FISH BITES

The Marlins open a seven-game road trip and three-game series against the Atlanta Braves tonight at 7:35 p.m. LHP **Wei-Yin Chen**, making his 17th start of the season, is facing the Braves for the eighth time in his career, posting a 2-1 record and 3.23 ERA (39.0 ip/14 er); in two starts this season he has gone 1-0 with a 3.97 ERA (11.1/5). The Braves are countering with Julio Teheran, who in 19 career starts against the Marlins has gone 6-6 with a 4.23 ERA (115.0/54); in two starts this season is 0-1 with 12.54 ERA. The Marlins concluded a 3-3 homestand yesterday, splitting a two-game series with the Braves and a four-game set against the Nationals. The current road swing will continue with the Marlins heading north to face the Phillies in a four-game series from Thursday-Sunday. Tonight's game continues a stretch of 13 straight games (3-3) against NL East opponents. Miami plays 38 of their remaining 54 games (71%) against division foes.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

Miami shut out the Washington Nationals, 5-0, to split a four-game series. **José Ureña** gave up just one hit with four walks and five strikeouts over 6.0 innings. Miami's first run came in the second, when Ureña singled home **Miguel Rojas**. The Marlins extended their lead to 2-0 in the third, as **Martín Prado** doubled home **Brian Anderson**. In the fifth, Prado singled home Anderson again for the first run of the inning. **J.T. Realmuto** scored on a fielding error off the bat of **JT Riddle**, and Rojas doubled home Prado to cap the scoring. Anderson, Prado and Rojas each had two-hit games for Miami.

VS. THE BRAVES

Miami trails the 2018 series, 3-6, which includes a 1-2 mark in Atlanta. The Marlins, who trail the all-time series, 177-246, have gone 81-132 in Atlanta (4-9 at SunTrust Park). Miami is in search of its first series win in Atlanta since taking two of three from September 12-14, 2016 at Turner Field.

SPLITTING HAIRS

Wei-Yin Chen is making his ninth start of the season on the road tonight, where he has gone 1-5 with a 10.47 ERA (32.2/38). That is a stark contrast to what he has been able to do at home this season, where has pitched to a 2-2 record and 2.18 ERA (45.1/11) in eight starts. According to the *Stats LLC*, he has the largest differential between home and road ERAs (8.29) in the Majors this season (min. 15 GS), ahead of Lance Lynn (4.25; 7.08 on road/2.83 at home), Ryne Stanek (3.90; 4.35/0.45) and Felix Hernandez (3.52; 7.58/3.55). In addition, he has the largest difference in road/home opponents average at .150 (.369 road/.209 home). That is larger than Wade Leblanc (.099; .297/.198) and Matt Harvey (.082; .302/.220).

SHUTOUT SHOUTOUT

Miami pitchers have shut out opponents nine times this season, which is tied with Philadelphia for the fourth most among National League clubs. Pittsburgh leads the NL with 12, followed by the Cubs (11) and Giants (10). Last season, the Marlins recorded only seven shutouts, while the 2016 staff recorded 12.

HISTORY REPEATS ITSELF

Miami began the season with just a .225 team average over its first 28 road games, which ranked 27th in the Majors. Over their last 22 road games since June 1, the Marlins have hit at a .273 clip to rank third in the Majors behind Atlanta (.276) and Oakland (.273). Since 2014, Miami leads the Majors in road average with a .261 mark, ahead of Houston (.258) and Kansas City (.256).

ROAD WELL TRAVELED

The Marlins have two of the best road hitters in the National League in **Derek Dietrich** (.3214) and **J.T. Realmuto** (.3212), who rank eighth and ninth in road average, respectively. Dietrich has hit in nine of his last 11 road contests, batting .450 (18x40) with four doubles, five home runs, and nine RBI in that span. Realmuto has hit in 11 of his last 13 road games with an average of .364 (20x55), six doubles, two home runs, and 12 RBI.

NO NICKELS AND DIMES...ALL QUARTERS

Starlin Castro is one of six active players to record 25+ hits in five-or-more consecutive months. Whit Merrifield has recorded 25+ hits in nine consecutive months, followed by Freddie Freeman (7), Francisco Lindor (7), Castro (5), J.D. Martinez (5) and Trea Turner (5). - *Stats LLC*

GETTIN' ZIGGY WITH IT

Since June 5, **Brad Ziegler** has been one of the best relievers in the Majors. He leads all relievers in appearances (28), ranks second in ERA (min. 20 GP) at 0.64 (28.1/2), and ranks fifth in innings pitched. He is averaging just 12.4 pitches per appearance in that time, which ranks fifth in the National League, behind Andrew Chafin (11.3), Adam Morgan (11.9), Tony Watson (12.2), and Amir Garrett (12.2).

FLIPPING THE M

Since June 5, the Marlins have gone 26-22, and have won nine of 15 series in that span (two splits), including consecutive series wins against then-first-place Milwaukee and Philadelphia to end the first half. Miami opened the season 20-39, and dropped a season-high six straight games just prior to this current stretch. The Marlins have gone 10-9 on the road since June 4, and since being swept in a three-game series in Arizona from June 1-3, have won four of their last six road series.

