SAN DIEGO NOTES

- **Joey Lucchesi** allowed a season-high-tying five earned runs in tonight's game (also: July 29 vs. ARI)...has now been saddled with the loss in all four of his starts against ARI, owning a 7.71 ERA (16 ER, 18.2 IP) and five home runs allowed...it's his highest ERA vs. any NL club.
- **Eric Hosmer** belted his 12th home run of the year and extended his hitting streak to six games, the longest active streak on the team (.348, 8-for-23)...has hit safely in his last six consecutive games vs. ARI, dating back to July 8 at ARI (.286, 8-for-28).
 - Tallied his sixth stolen base and 36th multi-hit game of the season.
- **Christian Villanueva** made his first career appearance at second base...is hitting .368 (14-for-38) in August with a .467 OBP (three walks)...his nine HBP continue to lead the team.
- **Jose Pirela** recorded his third multi-walk game of the season (last: May 9 vs. WSH)...started in left field for the first time since June 25 at TEX.
- **Robbie Erlin** made his first career pinch-hit appearance.

ARIZONA NOTES

- **Robbie Ray** threw a season-high-tying 107 pitches in tonight's game (also: April 24 at PHI)...is 2-1 with a 3.05 ERA (15 ER, 44.1 IP), .191 opponent average and 57 strikeouts in nine starts on the road this year.
 - Has pitched to a 4-0 record with a 3.57 ERA (16 ER, 40.1 IP) with 22 walks against 58 strikeouts in his last seven outings vs. SD since Aug. 20, 2016.
 - Recorded his second career bunt-hit in the second inning (first: Aug. 24, 2017 at NYM).
- **Paul Goldschmidt** hit his 28th homer of the season...has reached base in 36 consecutive road games since May 27, surpassing Eric Byrnes for the longest streak in team history...overall, has reached base safely in 23 straight games since July 23, tying his streak from May 26- June 19, 2016.
 - Extended his hitting streak to 10 games...is batting .422 (19-for-45) with three doubles, a triple, three homers and 10 RBI in his last 11 games vs. the Padres.
- **Steven Souza Jr.** went 3-for-5 and recorded his third multi-RBI game of the season (last: Aug. 4 vs. SF)...has reached base safely in 12 of his last 14 road starts, batting .340 (18-for-53) over that time...is hitting .417 (10-for-24) with runners in scoring position in 16 games since July 21.
- **Eduardo Escobar** tallied his third home run of the year...has reached base in 27 of his last 30 games (.385 OBP) with seven doubles, four home runs, 23 RBI and 16 walks.
- **Nick Ahmed** was ejected for the second time in his career (also: April 24, 2016)...is the sixth D-back to be ejected this season (last: A.J. Pollock, July 8 vs. SD).
