NATIONALS NEWS

ON-BASE MACHINE

Bryce Harper has reached base safely in 14 of his last 20 plate appearances dating to Sept. 1 vs. Milwaukee (8th inn.)...During this stretch, he has eight walks, six hits (3 singles, 2 doubles, homer) and five RBI.

- Harper has reached base safely in 11 straight games dating to Aug. 25...He has a .500 on-base percentage (9 H, 13 BB) while going 9-for-30 (.300) with three doubles, one homer, eight RBI, and eight runs.
- Since the All-Star break, Harper ranks in the National League in doubles (T1st, 14), RBI (2nd, 35), on-base percentage (3rd, .436), runs (T5th, 31), and OPS (7th, 1.024).
- On the season, he ranks in the NL in homers (T3rd, 31), RBI (7th, 89) and OBP (8th, .386).

BEST OF THE BEST

Since the All-Star break, Washington's offense ranks in the National League in OPS (1st, .791), on-base percentage (1st, .345), batting average (1st, .271), doubles (1st, 88), slugging percentage (2nd, .446), runs (2nd, 232), stolen bases (3rd, 29) and walks (2nd, 160).

DOING JUAN SOTO THINGS

Juan Soto has hit safely in nine of his last 12 games, hitting .372 (16-for-43) with two doubles, one homer, nine RBI, 10 walks and six runs scored during this stretch.

- Soto leads all MLB rookies (min. 400 PA) in on-base percentage (.419) and OPS (.928).
- He leads all National League rookies (min. 400 PA) in slugging percentage (.509) and batting average (.298).
- Even though he was called up on May 20, he ranks among National League rookies in walks (1st, 698), runs (2nd, 64), RBI (2nd, 54), home runs (3rd, 16), doubles (T3rd, 20) and hits (T3rd, 99).
- Since May 15 (the first game in his game log, due to the suspended game vs. NYY), Soto ranks among all National League hitters in walks (2nd, 69), OBP (3rd, .419), runs (5th, 64) and OPS (7th, .928).
- Among all NL hitters (min. 400 PA), he ranks in OBP (2nd, .419), OPS (6th, .928), AVG (8th, .298) and SLG (12th, .509).

TURNING THE HITS

Trea Turner has hit safely in 13 of his last 15 games dating to Aug. 21... During this stretch, he is 20-for-63 (.317) with two doubles, two homers, six RBI, seven walks, three stolen bases and 11 runs scored...Turner has not been held hitless in back-to-back games since Aug. 4-5.

- Turner leads the Nationals with 40 multi-hit games this season and his career-high 155 hits are tied for sixth in the National League.

ZIM'S WORLD

Since Aug. 7, **Ryan Zimmerman** is hitting .330 with 11 doubles, six homers, 22 RBI, 12 walks, one stolen base and 13 runs scored...He has reached base safely in 23 of the 27 games, posting a .402 on-base percentage and a .638 slugging percentage.

- Since July 23, his first start back after the All-Star Break, he ranks among National League hitters in doubles (T1st, 14), extra-base hits (T5, 21), SLG (7th, .608) and OPS (7th, 1.002).

SAVING GRACE

In 24 outings dating to July 4, **Matt Grace** has pitched to a 1.71 ERA (5 ER/26.1 IP) while striking out 25 batters and issuing just six walks...He has surrendered just five extra-base hits during this stretch (4 2B, HR).

- Among National League left-handed relievers, Grace ranks in walks per 9.0 IP (4th, 1.90), strikeout-to-walk ratio (8th, 4.18), opp. OBP (7th, .282) and WHIP (9th, 1.12).

ALL HANDS ON DECK

Including **Kyle McGowin's** Major League debut on Wednesday night, the Nationals have used 52 players this season, the fourth-most in Nationals history (2005-pres.)...The 2006 Nationals used 57 players, while the 2009 and 2005 Nationals each used 55...Washington's 52 players are tied for the third-most in the NL.

NATIONALS HISTORY

September 6 (8-4 on this date)

2012 – The Nationals capped a four-game sweep of the Chicago Cubs with a 9-2 win. The game included two bench-clearing incidents and the ejections of **Jamie Quirk**, **Steve Clevenger** and **Manny Corpas** of the Cubs as well as Washington's **Michael Gonzalez**. **Adam LaRoche** became just the sixth player in MLB history to homer in every game of a four-game series, including at least one multi-homer effort (**Johnny Bench**, **Lou Gehrig**, **Hank Greenberg**, **Babe Ruth**, **Mike Schmidt**).

Nationals manager, **Dave Martinez** served as the Cubs bench coach from 2015-2017 where he played an integral role in three Postseason appearances, including Chicago's 2016 World Series Championship...Martinez also made his Major League debut with the Cubs in 1986 and went on to play four seasons with the Cubs (1986-88, 2000)...Bullpen coach **Henry Blanco** served as Chicago's quality assurance coach from 2015-2017.