GRASSHOPPER SWEEP

The Greensboro Grasshoppers swept the Pitcher and Player of the Week awards in the South Atlantic League for July 23-29, it was announced today.

- 2017 first-round draft pick LHP **Trevor Rogers** earned his award after striking out a career-high 12 batters and carrying a no-hitter through 7.2 innings before surrendering a single yesterday vs. Hickory. He was lifted from the game after the base hit and did not factor in the decision, despite the career-long outing. He finished July with a 1-2 record and a 2.67 ERA (33.2 ip/10 er) in six starts, with 41 strikeouts (11.0 so/9.0). That includes a 1.90 ERA (23.2/5) over his last four starts.
- Of **Tristan Pompey**, Miami's third-round pick in this year's Draft, batted .524 (11x21) with five runs scored, two doubles, his first two career home runs, and four RBI in six games last week. He had four multi-hit games, with a career-high four knocks on July 28 vs. Hickory.

LET THE CONVERSATION START

In his final game before the break, **Brian Anderson** recorded his sixth three-hit game of the season to run his season hit total to 109. His hit total prior to the break tied Rocco Baldelli for the second-most by a Major League rookie since 2003, behind only Hideki Matsui (114 in 2003). He is the only Marlins rookie in franchise history to record 100+ hits prior to the break. He is on pace for 176 hits this season, which would rank as the second-most by a National League rookie since 2010, behind Corey Seager's 193 in 2016.

- Wei-Yin Chen will make his 17th start of the season, and second straight against Atlanta, in the opener of this three-game set at SunTrust Park.
- Owens career 2-1 record and 3.23 ERA (39.0 ip/14 er) in seven career starts against Atlanta. Tonight will mark his third against the Braves this season, going 1-0 with a 3.97 ERA (11.1/5). In only start this season at SunTrust Park, May 20, allowed two runs on five hits with a walk and five strikeouts over 5.1 innings. Was one of just two road starts this season where he has allowed fewer than three runs (also June 6 at St. Louis).
- In last start, July 24 vs. Atlanta, tossed season high 101 pitches in 9-3 win. His pitch total in the game was the most since throwing 104 on June 8, 2016 at San Diego. Has broken 100-pitch plateau six times dating back to the start of 2016 (43 starts). Over his first four Major League campaigns, eclipsed 100-pitch mark 54 times in 117 starts.
- Has 2.18 ERA (45.1 ip/11 er) in eight home starts, compared to 10.47 (32.2/38) in eight road starts. According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, the 8.29 difference in home/road ERA is by far the largest gap for any pitcher in the Majors this season (min. 5 GS at home and on road). The second-biggest gap between a home and road ERA is 5.44 by Jake Faria (8.14 road/2.70 home), and the third-largest is a 5.42 for Sam Gaviglio (7.92 road/2.60 home).
- Opponents are batting .223 (29x130) first time through lineup, .286 (34x117) second time through, and .393 (22x56) third time through.
- Began season on DL (left elbow strain). Made two rehab appearances at Single-A Jupiter, allowing just one run over 7.2 innings, with just one walk and 11 strikeouts. In first appearance, April 17 vs. Lakeland, allowed one run and three hits over 2.2 innings. In second start, April 22 vs. St. Lucie, tossed two-hit, 5.0-inning complete game. Struck out seven without issuing a walk.
- Made season debut on April 28 vs. Colorado, earning a win after allowing just one run on four hits (one home run), two walks, and a hit batter over 5.1 innings, with three strikeouts.
- His start on May 26 vs. Washington marked 150th of career. Among pitchers born in Taiwan, Chen leads all in innings pitched (941.0), starts (160) and strikeouts (733). He ranks second in career wins with 56, behind Chien-Ming Wang (68). Wang ranks second in innings pitched (845.2), starts (126), and strikeouts (394).
- Opened 2017 on 25-man roster, but made just five starts before beginning DL stint on May 5. Reinstated on September 4, after which he made just four relief appearances before being shut down with left elbow discomfort following outing on Sept. 22. Finished with 2-1 record and 3.82 ERA (33.0/14).
- Best start of the year came on April 18 at Seattle, holding Mariners hitless over 7.0 innings while striking out two and issuing just two walks. Marked first start of career holding an opponent hitless. Previous low-hit start was one, done on June 2, 2016 vs. Pirates (6.0 ip).
- Allowed season-high tying seven hits, with four runs and two walks, along with three strikeouts, over 5.0 innings on April 26 at Philadelphia. Loss marked first and only defeat of season.
- Recorded season-high seven strikeouts in final start, on May 1 vs. Tampa Bay. Did not receive a decision despite allowing just two runs and two hits over 6.0. Also walked a season-high four.
- Upon reinstatement from DL, made first career relief appearance on September 4 vs. Washington, tossing 1.0 perfect inning. Allowed one run on two hits over 6.0 innings (1.50 ERA) in four relief outings to close out season.
- Picked up first career hit, an infield single, off of Zack Wheeler on April 7 at the Mets.
