FISH BITES

The Marlins open their final homestand before the All-Star break with the first of three games against the Milwaukee Brewers tonight at 7:10 p.m. RHP **José Ureña**, making his second start since coming off the DL and 18th of the season, is facing the Brewers for the seventh time in his career (third start) with no record and a 6.35 ERA (17.0/12). Milwaukee is countering with RHP Chase Anderson, who in just two career starts against the Marlins has gone 0-1 with a 6.55 ERA (11.0/8). Miami just returned from a quick four-game against Washington at Nationals Park, and will continue this homestand with a three-game set against Philadelphia.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

Miami erupted for a season-high 22 hits (20 singles) in a 10-2 win over Washington, snapping a 14-game slide to the Nats. After a scoreless opening frame, **Cameron Maybin** drove in **Martín Prado** for the game's first run. **J.T. Realmuto** added a two-out, two-run single to give the Marlins a 3-0 advantage. Washington scored solo runs in the second and third innings to move within a run, but that would be it for the Nationals. **JT Riddle** extended Miami's lead with an RBI single in the fourth, and Miami added two more in the seventh on RBI-singles by **Derek Dietrich** and **Realmuto**. The Marlins added four more in the ninth, highlighted by **Justin Bour**'s two-run double. **Realmuto** finished with a career five hits, while **Prado** added four hits and **Riddle** chipped in three. **Trevor Richards** started for Miami and went 3.2 innings, allowing four hits, two runs, and seven walks, while striking out five. **Adam Conley** earned the win with 2.0 scoreless innings.

VS. THE BREWERS

Milwaukee is out in front of the 2018 season series, 4-0, after sweeping the four-game set at Miller Park from April 19-22. The series will mark the first played against Milwaukee at Marlins Park since May 9-11, 2016, when the two teams split a four game series. The 2017 series at Marlins Park was played in Milwaukee due to Hurricane Irma. The Marlins hold a 38-32 advantage in South Florida, which includes a 31-20 record since 2002. Miami, however, trails the all-time series, 69-75.

TODAY'S MOVES

The Marlins today placed C **J.T. Realmuto** on the Paternity list, placed RHP **Drew Rucinski** on the 10-day disabled list with a right groin strain, transferred LHP **Caleb Smith** to the 60-day DL, selected the contract of RHP **Javy Guerra** from Triple-A New Orleans and recalled C **Chad Wallach** from NOLA. In 12 appearances with the Baby Cakes, Guerra has gone 3-0 with no ERA, allowing just one unearned run and nine hits over 16.2 innings. Wallach has 28 appearances with NOLA, batting .211 (19x90) with 14 runs scored, three doubles, three home runs and 13 RBI. He also has nine appearances with Miami, batting .129 (4x31) with a double and two RBI.

UREÑA GETTING ICED

Tonight will mark **José Ureña**'s 11th start at Marlins Park this season, where he has posted an 0-7 record with a 3.88 ERA (58.0 ip/25 er). He is one of only three Major League pitchers since 1950 to start 0-7 or worse with an ERA under 4.00 through his first 10 home starts of a season. The other two are the California Angels' **Rickey Clark** in 1968 (0-7, 3.17) and the Cubs **Jamie Moyer** in 1988 (0-7, 3.92). One reason for the record is lack of run support, as he has the lowest run support at home of any Major League pitcher this season (min. 8 starts) with 11, while his run support average is second-lowest at 1.71, with only **Michael Fulmer** having a lower RSA at home (1.70). - *Stats LLC*

EXTRA-ORDINARY GROUP

On Saturday night, **J.T. Realmuto** homered in the fourth inning to give him 35 extra-base hits this season, reaching the mark in each of his first four full Major League seasons. According to *Stats LLC*, Realmuto became just the third catcher ever to accomplish the feat, joining **Johnny Bench** and **Mike Piazza**.

ALL IS RIGHT

Starlin Castro has excelled against right-handed pitchers this season, as his 83 hits against RHPs rank as the second-most in the Majors behind **Jose Altuve** (93). Teammate **J.T. Realmuto** (.354; 70x198) has also hit right-handed pitching quite well this season, as his average vs. RHP is the second-highest in MLB (min. 200 PA) behind **Altuve** (.358). - *Stats LLC*

CASTRO-LLING

With a 2x6 effort yesterday in Washington, **Starlin Castro** extended his hitting streak to seven games. He has recorded multiple hits in five of his last six games and now has 30 on the season. His 30 multi-hit games are the fifth-most in the National League, behind **Nick Markakis** (37), **Ozzie Albies** (33), **Nolan Arenado** (33), and **Scouter Gennett** (31). Castro has hit safely in 13 of his last 14 games, batting .464 (26x56) over that span to lead the Majors (min. 40 PA). In that time he has raised his average from .267 to a current .298. He is one of just six National League players with 100+ hits this season (107), joining **Nick Markakis** (113), **Ozzie Albies** (108), **Freddie Freeman** (108), **Scouter Gennett** (107), and **Trea Turner** (100).

KID CLUTCH

Brian Anderson has seven hits in his last 14 at-bats with runners in scoring position (.500). On the season, the rookie right fielder has posted the third-best average with runners in scoring position in the Majors at .417 (35x84), trailing the Dodgers' **Matt Kemp** (.438; 28x64) and Houston's **Yuli Gurriel** (.427; 32x75). Anderson leads MLB in hits with RISP, ahead of **Gurriel** and **J.D. Martinez** (30).