The Nationals and Cubs will meet seven times this season (3 in Chicago., 4 in D.C.)...These clubs have played to a 45-45 record against each other since 2005.

DAVE MARTINEZ

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** was named the seventh field manager in Nationals history on Oct. 30, 2017. He joined the Nationals for what will be his 30th season in professional baseball. A 16-year Major League outfielder, Martinez has been a Major League coach for the last 10 seasons, serving as Cubs manager **Joe Maddon's** bench coach and right-hand man in Chicago (2015-17) as well as Tampa Bay (2008-14). This is the first Major League managerial assignment of Martinez's career.

#37 - STEPHEN STRASBURG - RHP

Tall, powerful right-handed pitcher is a three-time All-Star who is Washington's all-time (2005-present) leader in wins (91) and strikeouts (1,406)... On May 10, 2016, he inked a seven-year contract extension that will keep him with the Nationals through the 2023 season.

AGAINST THE CUBS: Makes his first start against the Cubs this season...Is 1-1 with a 2.08 ERA in five career regular season starts against Chicago... Including two starts in the 2017 NLDS, has pitched to a 0.96 ERA (3 ER/28.0 IP) and 43 strikeouts against just five walks in his last four starts against the Cubs.

LAST START: Continued his progression since returning from the disabled list...Allowed two earned runs on five hits with two walks and seven strikeouts in Washington's 5-4 win over Milwaukee...Earned his first win since May 27 at Miami.

2018 NOTES

- Is 1-0 with a 5.06 ERA (9 ER/16.0 IP) and 17 strikeouts in three starts returning from the disabled list...Allowed five earned runs in his first start back, but has allowed two earned runs in each of his last two starts.
- Prior to the start in which he suffered right shoulder inflammation, he ranked among National League pitchers in strikeouts (4th, 93), strikeout-to-walk ratio (5th, 4.89), WHIP (7th, 1.06), opp. OBP (7th, .274), wins (7th, 6), opp. AVG (10th, .220), and hits allowed per 9.0 IP (11th, 7.32)... Also ranked seventh in the National League with a 2.33 road ERA (10 ER/38.0 IP).
- Along with teammates **Gio Gonzalez** and **Max Scherzer**, he ranked in the top 10 in the NL in opp. AVG with runners in scoring position (8th, .196) at the time of the injury with right shoulder inflammation.
- Since Aug. 19, 2017, he ranks sixth in the National League with a 2.96 ERA among pitchers with at least 25 starts...Among National League pitchers during this stretch, he ranks in opp. OBP (6th, .275) and opp. AVG (10th, .221).
- Fanned a season-high 11 batters on May 2 vs. Pittsburgh...Allowed two earned runs on seven hits in 7.0 innings of work.
- Allowed just three hits while striking out eight batters and walking two in 8.0 shutout innings on April 10 vs. ATL...It was his longest outing since Sept. 10, 2017 at PHI (8.0 IP)...Earned his second win as Washington topped Atlanta, 4-1
- Opened his 2018 season by tossing 6.1 innings while allowing one earned run as Washington topped Cincinnati, 13-7, on March 31...The lone earned run came via fourth inning home run by **Scott Schebler**.

2017 NOTES

- Put together a strong first half of the season en route to being named an All-Star for the third time in his career.
- Was a finalist for the National League Cy Young Award...Capped 2017 being named National League Pitcher of the Month in September.
- Also ranked in NL in HR/9.0 IP (1st, 0.67), opp. SLG (1st, .317), opp. OPS (2nd, .581), WHIP (3rd, 1.02), opp. OBP (3rd, .265), & opp. AVG (3rd, .204).
- On May 27 at San Diego, he struck out a career-high 15 batters in 7.0 shutout innings.
- On Aug. 19 at San Diego, he returned from a three-week stint on the disabled list...He went 5-1 with a 0.84 ERA (5 ER/53.2 IP) in his final eight starts of the regular season following reinstatement...He racked up 63 strikeouts, allowed just 10 walks and surrendered only one home run.

CAREER NOTES

- Is 86-49 with a 3.17 ERA in 189 starts since Sept. 6, 2011, his return from 2010 Tommy John Surgery.
- When starting, Washington is 126-75 (.627) since his debut...Since the start of 2016, the Nationals are 50-19 (.724) when he starts.
- Since 2012, he ranks in MLB in strikeouts per 9.0 IP (4th, 10.47), opp. SLG (7th, .357), opp. AVG (7th, .226), strikeouts (8th, 1,290), strikeout-to-walk ratio (8th, 4.43), opp. OBP (9th, .282), and ERA (11th, 3.21).
