TONIGHT'S GAME: The Giants and Braves play the middle game of this three-game series with the Giants looking to snap a season-long nine-game losing streak and the Braves seeking to win their fourth in a row.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: LHP Andrew Suárez, who turns 26 years old today, recorded his first Major League win in Atlanta on May 6, limiting the Braves to one unearned run in 5.1 innings...Suarez has held his opponents scoreless in three of his last five games, posting a 3.14 ERA (10er, 28.2ip) in that span.

FACEBOOK REMINDER: Tomorrow's Giants-Braves game is an exclusive Facebook/MLB Network telecast...the Giants' Mike Krukow will be in the booth along with Rich Waltz and Jason Marquis, representing the Braves.

GIANTS ON FOX: Please be advised that FOX Sports has selected the game of Saturday, Sept. 22 (SF at STL)...the game has been dropped from the NBC Sports Bay Area TV schedule and the game time has been changed from 4:15 p.m. PT to 10:05 a.m. PT (12:05 p.m. CT).

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: RHP Dereck Rodriguez turned in his 13th start this season where he has pitched at least 6.0 innings and allowed two or fewer runs...according to Stats, LLC., the only two pitchers since 1913 with 6.0+ innings while allowing two runs or fewer in at least 13 of their first 16 career starts are Rodriguez and the Expos' Steve Rogers...the last Giants pitcher (and only other since 1913) with 13 such starts in his first 16 starts in a season (rookie or veteran) was Juan Marichal in 1965.

TOUGH ON US: The Giants are currently in the middle of a stretch in which they are playing 12 consecutive games against teams vying for a playoff spot...they are 0-7 in this stretch, going 0-3 at Colorado, 0-3 at Milwaukee and 0-1 versus Atlanta...the Giants host the NL West-leading Rockies for three games this weekend.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY: Mike Passanisi, the Giants' Baseball Information Manager, celebrates his birthday today...Happy Birthday Mike!

SNAP THIS STREAK: Entering tonight's game, the Giants have lost each of their last nine contests, their longest losing streak of the season and their longest losing skid since a nine-game losing streak from July 23-Aug. 1, 2006...the Giants need a win tonight to avoid losing 10 consecutive games for the first time since June 21-30, 1996 (10 game losing streak).

SOLID PITCHING: Beginning June 1, Giants pitchers have posted a 3.42 ERA, which ranks as the third-best figure in the Majors behind Houston (3.38 ERA) and Los Angeles-NL (3.40 ERA).

NOTABLE BATTER-PITCHER MATCHUPS: IF Brandon Belt is 6-for-15 (.400) with three home runs and four RBI in his career against tonight's Braves starting pitcher Mike Foltyniewicz...IF Brandon Crawford has posted similar numbers, going 8-for-15 (.533) with three homers and four RBI.

TOUGH MONTH: The Giants are still looking for their first win this month as they are 0-9 in September...SF has scored a total of just 24 runs in the nine games (2.7/game) while hitting .190, including a .152 mark with runners in scoring position...the pitching staff has posted a 4.91 ERA, with the starters logging a 4.64 mark and the bullpen posting a 5.47 ERA...SF has 17 games left on its schedule.

SCORING: The Giants have scored three runs or fewer in 12 of their last 14 games.

SCORE AT LEAST FOUR: San Francisco is 19-60 (.241) when scoring three runs or fewer compared to 49-17 (.742) when plating four-or-more runs.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#59 LHP Andrew Suárez
6-0, 187, 26 years old (September 11, 1992)
6-10 Record, 4.33 ERA

- Suárez, who turns 26 years old today, is slated to make his 26th career Major League start...has gone 6-10 with a 4.33 ERA (67er, 139.1ip) in 25 outings, with the Giants going 11-14 in those games.
- Among NL rookie leaders he ranks first in innings pitched (139.1), fourth in strikeouts (118) and seventh in ERA (4.33).
- His 118 strikeouts are tied for the 11th-most by a rookie pitcher in franchise history...they rank seventh in the San Francisco era.
- Allowed a career-high three home runs in Wednesday's 5-3 loss at Colorado...was tagged with the loss after allowing five runs on six hits with two walks and five strikeouts over 6.0 innings.
- Has a 2.28 ERA (15er, 59.1ip) in the 10 one-run games he has pitched in...opponents have three hits in 15 at-bats (.200) off him in close and late situations.
- Has struck out 118 batters while issuing just 36 walks in his first 25 career Major League starts.
- Is holding opponents to a .179 average (7-for-39) with RISP and two outs.
- With one out in an inning opponents are hitting .304 off him with an OBP of .347 and a SLG pct. of .541... however, with two outs in an inning opponents are hitting .225/.283/.419 (Baseball Info Solutions).
- Has received three or fewer runs of support in 19 of his 25 starts.
- Has a 3.07 ERA (25er, 73.1ip) in 12 starts at home compared to a 5.73 ERA (42er, 66.0ip) in 13 starts on the road.
- Lefties are hitting .212 (29-for-137) off him with just seven extra-base hits (four doubles, two triples, one home run).
- Faced the Braves in Atlanta earlier this season and allowed one run (none earned) on seven hits over 5.1 innings...was the winning pitcher in the Giants' 4-3 victory.
- Was selected in the second round of the 2015 MLB Draft by San Francisco (No. 61 overall).

NOTES: The 31-year-old left-hander is slated to make his 28th start (32nd appearance) this season...has posted a 7-8 record with a 3.54 ERA (60er, 152.2ip) over his 31 outings...did not factor into the decision in his last start on Sept. 7 at Milwaukee...threw 6.0 innings, allowing just two runs on two hits and five walks with eight strikeouts in the Giants' 4-2 loss to the Brewers...has posted a 1.61 ERA (5er, 28.0ip) and a .190 opponents average with 27 strikeouts over his last five starts...since July 7, he's posted a 2.23 ERA (15er, 60.2ip), which ranks as the seventh-lowest figure in the Majors over that stretch...has made only one career appearance vs. Atlanta and threw 7.0 innings, allowing one run on eight hits with six strikeouts on Sept. 12, 2014.