HEATING UP WITH SUMMER

Since May 28, Miami's offense has hit at a .264 clip (376x1423) with 176 runs scored. The 376 hits lead all National League clubs in that time, ahead of the Cubs (369), Rockies (360), and Reds (357). The Marlins average in that time ranks fourth, behind the Reds (.280), Cubs (.279), and Rockies (.278).

GETTIN' MIGGY WITH IT

Miguel Rojas recorded a pinch-hit single yesterday, giving him at least one hit in seven of his last eight games. Since June 13, Rojas ranks second in the National League and third in the Majors in average (min. 70 PA), posting a .368 average (25x68). He trails only **Javier Baez** (.425; 34x80) and **J.D. Martinez** (.376; 32x85) in the Majors over that span.

ONE STECK OF A JOB

Drew Steckenrider entered yesterday's game and provided a scoreless seventh inning. He is on a career-best 19.2 inning scoreless streak over his last 22 appearances, a run that has seen him become the first pitcher in Club history to make 14-or-more appearances in a calendar month (June) without allowing a run; he last allowed a run (2) on May 20 at Atlanta. His scoreless streak is the longest active streak in the Majors, the second-longest by a Marlins reliever this season (**Barraclough** 20.2), and the 11th-longest by any pitcher in Marlins history.

THIS DAY IN MARLINS HISTORY

JULY 8

In 2009, Florida erased a seven-run deficit to the Diamondbacks for a 14-7 win in Arizona. The comeback matched the largest deficit overcome for a win in team history (other, June 28, 2003, 10-9 at Boston). The Marlins scored 10 runs on eight hits in the top of the eighth to take the lead and the game. In 2002, **Luis Castillo** and **Mike Lowell** both attended the 73rd MLB All-Star Game as reserves. **Mike Lowell** entered the game as a pinch-hitter, going 2x3 with a run scored. In 1996, **Kevin Brown**, **Al Leiter**, and **Gary Sheffield** were selected for the 67th MLB All-Star Game at Veterans Stadium in Philadelphia.

➤ José Ureña will take the mound tonight when the Marlins kick off their final homestand of the first half in the first game of a three-game set against the Brewers. It will mark the 100th appearance (67th start) of his career.

➤ Has a 0-0 record and 6.35 ERA (17.0 ip/12 er) in six career appearances (two starts) vs. the Brewers. His last two outings have been starts, posting a 5.59 ERA (9.2/6) and .222 (8x36) average against; Miami is 0-2 in those games.

➤ Was placed on 10-day DL on June 21 with right shoulder impingement, following his start at San Francisco the previous day (L, 5.2 ip, 8 h, 5 r, 5 er, 2 bb, 1bb, 5 so).

➤ In his start prior to that outing in SF, he fired off 8.0 shutout innings on June 15 at Baltimore to pick up his second win of the season (3 h, bb, 4 so, hb). It was his fourth career game tossing at least 8.0 innings, and fell 0.2 inning shy of his career-long outing. Also threw a career-high 112 pitches.

➤ Picked up his first win of the season on June 5 at St. Louis. It snapped a skid of 14 consecutive team losses in his starts, dating back to September 26, 2017, the longest streak in Club history. Picked up the win despite allowing a season-high 10 hits, and surrendering four runs. Benefitted from seven runs of support while he was in the game, the most he has received this season and just the second game with five-or-more (five on April 21 at Milwaukee).

➤ Opened 2018 with 5.88 ERA (26.0 ip/17 er) over his first five starts. In his 12 starts since then, he has posted a 3.58 ERA (73.0/29), allowing three-or-fewer runs eight times.

➤ His average of 2.91 runs of support during his starts ranks as second-lowest among National League starters (min. 17 GS), better only than Junior Guerra (2.88).

➤ Left in line for win on April 21 vs. Milwaukee, but ended up with no decision after Brewers scored two late runs. Allowed four runs on four hits and two walks, while striking out three, over 5.0 innings.

➤ On April 3, held Boston to one run on four hits over 7.0 innings. Walked one while striking out a career high-tying seven. It was third career seven-strikeout game; added a fourth in his start on May 25 vs. Washington.

➤ Earned Opening Day start against Cubs on March 29 at Marlins Park. Was seventh different OD starter in last seven openers for Miami. Took loss, allowing five runs on six hits over 4.0 innings. Hit three batters in first inning, becoming only second Marlins pitcher to ever tally three HBP in a single inning (Sergio Mitre on Aug. 31, 2007 vs. PHI).

➤ Posted team-high 14 wins last season, to go with 3.82 ERA (169.2/72) and 113 strikeouts in 34 appearances (28 starts). Established career highs in wins, appearances, innings pitched, strikeouts, and ERA.

➤ Finished season 14-7, 3.97 (154.1/68) as starter. Did not factor in a decision and had a 2.35 ERA (15.1/4) in six relief appearances.

➤ Went 6-1 with 2.40 ERA (63.2/17) in 11 day-game starts. Owned fourth lowest ERA among NL starters (min. 50.0 IP), behind Max Scherzer (1.90), Stephen Strasburg (2.06) and Jimmy Nelson (2.32). - *Stats LLC*

➤ From May 7 through end of season, led National League with 28 starts, and 14 wins in that time tied Zack Greinke and Alex Wood for second, behind only Zach Davies (15). Among NL pitchers who made at least 25 starts in that time, average against (.232) ranked sixth and ERA ranked 10th.
