this spring before being optioned...Went 0-0 with a 6.75 ERA (5 ER/6.2 IP) before being optioned to Triple-A on 3/16

#### 2017 Recap

- A* Made his major league debut while also spending time with Double-A Mississippi and Triple-A Gwinnett.
- A* Spent the majority of the season pitching in Double-A Mississippi's rotation... Started the year with the M-Braves and went 2-11 with a 5.92 ERA (57 ER/86.2 IP) and 85 strikeouts over 19 starts.
- A* The Braves recalled him from Mississippi on 8/5 and he made his MLB debut on 8/8 vs. PHI...Tossed 2.0 scoreless innings out of the bullpen.
- A* Started four of his final five games with the Braves...Made his first career start on 9/3 at CHI and earned the 5-1 victory after going 5.0 innings and allowing one run and four hits...Of the four Braves to make their first career start in 2017, Fried was the only one to win.

- A* Acquired by the Atlanta Braves along with INF Jace Peterson, OF Dustin Peterson and OF Malle Smith from the San Diego Padres in exchange for OF Justin Upton and RHP Aaron Northcraft on December 19, 2014

**Jesse Biddle • LHP • 6-5 • 220 • 26 yrs • #63**

**Saves/Opp:** 0/1 **Holds:** 2 **1st Batter/Retired:** 26/18 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 6/3

- Over his last 16 appearances, has a 2.33 ERA (5 ER/19.1 IP) with a .156 (10-for-64) opponents' average.
- Tossed a scoreless ninth and 10th innings, 7/2 at NYY, to earn his second win of the season... In four extra-inning outings this season, has tossed 8.0 scoreless innings with four hits and 14 strikeouts.
- Earned his first career hold with a scoreless seventh inning, 6/24 vs. BAL, and has holds in two of his last five outings...Became the sixth Atlanta pitcher with a hold this season.
- Right-handed batters have just eight hits in 71 at-bats (.113) against him...Lefties are hitting .359/.457/.667 with 14 hits, six walks, three doubles, three home runs and nine RBI.
- Set career highs in IP (3.0) and strikeouts (8), 6/2 vs. WSH... Became the first Braves reliever in 110 seasons to strike out at least eight batters in that few innings...MIL's Josh Hader struck out eight in 2.2 IP, 4/30/18 at CIN.
- Made his MLB debut, 4/21 vs. NYM with 1.0 scoreless inning...Earned the win when Atlanta walked off in the bottom of the ninth...Became the first ATL reliever to earn the win in his debut since Jed Bradley, 9/3/16 at PHI.

**Shane Carle • RHP • 6-4 • 210 • 26 yrs • #51**

**Saves/Opp:** 0/1 **Holds:** 11 **1st Batter/Retired:** 35/22 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 15/3

- Is one of three rookie relievers for Atlanta with at least 10 holds...No other team has more than one.
- Is one of eight relievers in the majors with at least four wins and 10 holds.
- Allowed five runs over his last two appearances (3.1 IP)...Allowed multiple runs in consecutive appearances for the first time in his career.
- Holding batters to a .182 (14-for-77) average with men on base and has allowed just six hits (6-for-44, .136) with runners in scoring position...Batters are hitting .280 (23-for-82) with no one on base.
- Has a 6.35 ERA (12 ER/17.0 IP) in his last 15 appearances dating to 5/21 at PHI...Pitched to a 0.69 ERA in his first 20 games of the season.
- Earned three of his four wins at SunTrust Park this season...Is 3-1 with a 2.05 ERA (5 ER/22.0 IP) at home.

**Sam Freeman • LHP • 5-11 • 180 • 31 yrs • #39**

**Saves/Opp:** 0/3 **Holds:** 6 **1st Batter/Retired:** 41/26 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 29/8

- Is 1-3 with an 7.31 ERA (13 ER/16.0 IP) in his last 17 appearances...Surrendered 15 hits and eight walks during the spell, including a pair of home runs, and has allowed at least one run in eight of those outings.
- Had a 8.49 ERA (11 ER/11.2 IP) in 12 games in June.
- Fanned a career high-tying four batters in 2.1 innings, 6/19 at TOR, to earn his second win
- Left-handed batters are hitting just 9-for-48 (.188) against him.
- Has inherited 29 runners on the season, and has stranded 21 (73%)...Inherited just 19 runners last season.
- Took the loss, 4/23 at CIN...The loss snapped a streak of 190 consecutive games without a loss, the longest such active streak in the majors at the time...Freeman's run, which is the third-longest in MLB history, dated to 10/3/12...Only Trevor Miller (240 games, 2006-09) and Peter Moylan (present) had a longer streak in MLB history.
